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### NARRATIVE

On Saturday, May 11, 2019, at approximately 1340 hours, the Brevard County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) Crime Scene Unit (CSU) received a request for forensic services from BCSO Communications Center, pertaining to a drowning investigation. I responded to the scene, 3582 Twelve Oaks Circle, Merritt Island, Brevard County, Florida, arriving at approximately 1438 hours.

BCSO Homicide Unit Agent E. Kersey, ID 0284, was assigned lead investigative duties for this case. Refer to his report for complete details regarding this investigation.

Upon my arrival, BCSO East Precinct Deputy T. Lewis, ID 4388, relayed the following case details: Mr. Riley Fowler, decedent, was swimming in the pool with his sisters, Ms. Reese Fowler and Ms. Farah Fowler. Mrs. Amber Fowler, mother, was observing the children from inside the residence while cleaning the floors. Mrs. Fowler was alerted by the girls that Riley was "floating without his floaties." Mrs. Fowler pulled Riley from the pool and began CPR. Riley was transported by Brevard County Fire Rescue to [REDACTED] and then to [REDACTED].

The residence was a single family home on the southwest side of Twelve Oaks Circle with the main entrance facing northeast.

The living room and kitchen were a large open space. A set of sliding glass doors connected the living room side with the pool deck area. A window was on the south wall on the kitchen side of the room. The windows were clear of any window treatments that would block the view to the pool. A mop was resting against the west side of the island in the kitchen. Chairs were turned over on the island. A table was in front of the window. The chairs around the table were turned over so they were out of the way for cleaning the floor.

The pool area consisted of an enclosed space with a removable net fence around pool, a table with chairs, poolside lounge chairs, a small child size table, a two seater outdoor chair, a grill, and plants. Sections of the removable fence were arranged so the kids could enter and exit the pool. The pool had steps on the west side and a hot tub was on the east side. A light green Stearns "Puddle Jumper" floatie (FJ1) was near the east side of the hot tub on the ground.

The floatie was collected as an item of evidence and listed on a property receipt as follows:

FJ1: One (1) child pool floatie

The pool area, the main living space, and item of evidence were photographed using a Nikon D7200 digital camera.
