As you are aware, Wayne Ivey is no longer the Resident Agent in Charge of the FDLE office in Volusia County. RAC Jack Massey has assumed responsibility for that role and the subsequent oversight of all FDLE criminal investigations from that office.

The death of Tracey Veira was investigated by the Volusia County Sheriff's Office, as are all inmate deaths within that facility.

The allegations of inaccurate reporting and dereliction of duty are most appropriately handled by the internal affairs division of VCSO, which did in fact conduct an investigation into the circumstances surrounding this investigation and found cause for discipline. If there are allegations of violations of Ms. Veira's civil rights, they should be directed to the Federal Bureau of Investigation which handles such matters.

Based upon the information you have provided, there is no information that would necessitate an independent investigation of this incident by FDLE. If there is evidence that implicates members of the corrections department or VCSO in the intentional commission of acts which caused the death of inmate Veira, please provide that evidence directly to RAC Massey so that he may evaluate the need for further review.
