MOTION TO COMPEL PRODUCTION OF E-MAILS

COMES NOW, the Defendant, DANA LYNN LOYD, by and through her undersigned counsel, and moves this Honorable Court for an Order Compelling the Department of Corrections to produce e-mails between December 2016 and June 2018 related to the supervision of the Defendant in the email account Margo.Sloan@fdc.myflorida.com or any previous server used by Officer Sloan and/or the Department of Corrections. As grounds therefor:

- 1. A deposition of Probation Officer Sloan is set for December 10, 2018.
- 2. Probation Officer Sloan has been served with a Subpoena Duces Tecum to bring with her to the deposition: information and reports from the supervision file of Dana Lynn Loyd, including the complete official file, attendance records, sign in sheets, hand written notes, correspondence from the victim, telephone messages, emails, and faxes in any way pertaining to Dana Lynn Loyd.
- 3. At 7:00 p.m. on December 5, 2018, Officer Sloan sent the attached Invoice for Production of Records with the hand-written note at the bottom of page 2: "Also; unable to access any saved Sloan emails between December 2016 through June 2018." See Ex. A.
- 4. On information and belief, the emails that are now allegedly inaccessible contain details that would exonerate the Defendant from any allegation of probation violation.
- 5. On December 6, 2018, Officer Sloan sent a follow-up e-mail explaining that "Apparently my email was an old version that I can no longer access, so I cannot access anything at all, not just hers." See Ex. B.

- 6. On information and belief, the information that would exonerate the Defendant would have appeared in emails in December of 2017 at which time Officer Sloan was using the same e-mail address that is currently in use, i.e., Margo.Sloan@fdc.myflorida.com.
- 7. On information and belief, government servers generally are provided with automatic back up systems that would be readily accessible by any IT person, and general public use email systems such as gmail, hotmail and the like can be accessed by forensic means to recover data.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant, DANA LYNN LOYD, by and through her undersigned attorney, hereby moves this Honorable Court for an Order compelling the Department of Corrections to produce the subject emails.
