INQUIRY CONCERNING A JUDGE NO. 20-154

RE: NEIL A. RODDENBERY

On April 6, 2020, the Judicial Qualifications Commission recommended that the Court order the involuntary retirement of Tenth Judicial Circuit Judge Neil Roddenbery due to a permanent disability that seriously interferes with the performance of his judicial duties. Judge Roddenbery does not contest the Commission's recommendation. Therefore, we approve the Stipulation, adopt the Commission's recommendation, and declare Judge Roddenbery to be involuntarily retired from judicial service as of 5:00 p.m. on May 1, 2020. The Court Administrator for the Tenth Judicial Circuit shall submit a personnel action request (PAR) form to the Personnel Office of the Office of the State Courts Administrator for processing.
