On 02/04/2012 at approximately 2240 hours Inmate Burke, Michael was arrested by VCSO for an adult warrant signed by Judge Rouse for Uttering Forged Checks with a bond of \$3500.00 and VOP Grand Theft and Dealing in Stolen Property signed by Judge Hudson with no bond. Inmate Burke was arrested at 1010 North Woodland Blvd. #29 in Deland Florida. Due to some medical concerns, Inmate Burke was taken to Memorial Hospital in Deland and was subsequently admitted. VCSO stayed with this inmate at the hospital until First Appearance on 02/05/2012. No changes occurred at First Appearance and custody of this inmate turned over to VCDC. On 02/05/2012 at 1043 hrs., Inmate Burke was booked into VCDC custody.
On 02/08/2012 at approximately 1300 hrs. VCDC was informed that Inmate Burke had escaped from custody while at Memorial Hospital in Deland. He was seen exiting the building by Memorial Hospital personnel who had reported this to their security staff. Attached to this report is a chronological list of events as reported by staff involved.

- * Approximately 1255 hrs. I received a radio call from Lt. Gallenkamp to call the Shift Commander's Office.
- * I immediately called Shift Commander's Office. Lt. Smith answered and informed me that the inmate being treated at Florida Hospital Deland had just walked off from his hospital room without staff's knowledge. Inmate's name was Burke, Michael #847159.
- * At approximately 1300 hrs. I arrived at the Shift Commander's Office and was informed by Lt. Mason that he had assigned two armed officers to respond as soon as possible to Florida Hospital Deland to assist in recovery efforts.
- * At approximately 1302 hrs. I spoke with Warden Pronovost about "walk-off" and informed him that I would respond as well.
- * At approximately 1303 hrs., as I was leaving Shift Commander's Office, I received a call from Officer Stridiron that the inmate had been captured.
- * I immediately informed Lt. Mason of capture of Inmate Burke who in turn relayed this information to his transport officers.
- * At approximately 1306 hrs. Capt. McClelland and myself drove to Deland. We were informed over the radio that Inmate Burke was captured by Deland Police Department and the location of this apprehension was at 740 Plymouth Ave. at the corner of Stone Street and Plymouth Ave.
- * At approximately 1320 hrs. we arrived at the above mentioned location. I observed EVAC, Deland Police Department, Florida Hospital Security, Ofc. Harrison and Ofc. Foss, Channel 13 News, Channel 9 News and some other civilians were present.
- * Upon arrival I also observed Inmate Burke already in the EVAC ambulance.
- * Capt. McClelland and myself then began to interview Deland Police Department in an effort to gather as much information as possible as to the attempted escape and recapture of Inmate Burke. According to the Deland Police Department who was on site (Officer Godwin), the reason EVAC was contacted was due to the fact he was in a hospital gown and had what appeared to be heart monitor leads on his chest at the time of this apprehension.
- * While conducting this interview with Deland Police Department, we were still trying to ascertain if this inmate needed to be returned to Memorial Hospital for further treatment.
- * Also during this interview with Deland Police Department, we were informed that there was a piece of string wrapped around the chain of the leg irons being worn by Inmate Burke. It was obvious that Inmate Burke was using this string in an effort to lift the chain of the leg irons to make it easier to walk or run with them on. We were also informed that Inmate Burke was in possession of a knife when arrested that they believed he obtained from a nearby shed next to a residence.
- * Deland Police Department then informed us that Inmate Burke had utilized this knife in an attempt to further advance his escape by threatening Florida Hospital Security and then threatened his own life. Deland Police Department was able to de-escalate this threat getting the inmate to drop the weapon and then secured in restraints.
- * At approximately 1326 hrs. EVAC was instructed to take Inmate Burke back to Memorial Hospital Deland. Ofc. Harrison was instructed to ride in the ambulance with Inmate Burke. I rode with Ofc. Foss following EVAC, and Capt. McClelland followed us.

* While in route from the arrest site of Inmate Burke to Memorial Hospital Deland, I received a phone call from Lt. Gallenkamp stating Corizon Director of Nursing, John Gordon, just made contact with the doctor assigned to Inmate Burke at Memorial Hospital Deland. He was informed by this doctor that Inmate Burke was officially discharged from the hospital and could be returned to the Jail.

* Once at the Emergency area of Memorial Hospital Deland. I instructed Ofc. Foss to park directly behind EVAC. Inmate Burke's restraints were re-checked and he was then transferred to VCDC transport and immediately taken to VCBJ with Ofc. Harrison and Ofc. Foss.

* Capt. McClelland and myself then went to the room Inmate Burke was assigned to along with Memorial Hospital Security.

* Ofc. Stridiron had returned to the said hospital room. He was asked if he was okay or hurt in any way by Capt. McClelland and then questioned as to the events that transpired about the attempted escape. Ofc. Stridiron stated he was okay and had no injuries. Ofc. Stridiron further explained where he was seated at the time Inmate Burke had gotten up from his hospital bed to use the restroom. According to Ofc. Stridiron, it was apparent that several minutes had passed when he had gotten up himself to check on Inmate Burke, when the nurse came in to the room and advised him the inmate had left.

* I took pictures of the hospital room and inspected the hospital room.

* We were informed by Memorial Hospital Security staff that video could be obtained of this escape.

* All the above information was relayed to Warden Pronovost via telephone as it was received.

* Capt. McClelland and myself then returned to VCBJ.

* Ofc. Harrison and Ofc. Foss had already arrived with Inmate Burke.

* Inmate Burke was booked into VCBJ, evaluated by Medical and escorted to Unit 12 for housing. Inmate Burke was placed on a Two Officer / Full Restraint status with the Shift Commander present when door is opened and SDO notified prior to any outside transports. Inmate Burke was also placed on a CWI for the threat of self harm as mentioned above.

* All medical paperwork from Memorial Hospital personnel was hand delivered to Corison staff.

* Ofc. Stridiron also returned to VCBJ with all equipment and instructed to provide a written statement on this incident.

* Capt. McClelland advised Mental Health staff to speak with Ofc. Stridiron to address any concerns he may have.


* Once he provided his written statement and spoke with Mental Health personnel, he was released from duty due to hospital coverage no longer being needed. He was then instructed to return to work the next day for his regular assigned work day 02/08/2012.

* At approximately 1800 hrs. Deland Police Department delivered an arrest affidavit on Inmate Burke for additional charges of Escape, Armed Burglary of a Dwelling/Structure/Conveyance with no bond. Inmate Burke is scheduled for First Appearance on these additional charges on 02/08/2012.

<p>At 0734 hrs. I Ofc. Stridiron # 702 arrived on duty in Deland hospital room # 252 to relieve Ofc. Plotz. Ofc. Plotz informed me that Inmate Burke was no problem and that fluids given by the hospital staff will cause him to use the restroom frequently. After I was briefed, Ofc. Plotz departed room # 252. Because of the fluids the inmate was drinking, the inmate was placed on the bed secured with leg irons but not secured to the bed just in case he had to suddenly go to the restroom. The inmate went to the restroom twice in the morning with the IV stand, IV bag and the IV machine without incidents and I was able to hear movement and also the leg irons. I was seated right around the corner from the restroom inside the room. The third time at 1233 hrs after the inmate was in the restroom for 8 minutes I got up to check and make sure the inmate was ok. As I went to open the restroom door, the nurse came around the corner to room # 252 and told me the inmate took off and hospital security was notified. I immediately went down the hallway to see if the inmate was in the area of the nurse's station and to see if I could get a visual on the inmate. While calling the Branch Jail via cell phone to each extension in the Shift Supervisor's office the nurse told me the inmate was last seen going down the stairs. I called Control. I spoke CRO Smith and requested to speak to Lt. Gallenkamp and that was when I informed Lt. Gallenkamp of the attempted escape of inmate Burke. After I spoke to Lt. Gallenkamp, I was told the inmate was found by hospital security.</p>

On the above date at approximately 1300 hrs I walked into the shift commander's office at VCBJ. At that time I was told by Lt. Mason to suit up and get ready for a transport and that I would be going to Deland with Officer Harrison to pick up an inmate that had escaped from custody at Florida Hospital but had been apprehended. I then proceeded to get my transport belt and vest from my personal vehicle. Ofc. Harrison then met me in the parking lot driving a county corrections vehicle and we proceeded to the area of Florida Hospital. On the way to Deland we were instructed over the radio by Lt. Gallenkamp to go to the address of an unknown business at 740 Plymouth. When we arrived at that address I observed multiple Deland police officers, Ofc. Stridiron, hospital security officers, an EVAC ambulance and news media on scene. I observed inmate Burke, Michael #867423 on a ambulance stretcher being attended to by EVAC personnel. Inmate Burke had leg irons on and was handcuffed behind the back when I came on scene. Capt. Reinhart and Capt. McClelland arrived on scene approximately 2 minutes after Ofc. Harrison and I arrived. Inmate Burke was then loaded into the EVAC ambulance and was escorted by 1 Female Deland Police Officer and Ofc. Harrison. I was instructed by Capt. McClelland to follow the EVAC ambulance in the County Corrections vehicle to Florida Hospital. When we arrived at Florida Hospital I was then instructed by Capt. McClelland that Ofc. Harrison and I would be transferring inmate Burke back to VCBJ because he had been discharged by the hospital. Ofc. Harrison checked the inmates handcuffs for proper fit and double locked them. Capt. McClelland double locked the legirons. Capt. McClelland, Ofc. Harrison and I then escorted inmate Burke from the inside the ambulance to our County Corrections vehicle without incident and secured him in the back seat. Capt. McClelland then cut a piece of string off of the leg irons that was approximately 2½ to 3 feet long. Ofc. Harrison and I then drove inmate Burke back to VCBJ without incident. When we arrived back at VCBJ we were met in the vehicle sally port by Lt. Mason and Sgt. Stormer. We secured our weapons and then inmate Burke was told to exit the back seat of the vehicle which he did. I then removed the back seat of the vehicle and Ofc. Harrison and I searched the back of the car for contraband. No contraband was found. Inmate Burke was escorted into I.D. Receiving and taken to the dress out room where he was strip searched by Lt. Mason. Inmate Burke was then dressed in orange pants and V-neck and then placed back into restraints. Inmate Burke was taken to the AFIS area and finger printed. Inmate Burke was then seen by VCBJ medical staff. Lt. Mason, Ofc. Harrison and I then escorted inmate Burke to Unit 12 where he was strip searched again per policy and secured in cell 12S08. I had no contact with this inmate after he was secured in Unit 12.


At approximately 1300 hours on 02-07-12 Lt. Mason told me to get suited up for a transport. I then got suited up and waited for further direction. Lt. Mason told me that officer Foss and I were going to the area of Florida Hospital Deland because an inmate had escaped from custody. I then went to the control room lobby window and received keys from officer Smith for a Crown Victoria vehicle. I met Ofc. Foss in the parking lot and drove around to the sally port of I.D. to retrieve weapons. I then proceeded to the Deland area. I was instructed by radio to go to the address of an unknown business at 740 Plymouth Ave. by Lt. Gallenkamp. Upon arriving at that address I observed multiple Deland Police officers as well as Ofc. Stridiron, Hospital security, an EVAC ambulance and news media at the scene. I then observed inmate Burke, Michael #867423 laying down on his back on an EVAC stretcher. This inmate was being attended to by the EVAC personnel. This inmate was in handcuffs and legirons. I then made contact with a Deland police officer by the name of Godwin. Ofc. Godwin stated inmate Burke ran from our staff, broke into a shed and armed himself with a switchblade knife. I then observed Capt. Reinhart and Capt. McClelland arrive on scene. I was then advised that inmate Burke was being transported via EVAC back to Florida Hospital Deland. I advised Capt. McClelland of this and he instructed me to enter the EVAC ambulance for the transport. The inmate had been placed in the ambulance just previous with a Deland P.D. officer. This inmate was then transported via EVAC ambulance back to Florida Hospital Deland to the area where the ambulances arrive. Ofc. Foss was behind the ambulance riding chase in vehicle 368. Capt. McClelland told us that this inmate was discharged from the hospital and able to be transported to VCBJ. Evac staff then removed the I.V. from this inmates right arm. I then double locked the handcuffs that were already on this inmates wrist and checked them for proper fit. I then asked Capt. McClelland to double check the leg irons. This inmate was then escorted from the ambulance to vehicle #368 without incident. As this inmate was seated into our vehicle Capt. McClelland cut a string from the leg irons that was approximately 3 feet in length. Ofc. Foss and I then transported inmate Burke to VCBJ without incident. During the transport Lt. Mason checked on us via radio and was advised each time that everything was OK. Upon arriving at VCBJ I advised Lt. Mason we were at the back gate and he along with Sgt. Stormer met us in the vehicle sallyport. Ofc. Foss and I then secured our weapons while the inmate was being watched by other staff. Inmate Burke was then told to exit the vehicle. Ofc. Foss then removed the back seat of the vehicle so the back of the car could be searched for contraband. No contraband was found. Inmate Burke was then escorted into I.D. Receiving and taken back to the dress out room where the restraints were removed and the inmate was strip searched by Lt. Mason. The inmate then got dressed in orange pants and v-neck and placed back into restraints by assisting staff. This inmate was then escorted to AFIS where his picture was taken and fingerprints were done. This inmate was then seen by medical and escorted to 12S08 without incident. This inmate was again strip searched per policy and secured in cell 12S08. I had no further contact with this inmate.

On above date I was assigned as the Relief Lieutenant for VCBJ. At approximately 12:55 I received a phone call from Ofc. Stridiron, who was assigned to watch I/M Burke, Michael 867423 who admitted to Florida Hospital Deland Room 252. At that time Ofc. Stridiron informed me that I/M Burke was "gone". At that time I was unsure what Ofc. Stridiron was trying to tell me and asked what he meant by gone. Ofc. Stridiron then informed me that he had let the inmate up to use the bathroom and that I/M Burke "took off and was gone." I asked Ofc. Stridiron if he knew which direction the inmate went and he stated that he did not. At that time Lt. Smith was also in the Shift Commanders office. I told Ofc. Stridiron that I would call him right back and asked Lt. Smith to brief Capt. Reinhart who was in the Armory at the time. I immediately reported to the Director's Office and informed Senior Management. I returned to the Shift Commanders office and contacted Ofc. Stridiron while other staff compiled the necessary paperwork. I asked Ofc. Stridiron if the inmate was in restraints and he stated that he was in leg irons. I then asked that he explain what had happened. He stated that he let the inmate up to use the bathroom. Ofc. Stridiron explained that there was a wall and curtain by the bathroom and that he could not directly see the bathroom door. I informed Ofc. Stridiron that assisting staff would be enrooted and that I would check back with him. At approximately 13:02 I attempted to contact the Deland Police Dept. when I was informed by Capt. Reinhart that I/M Burke had been apprehended. Capt's. Reinhart & McClelland left to respond to the Hospital along with Ofc's Harrison & Foss who were sent out to assist. I was again contacted by Ofc. Stridiron who informed me that the inmate was at 740 W. Plymouth and was secured. I relayed this information the the responding staff who arrived at approximately 13:26. I then spoke with RN J. Gordon in the clinic and asked that he see if he could communicate w/ the medical staff to determine if I/M Burke could be medically cleared and returned to the jail. Shortly after I was informed by Lt. Smith that I/M Burke had been cleared and was being returned to VCBJ. At approximately 13:44 Ofc's. Harrison & Foss were enroute to VCBJ w/ I/M Burke. At approximately 14:00 I/M Burke was arrived to VCBJ where his processing was completed and he was evaluated by medical staff. I/M Burke was then escorted to Unit 12 where he was strip searched and secured and secured into 12S08 at approximately 14:35.

On 02/07/2012 at about 1300 hours I was called to the Shift Commanders Office by Lt S Smith. Upon arriving I was informed that Inmate Burke, Michael 867423. Had escaped from the Deland Hospital. Lt Smith asked if a photo had been of Inmate Burke while he was at the hospital. I called AFIS and had them pull the last two photos of when Inmate Burke was in our custody. At the same time I informed Officer M Harrison and Officer J Foss to suit up for a transport and I returned to ID. Upon returning to ID I was informed that Inmate Burke was in the custody of Deland Police Dept / Deland Hospital Security in the area of Deland Hospital. I informed Officer Harrison and Officer Foss to head towards Deland Hospital and I would get them a better location on the way. I was also informed that Capt McClelland and Capt Reinhart were also on the way. Shortly after they had left VCBJ I overheard Lt Gallenkamp inform Capt Reinhart and Capt McClelland the location was 740 W Plymouth Ave Officer Harrison and Officer Foss advised they were headed to that location. During this time I went to the control room to field incoming calls and give direction as needed. Officer Harrison and Officer Foss advised they had arrived and were in contact with the inmate and Deland Police Dept. A little while later Officer Harrison and Officer Foss advised they were in route back to VCBJ with Inmate Burke. While in route back to VCBJ Capt McClelland called me and advised me that sometime after Inmate Burke had gotten away from the Hospital he had obtained a knife and that he needed to be researched when he arrived at VCBJ, Capt McClelland also advised me that he had just found this information out and that Officer Harrison and Officer Foss were unaware of this. At that point I contact Officer Harrison over the radio and asked if everything was ok. Officer Harrison advised everything was ok and they were about 5 minutes out from the jail. Upon their arrival at the jail I met them in the vehicle sallyport. Inmate Burke was removed from the vehicle, he was in leg irons and handcuffs and his underwear. Inmate Burke was asked by me if he had anything on him and he stated no, the vehicle was searched including the removal of the back seat. Inmate Burke was escorted inside the VCBJ. While being escorted Inmate Burke stated he did not remember anything and asked what had happened, I asked him what he meant and he stated the last thing he remembered was being in a motel a few days ago and then walking around on the street today. As we walked towards the dress out room I asked Inmate Burke if he remembered being in the hospital and he stated no he did not remember anything. Once inside Inmate Burke was escorted to the dress out room where he was stripped searched by me. After he was searched he was given a jumpsuit and placed back in full restraints. After Inmate Burke was secured in full restraints I asked him if he had any property at the hospital. Inmate Burke stated yes he had a cell phone, pants, shoes and 105.00 dollars. I asked Inmate Burke how he remembered this if he did not remember being in the hospital. Inmate Burke refused to comment after that. Inmate Burkes was processed through ID and evaluated by medical staff and placed on a CWI. (Capt McClelland had called me and advised the Deland Police Officer on the scene had advised that Inmate Burke held a knife to his wrist while he was being arrested.) Inmate Burke was then escorted to Unit 12 for housing. Once in Unit 12 Inmate Burke was stripped searched by Officer E Scarborough. Inmate was then secured in cell 12S08.

When Officer Stridiron arrived back at VCBJ he had a bag containing Inmate Burkes personal property. In the bag was a cell phone, shoes, pants, shirt, and drivers licenses. All inmates property was inventoried and placed in property.
