
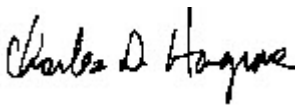



Summary/Highlights:							
On January 21, 2016, the county council approved a three (3) year agreement with Legal Research Associates - Florida for legal research services for requests from inmates. This agreement expires January 29, 2019.							
The county contracts with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC (Aramark), for corrections integrated banking and commissary services. Aramark offers similar legal research services via LexisNexis through kiosks made available to inmates. Terminating the current legal							

research agreement and amending the county's contract with Aramark to include the same service without interruption of inmate access to legal research would save the county approximately \$35,000 annually.

Staff requests that county council approve termination for convenience of the balance of the agreement with Legal Research Associates.
