**BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION:**

On December 19, 2013, Captain Mahoney received a memorandum from Sergeant Hazelwood in reference to concerns about the issuance of criminal citations by Officer Geiger. Sergeant Hazelwood advised, he witnessed Officer Geiger make a signature type mark in the offender signature field of the electronic citation he was going to issue the defendant Chris B. Johnson on December 14, 2013. Sergeant Hazelwood corrected Officer Geiger's action and had him reprint the citation and ensured the citation was signed by the offender. Sergeant Hazelwood searched past criminal citations issued by Officer Geiger and located eight (8) additional citations he believed had the same type of mark that he witnessed Officer Geiger make in the offender signature field of Johnson's citation. Sergeant Hazelwood referred to these signatures as "questionable" in his opinion. The (8) citations were filed with this case for further investigation.

On December 19, 2013, Captain Mahoney contacted Chief Investigator Noel Griffin of the State Attorney's Office and provided him the information known about the complaint. Investigator Griffin advised he spoke with Assistant State Attorney's about the facts and advised more information would be needed to determine if a possible crime occurred.

On December 19, 2013, Chief Arcieri contacted agent John King with the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and requested they investigate the incident. On January 8, 2014, Chief Arcieri and Captain Mahoney met with Agent King. King advised he reviewed the known facts about this incident and advised there was "no clear criminal violation" and FDLE declined to investigate the incident referring it back to our agency for an internal investigation.

On January 11, 2014 Captain Mahoney ordered Sergeant DeRosa to conduct an internal investigation on Officer Charles Geiger for failure to carry out his duties between October 24, 2013 thru December 14, 2013.

An internal investigation of Officer Geiger for the alleged violations of Departmental Policy and Procedure Directives are as follows:

**OFFENSE(S):**

Edgewater Police Department Policy and Procedure Directives, # 1-4-06 "Code Of Conduct" titled "Neglect of Duty" Section # 1.4.4 -Neglect of duty offenses include any act, failure to act, or instance wherein an employee ignored, paid no attention to, disregarded, failed to care for, failed to give proper attention to, or failed to carry out the duties and responsibilities of his/her position whether through carelessness, oversight or neglect. Each supervisor shall be accountable for the performance of the employees under his or her immediate supervision.

**INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:**

**Witness #1: Lindsay Medders**

On January 14, 2014, Sergeant DeRosa conducted a recorded sworn interview with Lindsay Medders. She was explained Florida Statute 112.533. Medders signed a notice of investigation and stated she understood the guidelines of this statute. Medders provided a sworn recorded statement. Below is a summary of the findings:

- Medders said she was stopped by Officer Geiger on December 05, 2013 for driving with a suspended license.
- Medders said she was issued a citation by Officer Geiger for the offense.
- Medders said she was informed the violation would require a court appearance.
- Medders said she never signed her citation.
- Medders was shown citation A05ISKE and confirmed the signature mark in the violators section of the citation was not hers.
- See attached citation for details.

The recorded statement from Medders was not submitted with this case file due to the recorder becoming defective and the audio not being able to be downloaded from the recording device.

**Witness #2: Sergeant Robert Hazelwood**

On January 15, 2014 Sergeant DeRosa conducted a recorded sworn interview with Sergeant Hazelwood. He was explained Florida Statute 112.533. Sergeant Hazelwood signed a notice of investigation and stated he understood the guidelines of this statute. Sergeant Hazelwood provided a sworn recorded statement. Below is a summary of the findings:

- Sergeant Hazelwood was Officer Geiger's supervisor on December 14, 2013.
- Sergeant Hazelwood was present during the traffic stop with Officer Geiger on December 14, 2013.

- Sergeant Hazelwood was present while Officer Geiger completed citation #A051SNE electronically on iye-citation software for Chris Johnson.
- Sergeant Hazelwood said upon completion of the citation by Officer Geiger, he witnessed him sign the signature area for the violator with a "Z" mark.
- Sergeant Hazelwood immediately addressed the improper procedure with Officer Geiger at the scene.
- Sergeant Hazelwood said Officer Geiger told him he signed the violators section of the citation because he did not want subjects touching his equipment.
- Sergeant Hazelwood ordered Officer Geiger to reprint the citation and have the violator sign it.
- Sergeant Hazelwood said once he addressed the violation with Officer Geiger proper procedure for obtaining the signature on the citation was completed.
- Sergeant Hazelwood stated the first citation was disposed of by Officer Geiger and was not collected for evidence since he had "crumbled it up."
- Sergeant Hazelwood said he felt Officer Geiger's act was a result of being lazy.
- Sergeant Hazelwood said he searched past criminal citations issued by Officer Geiger and located several other citations he believed were questionable.
- See enclosed CD of recorded interview for further details.

**Witness #3: Luke Garrabrant**

On January 15, 2014, Sergeant DeRosa conducted a recorded sworn interview with Luke Garrabrant. He was explained Florida Statute 112.533. Garrabrant signed a notice of investigation and stated he understood the guidelines of this statute. Garrabrant provided a sworn recorded statement. Garrabrant provided the following facts in regards to this investigation:

- Garrabrant stated he was stopped by Officer Geiger on October 24, 2013 for a traffic violation and a suspended license.
- Garrabrant said he was issued citation #A051M3E by Officer Geiger for the suspended license.
- Garrabrant stated he was informed the violation would require a court appearance.
- Garrabrant said he signed his citation.
- See enclosed CD of recorded interview for further details.

**Witness #4: John Allison**

On 1/17/2014, Sergeant DeRosa conducted a recorded sworn interview with John Allison. He was explained Florida Statute 112.533. Allison signed a notice of investigation and stated she understood the guidelines of this statute. Allison provided a sworn recorded statement. Below is a summary of the findings:

- Allison stated he was stopped by Officer Geiger on December 11, 2013.
- Allison said he was issued citation #A051SME by Officer Geiger for the violation of driving while his license was suspended.

- Allison said he was informed the violation would require a court appearance.
- Allison said he could not remember if he had signed his citation.
- Allison was shown citation A051SME and confirmed the signature mark in the violators section of the citation was not his.
- See enclosed CD of recorded interview for further details.

**Witness #5: Dominick Saladino**

Sergeant DeRosa requested Saladino provide an interview on January 17, 2014. Saladino informed Sergeant DeRosa he was refusing to come in or provide Sergeant DeRosa with a taped interview. Saladino said he was scheduled for a court appearance for citation A051SCE issued by Officer Geiger. Saladino said the officer treated him well and there was not any reason for him to come in or provide a recorded interview.

**Witness #6: Nicole Cornmier-Malone**

On January 21, 2014, Sergeant DeRosa conducted a recorded sworn interview with Nicole Cornmier-Malone. She was explained Florida Statute 112.533. Cornmier-Malone signed a notice of investigation and stated she understood the guidelines of this statute. Cornmier-Malone provided a sworn recorded statement. Below is a summary of the findings:

- Cornmier-Malone stated she was stopped by Officer Geiger on November 15, 2013 for a traffic violation and driving without a license.
- Cornmier-Malone said she was issued citation #A051S9E by Officer Geiger for driving without a license.
- Cornmier-Malone stated she was informed the violation would require a court appearance.
- Cornmier-Malone said she did not sign her citation.
- Cornmier-Malone was shown citation A051S9E and confirmed the signature mark in the violators section of the citation was not hers.
- See enclosed CD of recorded interview for further details.

**Witness #7: Darrin Knight**

On January 14, 2014 Sergeant DeRosa's attempt to contact Darrin Knight in person was unsuccessful. A business card was left with instruction for Knight to contact Sergeant DeRosa in reference to this investigation.

On January 21, 2014, Sergeant DeRosa conducted a recorded sworn interview with Knight. He was explained Florida Statute 112.533. Knight signed a notice of investigation and stated he understood the guidelines of this statute. Knight provided a sworn recorded statement. Below is a summary of the findings:

- Knight stated he was stopped by Officer Geiger on December 07, 2013 for operating an unregistered motor vehicle.
  - Knight said he was issued citation #A051SLE by Officer Geiger for driving without a license.
  - Knight stated he was informed the violation would require a court appearance.
  - Knight said he did not remember if he had signed his citation.
  - Knight was shown citation A051SLE and confirmed the signature mark in the violators section of the citation was not his.

**Witness #8: Mark Hurley**

On January 17, 2014 an attempt to contact Hurley in person at 803 Old Mission Road in New Smyrna Beach was unsuccessful. The land owner verified Hurley was currently residing at this location. A business card was left at his residence with instructions for him to contact Sergeant DeRosa in reference to this investigation.

On January 21, 2014 a second attempt was made to contact Hurley for an interview at 803 Old Mission Road in New Smyrna Beach. A business card was left at the residence with instructions for him to contact Sergeant DeRosa in reference to this investigation.

As of January 27, 2014 Hurley has refused to make contact with Sergeant DeRosa for this investigation. An interview with Hurley regarding this investigation was unsuccessful.

**Witness #9: Sabrina Dejesus**

On January 17, 2014 an attempt to contact Sabrina Dejesus in person at 815 Carol Ave in New Smyrna Beach was unsuccessful. The homeowner at this location advised Dejesus no longer lived at this location, but informed Sergeant DeRosa her husband worked the Atlantic Plaza Condo, located at 425 S Atlantic Avenue in New Smyrna Beach. Sergeant DeRosa was able to make contact with Mr. Dejesus who was advised of the pending investigation. Mr. Dejesus told Sergeant DeRosa he would inform his wife of the investigation. Mr. Dejesus was provided a business card with instructions for Sabrina Dejesus to contact Sergeant DeRosa in reference to this investigation. Mr. Dejesus stated he and his wife are currently residing at 105 E. Orange Avenue in New Smyrna Beach. A follow-up verification of this address showed it did not exist.

On January 21, 2014 a second attempt to locate Sabrina Dejesus was made at the Atlantic Plaza Condo with negative results. Mr. Dejesus was not present during this contact.

As of January 27, 2014 Dejesus has refused to make contact with Sergeant DeRosa for this investigation. An interview with Dejesus regarding this investigation was unsuccessful.

**Subject Officer: Charles Geiger:**

On January 13, 2013, Officer Geiger was informed of the pending investigation against him. Officer Geiger was issued a "Notification of Internal Investigation Form," which he signed and stated he understood the guidelines of the notification.

Officer Geiger was explained and provided with Florida Statutes 112.533 and his rights outlined in Florida Statute 112.532. Officer Geiger was issued copies of both statutes. Officer Geiger said he understood.

On January 28, 2014, Officer Geiger provided a sworn recorded interview. Sergeant DeRosa informed Officer Geiger of the nature of the investigation, the names of all complainants. Sergeant DeRosa provided Officer Geiger with all the documents for this investigation, including, but not limited to complaint details and witness statements relevant to this case for his review. Upon review of all documents for this case, Officer Geiger stated he waived his right to representation or legal counsel.

Sergeant DeRosa read Officer Geiger Garrity Warnings, which he signed stating he understood. Officer Geiger provided a sworn recorded statement. Below is a summary of the findings:

- Officer Geiger stated he did not have Chris Johnson initially sign citation #A051SNE.
- ~~Officer Geiger admitted he had filled in the violator section of the citation for Chris Johnson with a random mark.~~
- Officer Geiger stated when Sergeant Hazelwood confronted him with his actions he reprinted the citation and had Johnson sign the citation. Officer Geiger stated the original citation he had marked was disposed of.
- Officer Geiger stated he did sign the violators section of all the citations listed in this case to include the witnesses who were not interviewed.
- Officer Geiger stated he informed all the violators the citation would require a court appearance.
- Officer Geiger stated the reason he failed to have the violators sign the citation was due to officer safety reasons.
- Officer Geiger stated the new iye-citation program required the violator coming back to the vehicle to sign their name on a signature pad.
- Officer Geiger stated the majority of the citations he had issued in this case he had no back-up unit.
- Officer Geiger stated since December 14, 2013 he has not signed the violators section of any other citations.
- Officer Geiger said due to the safety risk involved, he no longer uses the electronic citation program and now hand writes his citations to reduce the safety risk.

## Finding of Fact

The following facts support the below listed conclusion for policy violation titled "Neglect of Duty."

Confirmed witnesses who did not sign their citation:

- Nicole Commier-Malone (Citation #A051S9E)
- Lindsay Medders (Citation #A051SKE)
- Darrin Knight (Citation #A051SLE)
- John Allison (Citation #A051SME)

Witness who advised he signed his citation:

- Luke Garrabrant (Citation #A051M3E)

Witnesses issued citations that would not cooperate with investigation:

- Mark Hurley (Citation #A051M9E)
- Dominick Saladino (Citation #A051SCE)
- Sabrina Dejesus (Citation #A051SAE)

Based on this investigation it was determined Officer Geiger neglected his duties and did not properly obtain the required signatures from violators during the issuing of seven (7) uniform traffic citations.

In reference to citation #A051M3E during interview Luke Garrabarant said he had signed the citation. Officer Geiger also stated in interview he had made the mark in the signature field of the citation. Due to conflicting statements it's unknown who actually signed the citation.

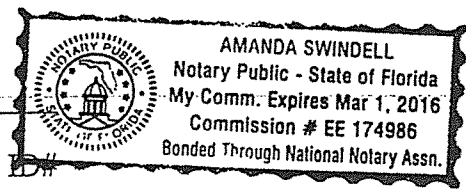

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Capt Mahoney,

Officer Geiger worked the Friday over time detail on 12/13/2013 that ended at 03:00 on 12/14/2013.

I was present with Officer Geiger during one of his stops on a black Dodge pickup bearing Florida tag# 924PYH. The vehicle was driven by a subject who identified himself as Chris Bradley Johnson, 06/29/75. Officer Geiger issued Bradley criminal citation #A05ISNE for DWLS. During this process I witnessed Officer Geiger prepare the citation utilizing E Citation. Once the citation was completed, Officer Geiger utilized the signature pad and drew a z pattern in the violators section and printed the citation out. I questioned Officer Geiger's actions as to why he was not having Bradley sign the citation since this is their promise of appearing in court. Officer Geiger stated he didn't want the subject (Bradley) to touch his signature pad. Officer Geiger was advised this process was incorrect and criminal citations need the Defendant's signature if being ROR'd. I then instructed Officer Geiger to utilize the re-print option and pull up the citation for a signature. This was accomplished and Bradley signed citation #A05ISNE.

I then investigated further under Officer Geiger's criminal E Citations and discovered (9) nine more questionable signatures that go back to October 24, 2013. The majority of these citations have the same z pattern that I witnessed on the original citation issued to Bradley.

I feel this can cause major concern if Officer Geiger is signing criminal citations where the Defendant's are suppose to sign promising their appearance.

I printed the questionable signatures and enclosed them with this memo.

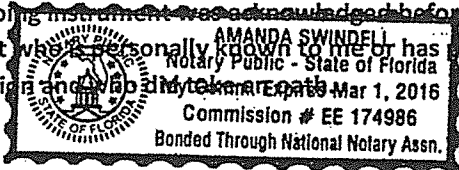

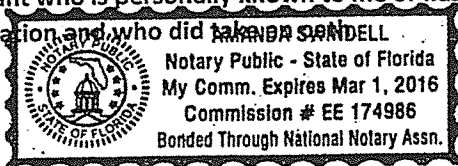



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**INTERNAL INVESTIGATION RECORDED STATEMENT**

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I am Sergeant DeRosa of the Edgewater Police Department. I have been assigned by the Chief of Police to conduct an Internal Affairs Investigation #1401-001 and I am the investigator in charge of this case. You are being questioned as a subject officer in an official investigation by the Edgewater Police Department. A complaint has been made against Charles Geiger regarding his conduct and behavior during the time period of October 24, 2013 through December 14, 2013 while he was on duty.

**The specific allegations are as follows:**

During the time period of October 24, 2013 through December 14, 2013, Officer Charles Geiger may have failed to obtain the defendant/recipient's signature on criminal traffic citations issued by him as required by Florida State Statute.

On December 19, 2013, Captian Mahoney received a memorandum from Sergeant Hazelwood in reference to concerns about the issuance of criminal citations by Officer Geiger. Sergeant Hazelwood advised he witnessed Officer Geiger make a signature type mark in the offender signature field of the electronic citation he was going to issue the defendant Chris B. Johnson on December 14, 2013. Sergeant Hazelwood corrected Officer Geiger's action and had him reprint the citation and ensured the citation was signed by the offender. Sergeant Hazelwood searched past criminal citations issued by Officer Geiger and located nine (8) additional citations not including Johnson's citation in which he believed had the same type of mark that he witnessed Officer Geiger make in the offender signature field of Johnson's citation. Sergeant Hazelwood referred to these signatures as "questionable" in his opinion.

**It is being alleged you violated the following directives:**

**Edgewater Police Department Policy and Procedure Directives, # 1-4-06 "Code Of Conduct" titled "Neglect of Duty" Section # 1.4.4 -Neglect of duty offenses include any act, failure to act, or instance wherein an employee ignored, paid no attention to, disregarded, failed to care for, failed to give proper attention to, or failed to carry out the duties and responsibilities of his/her position whether through carelessness, oversight or neglect. Each supervisor shall be accountable for the performance of the employees under his or her immediate supervision.**

## Law Enforcement Officers' and Correctional Officers' Rights

Florida State Statute 112.532

All law enforcement officers and correctional officers employed by or appointed to a law enforcement agency or a correctional agency shall have the following rights and privileges:

**(1) RIGHTS OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS WHILE UNDER INVESTIGATION.**—Whenever a law enforcement officer or correctional officer is under investigation and subject to interrogation by members of his or her agency for any reason that could lead to disciplinary action, suspension, demotion, or dismissal, the interrogation must be conducted under the following conditions:

(a) The interrogation shall be conducted at a reasonable hour, preferably at a time when the law enforcement officer or correctional officer is on duty, unless the seriousness of the investigation is of such a degree that immediate action is required.

(b) The interrogation shall take place either at the office of the command of the investigating officer or at the office of the local precinct, police unit, or correctional unit in which the incident allegedly occurred, as designated by the investigating officer or agency.

(c) The law enforcement officer or correctional officer under investigation shall be informed of the rank, name, and command of the officer in charge of the investigation, the interrogating officer, and all persons present during the interrogation. All questions directed to the officer under interrogation shall be asked by or through one interrogator during any one investigative interrogation, unless specifically waived by the officer under investigation.

(d) The law enforcement officer or correctional officer under investigation must be informed of the nature of the investigation before any interrogation begins, and he or she must be informed of the names of all complainants. All identifiable witnesses shall be interviewed, whenever possible, prior to the beginning of the investigative interview of the accused officer. The complaint, all witness statements, including all other existing subject officer statements, and all other existing evidence, including, but not limited to, incident reports, GPS locator information, and audio or video recordings relating to the incident under investigation, must be provided to each officer who is the subject of the complaint before the beginning of any investigative interview of that officer. An officer, after being informed of the right to review witness



statements, may voluntarily waive the provisions of this paragraph and provide a voluntary statement at any time.

(e) Interrogating sessions shall be for reasonable periods and shall be timed to allow for such personal necessities and rest periods as are reasonably necessary.

(f) The law enforcement officer or correctional officer under interrogation may not be subjected to offensive language or be threatened with transfer, dismissal, or disciplinary action. A promise or reward may not be made as an inducement to answer any questions.

(g) The formal interrogation of a law enforcement officer or correctional officer, including all recess periods, must be recorded on audio tape, or otherwise preserved in such a manner as to allow a transcript to be prepared, and there shall be no unrecorded questions or statements. Upon the request of the interrogated officer, a copy of any recording of the interrogation session must be made available to the interrogated officer no later than 72 hours, excluding holidays and weekends, following said interrogation.

(h) If the law enforcement officer or correctional officer under interrogation is under arrest, or is likely to be placed under arrest as a result of the interrogation, he or she shall be completely informed of all his or her rights before commencing the interrogation.

(i) At the request of any law enforcement officer or correctional officer under investigation, he or she has the right to be represented by counsel or any other representative of his or her choice, who shall be present at all times during the interrogation whenever the interrogation relates to the officer's continued fitness for law enforcement or correctional service.

(j) Notwithstanding the rights and privileges provided by this part, this part does not limit the right of an agency to discipline or to pursue criminal charges against an officer.

**(2) COMPLAINT REVIEW BOARDS** — A complaint review board shall be composed of three members: One member selected by the chief administrator of the agency or unit; one member selected by the aggrieved officer; and a third member to be selected by the other two members. Agencies or units having more than 100 law enforcement officers or correctional officers shall utilize a five-member board, with two members being selected by the administrator, two members being selected by the aggrieved officer, and the fifth member being selected by the other four members. The board members shall be law enforcement officers or

correctional officers selected from any state, county, or municipal agency within the county. There shall be a board for law enforcement officers and a board for correctional officers whose members shall be from the same discipline as the aggrieved officer. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to sheriffs or deputy sheriffs.

**(3) CIVIL SUITS BROUGHT BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OR CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS.**—Every law enforcement officer or correctional officer shall have the right to bring civil suit against any person, group of persons, or organization or corporation, or the head of such organization or corporation, for damages, either pecuniary or otherwise, suffered during the performance of the officer's official duties, for abridgment of the officer's civil rights arising out of the officer's performance of official duties, or for filing a complaint against the officer which the person knew was false when it was filed. This section does not establish a separate civil action against the officer's employing law enforcement agency for the investigation and processing of a complaint filed under this part.

**(4)(a) NOTICE OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION.**—A dismissal, demotion, transfer, reassignment, or other personnel action that might result in loss of pay or benefits or that might otherwise be considered a punitive measure may not be taken against any law enforcement officer or correctional officer unless the law enforcement officer or correctional officer is notified of the action and the reason or reasons for the action before the effective date of the action.

(b) Notwithstanding s. 112.533(2), whenever a law enforcement officer or correctional officer is subject to disciplinary action consisting of suspension with loss of pay, demotion, or dismissal, the officer or the officer's representative shall, upon request, be provided with a complete copy of the investigative file, including the final investigative report and all evidence, and with the opportunity to address the findings in the report with the employing law enforcement agency before imposing disciplinary action consisting of suspension with loss of pay, demotion, or dismissal. The contents of the complaint and investigation shall remain confidential until such time as the employing law enforcement agency makes a final determination whether or not to issue a notice of disciplinary action consisting of suspension with loss of pay, demotion, or dismissal. This paragraph does not provide law enforcement officers with a property interest or expectancy of continued employment, employment, or appointment as a law enforcement officer.

**(5) RETALIATION FOR EXERCISING RIGHTS.**—No law enforcement officer or correctional officer shall be discharged; disciplined; demoted; denied promotion, transfer, or

reassignment; or otherwise discriminated against in regard to his or her employment or appointment, or be threatened with any such treatment, by reason of his or her exercise of the rights granted by this part.

**(6) LIMITATIONS PERIOD FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS-**

(a) Except as provided in this subsection, disciplinary action, suspension, demotion, or dismissal may not be undertaken by an agency against a law enforcement officer or correctional officer for any act, omission, or other allegation of misconduct if the investigation of the allegation is not completed within 180 days after the date the agency receives notice of the allegation by a person authorized by the agency to initiate an investigation of the misconduct. If the agency determines that disciplinary action is appropriate, it shall complete its investigation and give notice in writing to the law enforcement officer or correctional officer of its intent to proceed with disciplinary action, along with a proposal of the specific action sought, including length of suspension, if applicable. Notice to the officer must be provided within 180 days after the date the agency received notice of the alleged misconduct, except as follows:

1. The running of the limitations period may be tolled for a period specified in a written waiver of the limitation by the law enforcement officer or correctional officer.
2. The running of the limitations period is tolled during the time that any criminal investigation or prosecution is pending in connection with the act, omission, or other allegation of misconduct.
3. If the investigation involves an officer who is incapacitated or otherwise unavailable, the running of the limitations period is tolled during the period of incapacitation or unavailability.
4. In a multijurisdictional investigation, the limitations period may be extended for a period of time reasonably necessary to facilitate the coordination of the agencies involved.
5. The running of the limitations period may be tolled for emergencies or natural disasters during the time period wherein the Governor has declared a state of emergency within the jurisdictional boundaries of the concerned agency.
6. The running of the limitations period is tolled during the time that the officer's compliance hearing proceeding is continuing beginning with the filing of the notice of violation and a request

for a hearing and ending with the written determination of the compliance review panel or upon the violation being remedied by the agency.

(b) An investigation against a law enforcement officer or correctional officer may be reopened, notwithstanding the limitations period for commencing disciplinary action, demotion, or dismissal, if:

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1. Significant new evidence has been discovered that is likely to affect the outcome of the investigation.

2. The evidence could not have reasonably been discovered in the normal course of investigation or the evidence resulted from the predisciplinary response of the officer.

**Any disciplinary action resulting from an investigation that is reopened pursuant to this paragraph must be completed within 90 days after the date the investigation is reopened.**

**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING A NON-CRIMINAL TRAFFIC INFRACTION NOT REQUIRING A COURT APPEARANCE**

If you were charged with a civil infraction, you must complete one of the following options within 30 calendar days of the date of this citation. If you fail to comply within 30 calendar days, your driving privilege will be suspended until you comply. You will then be subject to additional penalties. Please see the front of the citation for the contact information for the Clerk of Court in the county where this violation occurred.

**Option 1:** You may pay the civil penalty listed on the front of this citation to the Clerk of Court. You must enclose this citation if you mail payment, which may be a money order or a cashier's check. The clerk does not accept personal checks. Payment of the civil penalty is considered a conviction and points will be assessed, if applicable. You will be required to complete a driver improvement course if you are convicted of running a red light or passing a school bus. Your driving privilege will be suspended if you are convicted of not providing proof of insurance. Accumulation of points may increase the cost of your insurance.

**Option 2:** If you were cited for expired driver license, failure to display a valid driver license, expired tag, failure to possess a valid registration, or no proof of insurance, you may show proof to the Clerk of Court that you had a valid driver license, tag/registration, or insurance, whichever is applicable, at the time of the offense. The charge will be dismissed upon payment of a dismissal fee.

**Option 3:** If you were cited for driver license expired 6 months or less, expired tag 6 months or less, failure to display a valid driver license, failure to possess a valid registration, no proof of insurance, or driving while license suspended (see s. 322.34(10)(a), F.S.), you may elect to show proof of compliance to the Clerk of Court in the form of a valid driver license, registration, or proof of insurance, whichever is applicable. You may make only one such election per year and no more than three such elections in your lifetime. You must pay court costs and adjudication will be withheld.

**Option 4:** If you do not hold a commercial driver license, you may be eligible to elect to complete a Florida driver improvement course. You must contact the Clerk of Court to make this election. You may make only one such election per year and no more than five elections in your lifetime. Please visit [www.flhsmv.gov](http://www.flhsmv.gov) for a list of approved courses and to determine your eligibility for this election. Adjudication will be withheld and points will not be assessed. You must pay a civil penalty and court costs. This option is not available for certain traffic offenses, including driver license, tag, and registration violations. Completion of a driver improvement course is required if you are cited for running a red light/traffic control device, even if you do not make this election.

**Option 5:** You may elect a court hearing by contacting the Clerk of Court. If you request a hearing and the County Judge/Magistrate/Hearing Officer determines that you have committed the offense, the County Judge/Magistrate/Hearing Officer may impose a penalty of up to \$500 (or \$1000 if a fatality occurred) and/or require completion of a driver improvement course. Points may be assessed. If it is determined that no infraction has been committed, no cost or penalties shall be imposed.

**Option 6:** If you were cited with a non-criminal violation of operating a motor vehicle in an unsafe condition (s. 316.610 F.S.) or not properly equipped (s. 316.610, F.S. or s. 316.2935, F.S.), you may have the defect corrected, then contact your local county or city law enforcement agency to have the correction certified below. You must pay the local law enforcement agency \$\_\_\_\_\_ for this service. You may then mail or present this affidavit of compliance along with \$\_\_\_\_\_ to the Clerk of Court within 30 calendar days of the date of this citation. No points will be assessed. This option does not apply to a commercial motor vehicle or a transit bus owned by a governmental entity.


