

Re: Public Records Request

Dear Mr. Wyckoff:

I am in receipt of your letter of August 16, 2005 as well as your letter to Mrs. Bowman of August 9, 2005.

As for your FDLE officer Profile Sheet, I am familiar with the FDLE Affidavit of Separation, Form CJSTC 61, which is used to prepare the profile sheet. In your case, the separation reason given was "terminated for violating Ch. 943.13(4), FS **OR** moral character standards". (emphasis added) "Moral character standards" are set forth in Rule 11B-27.0011 F.A.C. and include the conduct for which you were terminated.

Despite your assertions to the contrary, there has been no "active campaign" to criminally charge you with worker's compensation fraud. I can assure you, if such was pursued, it would not be unsuccessful.

As for your public records request, portions of your worker's compensation file are exempt from public records discipline. Those portions which are public record or which may be available to you pursuant to the signing of a release (ie medical records) will be provided to you. All medical records have previously been provided to your attorney. Payment for copies is required in advance. Please call my office at the listed number in order or arrange a mutually convenient time to resolve this matter.
