On May 17, 2005, the Department of Public Protection, Internal Affairs' Unit received information from the Division of Corrections that alleged that Correction's Officer Trainee Thomas McCallister, who worked the night shift, was introducing contraband (cigarettes) into the Corrections Facility.

On May 19, 2005, the officer was directed to the Internal Affairs' Unit to review the complaint and provide a sworn statement addressing the allegation. When the officer read the complaint he advised, prior to making his statement, that the allegation was true and he was bringing tobacco products into the corrections facility for Inmate Brewster, John, Booking Number 610979, for about a month. He then stated he was resigning his position as a corrections officer effective immediately and submitted a written resignation.

In view of the officer's admission, the officer's resignation was received and accepted after notifying the Department Director. Further investigation was not necessary.

Therefore, the allegation associated with this case is SUSTAINED.

This investigative report is being submitted for your review and action as deemed appropriate. With your approval this case file will be closed without further action from this unit.
