

1 On 02-10-2015 at approximately 2145 hours the Daytona Beach Police Department responded to Dr Mary McCloud Bethune Boulevard and Lincoln 2 Street in reference to a traffic crash with injuries (DBPD #20150002559). At approximately 2150 hours the Daytona Beach Police Department 3 received a call from the second party of the crash, [REDACTED] advised that she was involved in the crash and she had driven to her 4 house to report the crash because her phone was dead. As a result of the investigation Officer Connelly made the decision to arrest [REDACTED] for 5 leaving the scene of a crash with injuries. Officer Connelly handcuffed [REDACTED] behind the back and she was eventually placed in the rear of Officer 6 Larry Jones' vehicle. 7 8 At approximately 2224 hours Officer Jones advised dispatch that he was enroute to Valor Boulevard with a female. At 2242 hours Officer Jones sent 9 the dispatcher a message stating "I moved t15 handcuffs to the front because she was complaining of her wrist hurt. t15 began yelling and 10 screaming. Code 4. Back en route to station". At 2303 hours Officer Jones sent a second message to the dispatcher via computer stating "did you get 11 my message?" At 1104 hours the dispatcher responded via computer "I was on break". Officer Jones replied "t4. No biggy. Thanks." At 1105 hours 12 the dispatcher sent Officer Jones a message via computer "Do you need me to put the comments in the call?" At 1105 hours Officer Jones replied 13 stating "t54. I shouldn't just in case someone asks why I stopped on my way to Valor. At 2303 hours Officer Jones arrived at Valor with [REDACTED]. 14 [REDACTED] was then processed and transported to the Volusia County Branch Jail. 15

16 While being processed at the Volusia County Branch Jail [redacted] advised that she had been sexually assaulted by Officer Jones and that he had
 17 grabbed her breast. Detective Draugelat, Sergeant Donald and Officer Connolly responded to the jail and conducted an interview with [redacted] in the
 18 sally port. [redacted] advised that while enroute to Valor Officer Jones pulled off of Mason Avenue on two occasions. [redacted] described the first area
 19 as being the first driveway just after Mason Avenue goes from two lanes to one lane. [redacted] advised at that time Officer Jones got out of his vehicle
 20 momentarily and had her place her feet outside the vehicle. At that point Officer Jones made her put her feet back in the vehicle and she advised
 21 they traveled west on Mason Avenue for a very short distance. At that point Officer Jones pulled into a driveway on the left (south) and had her exit
 22 the vehicle. While outside the vehicle Officer Jones asked [redacted] if she had anything on her. [redacted] advised that she had already been searched.
 23 According to [redacted] Jones state he had to make sure she did not have anything on her before he switched the handcuffs. [redacted] advised that
 24 Officer Jones then reached under her shirt and caressed her breast and then rubbed her legs all the way up to her vagina. At that point Officer Jones
 25 removed his flashlight from his belt, pulled her pants and underwear away from her and flashed the light down the front and back of her body.
 26 [redacted] advised that Officer Jones then removed the handcuffs and pushed her against the vehicle and continued to rub her legs like he was
 27 searching her. [redacted] advised at that point she began to crying. [redacted] further advised that during the incident Officer Jones removed her belly
 28 button ring from her belly button. [redacted] advised that during the incident Officer Jones never penetrated her but she could feel his penis on her
 29 buttocks area. It should be noted both parties were clothed during this incident. [redacted] advised that at some point during the incident Officer Jones
 30 was on his cell phone with an unknown person.

31 It was verified through an interview with Sergeant Webber about the incident that Officer Jones contacted him at some point from phone number
 32 [redacted]

33 On 2-11-2015 the Forcewatch Activity log was checked for Officer Jones' vehicle. The log revealed that at 23:30:42 Officer Jones' vehicle just west of
 34 the intersection of Mason Avenue and Bill France Boulevard traveling at approximately 28.7 mph. At 10:30:56 seconds Officer Jones is near or in
 35 front of Gambro Healthcare traveling at approximately 30 mph. At 10:33:02 seconds Officer Jones is at or near Terminex located at 1838 Mason
 36 Avenue traveling at approximately 25.1 mph. At approximately 10:35:23 seconds Officer Jones is located at or near AT&T located at 1861 Mason
 37 Avenue showing stationary. At 10:39:44 seconds Officer Jones is still located at or near AT&T and stationary. At 10:42:26 Officer Jones is at or near
 38 Fentress Avenue and Mason Avenue traveling westbound at approximately 39.6 mph.

39 On 02-11-2015 Crime Scene Investigator Tom Youngman processed Officer Jones' vehicle (#5323) for any potential evidence. Crime Scene
 40 Technician Youngman advised after processing the vehicle his was unable to locate any evidence. The Mobil Data Terminal (MDT) assigned to
 41 Officer Jones' vehicle was turned over to Detective Tim Ehrenkauf for analysis.

42 On 02-11-2015 Detective Deschamps and I reviewed the video surveillance located in the sally port at the Daytona Beach Police Department. The
 43 video surveillance indicates that Officer Jones arrived at the police station sally port at 2244 hours according to the time on the video. Inside the sally
 44 port with Jones was Officer Rod Harris, the prisoner transport wagon operator. At 2247 hours according to the time Officer Jones has [redacted] exit
 45 the vehicle. At approximately 2250 hours according to the time Sergeant Stephanie Donald is seen walking into the sally port and contacting Officer
 46 Jones, Officer Harris and [redacted]. At that point Officer Harris walks [redacted] to the holding cell area so she can use the restroom facilities. There is
 47 no audio outside in the sally port so it is unknown what conversation is taking place while in the sally port. While [redacted] is inside the facility however
 48 there is both audio and video. [redacted] has a small conversation with Officer Harris in reference to the restroom facility and later about having to wear
 49 handcuffs but never mentions anything about any sexual misconduct that had allegedly taken place prior to her arrival in the sally port. At 2254
 50 Officer Harris returns [redacted] to the sally port. At 2255 according to the time [redacted] is placed into the transport van and the door is shut. At 2258
 51 hours according to the time Officer Jones has [redacted] sign the property sheet. At 2301 hours according to the time the van exits the sally port. The
 52 transport van makes a stop at the beachside precinct to pick up additional prisoners before being driven to the Volusia County Branch Jail.

53 On 02-11-2015 Detective Deschamps and I reviewed the surveillance video recorded in Officer Harris' transport wagon (#5220) on the night of the
 54 incident. When [redacted] is placed into the transport wagon she makes the statement "I'm gonna sue your ass for a check, you best believe it, the
 55 bitch was in my panties". At 23:08 hours Officer Jones requests [redacted] to sign the property sheet. [redacted] states "what is it?" Officer Jones replies
 56 "This is saying this is all your property". [redacted] responds "Let me read it because I don't trust you Officer Jones". Officer Jones replies "Ok, sorry
 57 you don't trust me". [redacted] responds "I don't see my scarf on here". Officer Jones replies "You don't see it m-yeah, show me". [redacted] responds
 58 "You may want to steal my scarf". Officer Jones asks "Is it Brown / Tan". [redacted] responds "I don't know you the officer you tell me". Officer Jones
 59 replies "Let me see that again, sign right here for me". [redacted] replies "Nah, I need to read it again look you are dropping my merchandise, now I
 60 have to make sure you got all my merchandise". Officer Jones replies "It's right there, it's all right there ok, it's all in there, here ya go." [redacted]
 61 states "Where am I signing at homeboy" Officer Jones replies "Right next to the x please and thank you". [redacted] states "You really aren't welcome

67 cause you tried to act like you were gonna help me but you did not help me" Officer Jones replies "I really did". [redacted] replies "You didn't though
68 what you do I didn't hear you try" Officer Jones states "I called, I did call". Shortly thereafter Officer Jones closes the wagon doors. [redacted] then
69 states "What the fuck I look like, ant run game on me bitch, I'm a Criminal Justice Major". "They're gonna have a lawsuit in the morning for fucking
70 rape so they better be prepared." "I'm going to write as soon as I get out this bitch I'm going to file my report for rape". "Bitch gonna stop down the
71 street and check all in my clothes and pull my draws down, think I'm fucking stupid" "Hurry up and send my fucking ass to jail because as soon as I
72 get my ass free I'm going to file my sexual harassment and rape charge, you got me fucked up".

73
74 On 02-11-2015 Detective Deschamps and I conducted an audio interview with Sergeant Stephanie Donald in the Criminal Investigations conference
75 room located at the police department. After swearing Sergeant Donald in the following information was obtained. Sergeant Donald was working as
76 shift supervisor on 02-10-2105. Sergeant Donald advised that she responded to 780 North Street to conduct a female search of [redacted] Sergeant
77 Donald advised that she conducted the search and pulled a piece of paper from [redacted] pocket and placed it on the trunk of the vehicle. After the
78 search she got back into her vehicle and drove to the station. While at the station she was in the Sally port signing off on another officer's paperwork.
79 Sergeant Donald advised that she walked back inside the station when she was contacted by Officer Jones and asked to come to meet him in the
80 Sally port. Sergeant Donald advised that after a few minutes she walked outside and made contact with Officer Jones. While talking with Officer
81 Jones [redacted] yelled from the backseat that she had to use the restroom. Sergeant Donald advised that she directed Officer Harris to take [redacted]
82 to the restroom and she would wait right there. Officer Harris took [redacted] to the bathroom and left prior to her return. Sergeant Donald stated that
83 [redacted] was very verbal about why she was arrested but she did not recall anything else she stated. Sergeant Donald confirmed that she did not
84 take anything else from [redacted] when she did her search and could not recall if she had any jewelry to include a belly button ring. Sergeant Donald
85 advised about 30 minutes later she heard Sergeant Webber on the phone with Officer Jones. Sergeant Webber had advised Officer Jones to do a
86 supplement in reference to a complaint about someone's handcuffs. Sergeant Donald advised she had contacted Officer Jones about a different
87 matter when he advised her of what Sergeant Webber had requested her do in reference to a complaint about handcuffs. Sergeant Donald directed
88 Officer Jones to do whatever Sergeant Webber had directed him to do. Sergeant Donald then was contacted about the allegations and was briefed
89 by Lt. Eisner. After a short meeting with Lt. Eisner, Sergeant Donald responded to the Volusia County Branch Jail with Detective Draugelat and Kevin
90 Connolly who was equipped with an Axon camera. [redacted] advised her that as they were driving to the station Officer Jones pulled off into a parking
91 lot near Bill France and Mason Avenue. Officer Jones tried to get her out of the vehicle but she did not respond. [redacted] advised Sergeant Donald
92 that he began typing something on the computer and she asked him why he was not being truthful. [redacted] then advised that they traveled a little
93 ways down the road and pulled off the road again. [redacted] advised Sergeant Donald that Officer Jones pulled her out of the car to change her cuffs.
94 [redacted] advised Sergeant Donald that Officer Jones groped her breast and was saying he was searching her. Sergeant Donald advised [redacted]
95 stated to her that it was not like when she was searching her he really was trying to get in there. Sergeant Donald advised that [redacted] advised that
96 Officer Jones rubbed her crotch and her legs and took his flashlight and looked in her pants. [redacted] further stated that Officer Jones pushed her
97 against the car and rubbed his penis on her buttocks area to the point she could feel his penis. After this took place he placed her back in the car and
98 drove her to the Sally port. Sergeant Donald advised that she took this information back to Lt. Eisner. Sergeant Donald advised that she did not have
99 other conversations with Officer Jones about the incident and sat with him while he typed a report on her computer. Sergeant Donald advised she got
100 one other call from Officer Jones after he had been relieved of duty but the call was answered in the presence of Sergeant Chirco. Sergeant Donald
101 advised Officer Jones what [redacted] was saying. Sergeant Donald advised that she could not talk with him about it. See audio interview for further
102 details.

103
104 On 02-11-2015 I conducted an audio recorded interview with Sergeant Rick Webber, who was working off-duty at the Daytona International
105 Speedway. After swearing Sergeant Webber in, the following information was obtained. Sergeant Webber was working on the night of 02-10-2015 as
106 a road supervisor. Sergeant Webber advised that he was aware of an investigation being conducted in reference to traffic crash with injuries but did
107 not respond to the scene himself. Sergeant Webber advised he was in the office doing paperwork when he received a call from Officer Larry Jones at
108 his desk. Sergeant Webber advised that Officer Jones advised him that the [redacted], who was the driver of the vehicle that fled the scene, was "out of
109 control". Officer Jones advised Sergeant Webber that the [redacted] was complaining of wrist and shoulder pain and was threatening to bring a lawsuit
110 against the city. Sergeant Webber advised that the conversation over the phone lasted only 30 to 40 seconds and he could not hear anyone in the
111 background. Sergeant Webber did not know what time the phone call took place and Officer Jones never mentioned anything about [redacted] making
112 sexual misconduct claims against him. Sergeant Webber further advised that he never directed Officer Jones to take [redacted] to the hospital and as
113 far as he believed the phone call made by Officer Jones was being made from the scene of the arrest at 780 North Street. According to Sergeant
114 Webber, Officer Jones never mentioned to him that he stopped anywhere while transporting [redacted] to the police department. Sergeant Webber
115 stated when Officer Jones was taken off the street and brought into the office after the allegation had been made, Officer Jones did not ask him any
116 questions and Jones made no statements to him. Sergeant Webber advised that he had little involvement in the incident however did review the
117 supplemental report completed by Officer Jones.

 119 The statement provided by Sergeant Webber was consistent with the statement he provided to Detective Draugelat earlier in the morning in
 120 reference to this incident. The audio video statement obtained by detective Draugelat and the audio recorded statement I obtained were tagged into
 121 the property and evidence section of the Daytona Beach Police Department. See Sergeant Webber's statements for further details.

122
 123 On 02-11-2015 Detective Draugelat completed a Supplemental Report in reference to this incident. The report was written under Daytona Beach
 124 Case #20150002559. Detective Draugelat advised that he was contacted by Lt. Mark Eisner in reference to a female prisoner was reporting sexual
 125 misconduct. While in Lt. Eisner's office Officer Jones walked in. Detective Draugelat advised Lt. Eisner asked Officer Jones if he drove straight from
 126 the scene from North Street to the station. According to Detective Draugelat Jones advised that he pulled over on Clyde Morris after the prisoner was
 127 complaining that the handcuffs were hurting her. According to Detective Draugelat Lt. Eisner advised him to go find the exact address he pulled over
 128 at and Officer Jones returned a short time later and advised 1861 Mason Avenue. Detective Draugelat advised he then went to the Volusia County
 129 Branch Jail and assisted Sergeant Donald with the interview conducted with [redacted]. Detective Draugelat advised after that interview he conducted
 130 an audio / recorded interview with Sergeant Webber at the station. Sergeant Webber advised him that he had received a phone call from Officer
 131 Jones. Officer Jones advised Sergeant Webber that [redacted] was upset over her arrest and that she was going to sue the city. Sergeant Webber
 132 advised to document the incident. Detective Draugelat advised he then turned the interview over to Sergeant James Chirco who advised him that he
 133 would hand it over to Sergeant Scott Goss. See Detective Draugelat's supplement for further details.

134
 135 On 02-11-2015 Detective Deschamps and I conducted an audio interview with Officer Rod Harris at the Daytona Beach Kennel Club where he was
 136 working off-duty. After swearing Officer Harris in, the following statement was obtained. Officer Harris advised that he was the transport driver for
 137 wagon #5220 on the night of 02-10-2015. Officer Harris [redacted] never made any direct statements to him concerning anything that had happened
 138 prior to her being placed in the back of the wagon. Officer Harris advised once at the Volusia County Branch Jail [redacted] advised him that her belly
 139 button ring was missing. Officer Harris advised [redacted] told her that Officer Jones had the property or took it off her but could not be certain. Officer
 140 Harris then clarified and advised [redacted] stated they took her property. Officer Harris advised that while at the station and prior to entering the
 141 transport wagon Officer Jones removed a head scarf and a pair of earrings from her. Officer Harris went on to advise that he thinks Officer Jones
 142 stated to him that [redacted] still had a belly button ring in her pocket on her person still. Officer Harris advised that [redacted] pocket was never
 143 checked and he never saw the belly button ring. Officer Harris advised while Officer Jones had [redacted] sign the property sheet Officer Jones
 144 dropped her property bag and she made the statement that he was dropping her things. Officer Harris stated the only thing that fell from the property
 145 bag was her earrings which were recovered and placed back in the bag. Officer Harris advised while he was cleaning out the van he located a pink
 146 ball and a series of "stones" mixed in with the vomit in the rear of the van where [redacted] was located. Officer Harris advised that he pulled a case
 147 number and tagged them into evidence as found property. See case Officer Harris' case #20150002575 for further details. Officer Harris clarified and
 148 advised that he located the belly button ring while still at the jail and notified the jail staff however they would not take the ring because they had
 149 already signed the sheet. Officer Harris advised that [redacted] was standing next to the jailer when this conversation took place and stated to him that
 150 she never took her belly button ring off. Near the end of Officer Harris' statement he advised that he had a conversation with Officer Jones on tac
 151 channel 1 in reference to the belly button ring. Officer Harris stated Officer Jones advised that the belly button ring was on her person or in her
 152 pocket. See audio recorded statement for further details.

153
 154 The radio transmissions Officer Harris spoke about on TAC Channel 1 was obtained. Officer Harris initially asked Officer Connelly about the missing
 155 belly button ring. Officer Connelly advised that Officer Harris needed to get with Officer Jones because he was the one who transported him. Officer
 156 Harris contacted Officer Jones over the radio asked about the belly button ring missing but written on the property sheet. Officer Jones replied that "It
 157 was in her pocket or something like that". Officer Harris replied "So you say it was in her pocket?" Officer Jones replied "You say what now" Officer
 158 Jones asks "Did they get it?" Officer Harris replies "No". Officer Jones replies "It was in her pocket that was about it she, she had it in her pocket".
 159 Officer Harris acknowledged and stated 10-4. Officer Jones then stated again "She had it in her pocket that is all I can tell you".

160
 161 On 02-11-2015 at 0235 hours Officer Larry Jones completed a Supplemental Report in reference to this case as directed by Sergeant Webber.
 162 Officer Jones stated while traveling to the station [redacted] stated to him several times that she had a job and that if she did not show up she would be
 163 fired. Officer Jones further stated that while in the back of the patrol car [redacted] stated multiple times "I'll do whatever you want, just please let me
 164 go I have to work tomorrow. Just tell them I ran away, just let me go". Officer Jones stated that [redacted] cried and complained of back, shoulder, and
 165 wrist pain because of the handcuffs. Officer Jones stated at that point [redacted] became silent and then woke crying heavily stating to let her go.
 166 Officer Jones stated that [redacted] advised that she had done nothing wrong and that there would be a big lawsuit in the morning. Officer Jones
 167 advised that [redacted] began stating again that she was in pain because of the handcuffs. Officer Jones stated that he stopped at 1861 Mason
 168 Avenue to adjust [redacted] handcuffs meaning moving them from the back to the front. Officer Jones advised while doing this [redacted] cried heavily

169 and stated multiple times that she had a job she did not want to lose. Officer Jones stated also during this time [redacted] asked him for help multiple
 170 times and to let her go. Officer Jones explained to [redacted] that she was under arrest and was not free to leave. Officer Jones advised that after
 171 moving the handcuffs from the back to the front [redacted] complied and got back into his patrol vehicle. Officer Jones stated [redacted] did not resist in
 172 any way. Officer Jones stated once at the station Sergeant Donald walked outside to allow [redacted] to use the bathroom. When [redacted] returned he
 173 advised that he attempted to remove [redacted] scarf from her hair. Officer Jones stated [redacted] pushed his hand away. Officer Jones advised that
 174 [redacted] stated to him that she was going to file a lawsuit because she was wrongfully arrested. Officer Jones attempted a second time to remove
 175 [redacted] scarf. [redacted] stated to Officer Jones not to pull it and to treat her like he would treat his mother. Officer Jones then advised that [redacted]
 176 took the scarf off her head and he assisted her with taking her earrings out without incident. Officer Jones advised that he completed her property
 177 sheet and took it to [redacted] to sign it. Officer Jones advised he mistakenly dropped her property but picked it up and put it all back inside the
 178 property bag. Officer Jones advised that [redacted] stated that she did not even know what was in the bag anymore and that her stuff is probably
 179 missing. Officer Jones allowed [redacted] to check the bag and verified that everything was in the property bag. Officer Jones advised that [redacted]
 180 signed the property sheet and stated "I thought you were supposed to be helping me Officer Jones, I guess you don't care about me huh, I thought
 181 that you were supposed to be trying to help me. But it's ok because tomorrow I'm going to file a lawsuit. Officer Jones advised at that point he closed
 182 the transport wagon doors.

184 I reviewed the Prisoner Property form completed by Officer Jones the night of the incident and signed by [redacted]. The property listed on the form is a
 185 set of earrings, a scarf and a belly button ring. Written in the description of the property is the sentence Belly button ring not in the property bag. It
 186 was confirmed by Detective Deschamps that Officer Harris wrote that statement after learning the belly button ring was missing.

188 On 02-12-2015 [redacted] contacted me at the Daytona Beach Police Department. I conducted an audio / video recorded interview with [redacted].
 189 After swearing [redacted] in, the following information was provided. [redacted] advised that she was handcuffed at her house with her hands behind her
 190 back. [redacted] advised that after being placed in Officer Jones' vehicle she was speaking to her mother who had arrived on scene. [redacted] advised
 191 that prior to ending the conversation Officer Jones drove away. [redacted] advised that they traveled west on North Street towards Nova Road. Once at
 192 Nova Road Officer Jones made a right turn onto Nova Road and traveled north towards Mason Avenue. Once at Mason Avenue Officer Jones made
 193 a left turn to travel west on Mason Avenue. [redacted] advised that while traveling on Nova road Officer Jones tried to talk to her. [redacted] advised
 194 Officer Jones was asking what had happened and what was going on. [redacted] advised Officer Jones that he wasn't helping her and he was just
 195 taking her to jail. According to [redacted] Officer Jones replied that he was trying to help her but the decision had been made to take her to jail and he
 196 was not the arresting officer. [redacted] advised at that time she got quiet. [redacted] advised just after Mason Avenue changes from two lanes to one
 197 lane Officer Jones began to pull into either the first or second driveway on the right. [redacted] asked Officer Jones what he was doing. Officer Jones
 198 stated to her that he was about to move her handcuffs from the back to the front. [redacted] advised that Jones then began to type on his computer
 199 something to the effect of arrestee complained of handcuffs hurting moved them from the back to the front. [redacted] states to Officer Jones
 200 something to the effect of why he was he lying. [redacted] stated she could remember seeing semi trucks at this location. [redacted] then stated Officer
 201 Jones exited the vehicle and walked to the passenger side of the vehicle. Officer Jones opens the door and directs her to move from the rear driver's
 202 side of the vehicle to the rear passenger side. Anthony states that she puts her feet outside of the vehicle but does not get out. Officer Jones then
 203 closes the door and walks back to the front of the vehicle, and enters the driver's seat. [redacted] stated at about that time Officer Jones received a call
 204 from someone and the conversation he had with that person was in reference to the victims of the crash and what they went hospital for. [redacted]
 205 advised at that point Officer Jones turned right front where they were at and traveled approximately 30 seconds to a business located on the left side
 206 of the road. [redacted] believed that the name of the business was "Gambro".

208 [redacted] advised that on this second stop Officer Jones exited the vehicle and walked to the rear of vehicle where she was sitting on the passenger
 209 side. Officer Jones directed [redacted] to exit the vehicle. [redacted] advised she complied and exited the vehicle. [redacted] advised at that point Officer
 210 Jones directed her to the side of the vehicle and asked her if she had anything on her. [redacted] responded that she did not have anything on her and
 211 that she had already been searched by an officer at her house. [redacted] stated at that point Officer Jones, who was standing behind her at this point,
 212 placed his hands under her shirt and bra and began to caress her breast. [redacted] advised at that point Officer Jones removed his hands from under
 213 her shirt and removed his flashlight from his belt. Officer Jones at that point asked [redacted] again are you sure you don't have anything on you.
 214 [redacted] stated again that she did not have anything on her and she had already been checked. According to [redacted] at that point Officer Jones pulls
 215 her pants from her body and flashed his flashlight down the front and back of her pants. [redacted] advised that at that point Officer Jones removed her
 216 belly button ring from her stomach. After removing the belly button ring from her [redacted] advised Officer Jones placed it in the pocket of his jacket.
 217 Officer Jones then removes her handcuffs from behind her back and places them in front of her. According to [redacted] Officer Jones asked her again
 218 if she was sure that she did not have anything on her to which she replied again that she did not. [redacted] advised at this point Officer Jones had her
 219 against the car with her rear end facing him. [redacted] advised that Officer Jones then began to caress her rear end with his penis. [redacted] stated that

220 it kind of turned her on. [redacted] stated at that she broke down and began to cry and stated that she asked Officer Jones that she thought he was
 221 trying to help her. Officer Jones stated that he tried but they were arresting her and placed her in the rear of the vehicle. After Officer Jones placed
 222 her back inside the vehicle [redacted] advised that he began to type on his computer that the inmate or arrestee began yelling and screaming. [redacted]
 223 asked why he was not being truthful and he replied to her that she had gotten rowdy again. [redacted] stated that at that point they began to travel
 224 again on Mason Avenue eventually arriving at the police department. Once inside the jail port area [redacted] advised that Officer Jones removed her
 225 head scarf and her earrings. After using the restroom [redacted] was placed in the back of the transport vehicle. [redacted] advised that after entering the
 226 van Officer Jones asked her to sign her property sheet. [redacted] advised that the only thing indicated on the sheet was her scarf and earrings.
 227 [redacted] asked Jones where her belly button ring was at. According to [redacted] Officer Jones just told her to sign the property sheet. [redacted] asked
 228 when she got to the jail where her belly button ring was and further advised that the jailers looked through her property and advised them that it was
 229 not with her. [redacted] advised while at the jail she asked the female guard what she should do if she had been sexually assaulted.

230
 231 [redacted] described her belly button ring as being pink in color and further described it as a silver half moon shaped ring with two pink balls. [redacted]
 232 stated that she never complained to Officer Jones that her handcuffs were hurting her. [redacted] stated that Officer Jones never made any statements
 233 to her during the incident. [redacted] further advised that she thought it was strange for it to be happening but she let it happen anyways. [redacted]
 234 stated that she was originally not going to say anything because she believed everyone was going to take Officer Jones' side. [redacted] confirmed that
 235 she and Officer Jones were both clothed at the time of the incident and at no time did Officer Jones insert anything into her body. During the interview
 236 Detective Deschamps and I had Ms. [redacted] take us to the locations she mentions in her interview. Ms. Jones stated and showed and told us the
 237 addresses to be 1820 Mason Avenue (Frito Lay) and 1845 Mason Avenue (Gambro) for the second stop. It should be noted that the 1845 Mason
 238 Avenue is directly to the west of the location confirmed by GPS. This was audio recorded and tagged into evidence. During this time Ms. [redacted]
 239 also described the actions Officer Jones took during the incident.

240
 241 During transport Ms. [redacted] could be observed retrieving something from her pocket. This was learned during the interview to be the ball of belly
 242 button ring. This ball was recovered from the floor of the transport van by Officer Rod Harris. Ms. [redacted] states in her interview that Officer Jones
 243 put it there during the second stop. Additionally she adds that he placed the actual ring part itself in either his right jacket or pants pocket.

244
 245 It should be noted that the van was checked for any additional evidence by Sergeant Goss. Utilizing a camera "snake" the crevices of the seats and
 246 any open area were checked. No ring was located nor was any additional items.

247
 248 On 02-13-2015 Detective Tim Ehrenkaufar obtained the locally stored AVL transmittal log from the computer assigned to Officer Jones' vehicle and
 249 utilized by Officer Jones the night of the incident. The data stored and captured provided within the computer store time, date, and speed as well as
 250 up to the second latitude and longitude coordinates. The information gathered is updated twice a second (2 pings a second). The information data
 251 stored within the computer is more accurate than the data stored within the Forcewatch System. At 22:31:09 seconds Officer Jones is shown
 252 stationary in the driveway of Florida Contractor Rentals located at 1830 Mason Avenue. The latitude and longitude coordinates indicate the vehicle is
 253 stationary near the entry exit gate of the business. At 22:32:41 seconds Officer Jones' vehicle is no longer stationary and mobile once again. At
 254 22:32:24 seconds Officer Jones' vehicle is stationary in the driveway of AT&T located at 1861 Mason Avenue. At 22:42:12 seconds Officer Jones'
 255 vehicle is no longer stationary and traveling once again. At 22:43:11 seconds Officer Jones' vehicle arrives at the Daytona Beach Police Department
 256 located at 129 Valor Boulevard. The time elapsed from the first stop at 1830 Mason Avenue and arrival, second stop at 1861 Mason Avenue and
 257 arrival to the Daytona Beach Police department is 11 minutes and 3 seconds. The distance traveled from 1861 Mason Avenue, where Officer Jones
 258 advised that he stopped to change the handcuffs from the front to the back, to the Daytona Beach Police Department is approximately 0.5 miles or
 259 2,640 feet according to Google Maps. The time it took Officer Jones to travel this distance in his police car was 59 seconds.

260 The locations of the stops made by Officer Jones were checked for video of the incident. All location yielded no video of any evidentiary value.
 261
 262 It should be noted that Officer Jones never dictated over police radio his status change, nor the fact that he was stopping. Additionally he never
 263 indicated on the radio that his prisoner was combative and/or making complaints of any nature to warrant his stop.

264
 265 Based on the culmination of evidence in this investigation it is believed that Officer Jones deviated from accepted and directed departmental
 266 responsibility as prescribed below.

267
 268 704.1 All prisoners/detainees will be handcuffed behind the back, except once released to the custody of the transport wagon personnel, where they
 269 will be handcuffed in the front, unless obviously injured or disabled prisoners. Under no circumstances shall a prisoner be secured to any portion of a
 270 vehicle, and shall not be transported in vehicles without a cage, with the exception of CID personnel and command personnel. (see CID procedures

273 704.7 Prisoners/detainees will be handcuffed behind the back, except when released to the transport wagon personnel where they will be handcuffed
 274 in the front, unless obviously injured or disabled, and are not be secured to any portion of the vehicle. Each prisoner/detainee will be searched for
 275 weapons and contraband prior to transport. Prisoners/detainees shall not be left unattended in police vehicles or at other locations and
 276 prisoners/detainees shall not use the officer's locker room.

277

278 704.10 Transporting officers shall search prisoners and transporting vehicles, including assigned and unassigned vehicles thoroughly, prior to and
 279 after prisoner transport. Officers will not search prisoners/detainees of the opposite sex. The on-duty supervisor shall be contacted to locate an officer
 280 of the same sex as the prisoner/detainee to perform the search. If none can be found, the search should be made in the presence of a supervisor or
 281 another officer as a witness and documented. This search should exclude the breast and genital areas. If necessary, a supervisor shall call and wait
 282 upon a member of the opposite gender to perform this search, including the calling in from another district, or agency immediately contact the on-duty
 283 supervisor if there is a disagreement as to the completeness or accuracy of the prisoner/detainee property sheet.

284

285 704.17 When any transport officer transports prisoners/detainees of the opposite sex, officers shall notify dispatch via radio prior to transporting. The
 286 following, shall be given: starting location, number of prisoners being transported, adult or juvenile, sex of the prisoners, starting mileage, and upon
 287 arrival the, ending mileage.

288

289 704.64 Restraining and/or transporting sick or injured prisoners/detainees shall be handled in the following manner. Any prisoner/detainee
 290 complaining of sickness or injury, or who appears to be sick or injured whether complaining or not, will be treated as follows:

291

292 310.63 The use of terminal messages must be restricted. Terminal messages are designed for car-to-car-transitory information using the MSG
 293 command and shall not be directed to Telecommunicators. Do not use a terminal message (MSG) to make any type of official request for which
 294 action will need to be taken. Often, the message is not read immediately, the screen has been cleared, or a personnel change has taken place.

295

296 310.64 All requests will be made by voice radio transmission so that they are "time stamped" for logging purposes.

297

298 All statements obtained within this report have been sworn to and stored for evidentiary keeping.

299

300 Based on the statement proved by Ms. [REDACTED] Officer Jones touched her in a sexual manner against her will while she was handcuffed thus
 301 detaining her in a manner inconsistent with police operations. Officer Jones had deviated from his official duties at this time and was operating
 302 beyond the scope and guidelines of the Daytona Beach Police Department.

303

304 In addition Officer Jones removed jewelry belonging to Ms. [REDACTED] for unknown reason depriving her of such property indefinitely.

305

306 In documenting this incident Officer Jones falsified an official document as it relates to his whereabouts and transportation route on the night in
 307 question on the entire incident itself.

308

309 These three enumerated highlights have been set forth prior in this affidavit based on circumstances substantiated by the evidence obtained in this
 310 investigation.

311

312 On 2-12-2015 Officer Jones was contacted by Sergeant S. Goss at the Daytona Beach Police Department. Sergeant Goss advised Officer Jones he
 313 wished to obtain a statement in ref. to a criminal investigation. Officer Jones on the advice of his council declined to give a statement. A search
 314 warrant was then executed on his phone. Please see Detective Tim Ehrenkauffer's supplement for additional information.
