

After meeting with in this agency's lobby, I made contact with Detective Campbell, who I was advised was the lead detective assigned to this case. I provided Detective Campbell with a photocopy of sworn written statement and further advised her of my contact with her and of desire to pursue charges.

After this, I contacted the SAVS hotline. A sexual assault examination was scheduled for 3:45 pm, with for the SAVS South Brevard Center, Malabar, Florida. I was advised that SANS nurse, Barbra Bormen, RN, would be the nurse responding.

Once Detective Campbell completed her sworn video recorded interview with and controlled phone call, she asked if I could assist her by meeting at her mother's residence to seize the clothing she wore back to her mother's after Pill had allegedly sexually battered her.

EVIDENCE:

I next responded to Palm Bay, Brevard County, Florida 32909, and met with the residence. I followed to a back bedroom, located to the west of the residence, where she retrieved a white, with color tank top (NC6), a pair of blue jean shorts (NC5), and some green thong underwear (NC1). identified these items as the clothing she had worn while out with Pill and after the sexual battery. These items were entered into Palm Bay Police Property and Evidence.

SEXUAL ASSAULT EXAMINATION:

After retrieving this property, I advised I would meet her at the SAVS Center of South Brevard around 3:45 pm. She was provided with a map to the rape crisis center.

Upon my arrival to the SAVS Center of South Brevard, I made contact with both Victim's Advocate, Sarah Jackson, and the SANS's nurse, Barbra Bormen, RN. Moments after my arrival, along with her best friend arrived at the rape crisis center.

I stood by in center's lobby while RN Bormen conducted sexual assault examination. After the examination was completed, RN Bormen placed in my possession a sealed FDLE sexual assault kit, and a sealed FDLE toxicology kit. I provided RN Bormen with the yellow copy of the Palm Bay Police property receipt form, after I filled out the property description. I next responded back to Palm Bay Police Department with the evidence; and placed the FDLE toxicology kit (NC3) in evidence refrigerator locker number 001. I then placed the FDLE

CSI Miller placed this towel in another brown paper evidence bag. This detective had no further involvement with this case investigation.

I met with who stated the following in summary in a recorded sworn interview:

That she and Ryan had dated approximately 3 years ago and were an "on and off again" type couple. Ryan started dating his recent ex-girlfriend several years ago with whom he had a baby in February 2010. When Ryan broke up with his girlfriend and she moved to Ocala with their baby, and Ryan were talking about possibly getting back together but she was hesitant because of their history.

According to she and Ryan stayed platonic friends and in contact during the past three years that they were not a couple. also mentioned that they have engaged in consensual intercourse on occasion during this time span which included a consensual sexual encounter approximately a month to two months ago.

Because of Ryan's emotional state due to his girlfriend breaking up with him and taking their baby with her to Ocala, Florida, has been comforting him as a platonic friend. Ryan asked her to go out on June 23, 2011 since he "owed" her. elaborated that Ryan "owed" her because she had been helping him monetarily and had cleaned his apartment several times in the past.

According to Ryan picked her up from her mother's house and drove her to Meg O Malley's in Melbourne, Florida around 1700 hours. While at Meg O Malley's, they met Ryan's supervisors; Chief Jack King and Corporal Jason Wheeler. According to they drank a couple of beers each and then left at approximately 1900 hours to go to the "Premiere Oaks Theater" to watch the movie "Super 8" which started at 1920 hours.

After the movie was over (approximately 112 minutes later), Ryan drove her to his apartment within the city limits of Palm Bay so they could watch a movie and "hang out".

told Ryan that he took an oath as a cop to not do something like this, Ryan responded with "Yes I know; I can't tell you how bad I feel, like there's no way to explain, and I should feel this way". then asked how he would feel if this happened to his daughter to which he responded "I know, I know, I'm so so sorry." hen said "I can't believe as a cop you would rape me". Ryan responded. with I'm so sorry I didn't mean to".

The controlled phone ended shortly thereafter.

On June 23, 2011, Detective Caroffino accompanied to the Sexual Assault Victim Services Center located within Brevard County to submit to a sexual assault exam. See Detective Caroffino's supplement for details.

On June 23, 2011, I completed and executed a search warrant which was reviewed and approved by ASA David Koenig and subsequently signed by Judge B. Garagozlo. Crime Scene Technician Miller was assigned to take possession of the items that pertained to this investigation. See Crime Scene Technician Miller's supplement for details.

On June 23, 2011, Ryan made contact with me via cell phone and informed me that he wanted to meet with an attorney prior to speaking with me.

On June 27, 2011, Attorney Alan Landman made contact with me advising that he would be representing Ryan in regards to these allegations and to notify him in reference to this investigation if warranted.

On June 27, 2011, I made contact with Chief J. King and informed him of the allegations against Ryan to which he informed that on June 22, 2011, he met with Ryan and at Meg O Malley's. It appeared to Chief King that they were platonic friends since he didn't observe any signs of affectionate behavior between Ryan and

Chief King stated that he observed Ryan drink "a beer" but he may have had two. Chief King was adamant that they were not under the influence of alcohol when they left Meg O Malley's. Sergeant Wheeler went home to get ready to meet Chief King and Ryan Pill at Meg O' Malley's; however mentioned that when they were driving, Ryan said that he was bringing an ex-girlfriend to Meg O' Malley's. Sergeant Wheeler said that Ryan never mentioned if their relationship was sexual.

Ryan returned to Sergeant Wheeler's house with and they drove together to Meg O' Malley's. According to Sergeant Wheeler, during the ride, Ryan and seemed friendly but weren t touching each other. Sergeant Wheeler felt that they were acting somewhat of an uncomfortable first date. Sergeant Wheeler did mention that when they were at Meg O' Malley's, they all shared nachos and he knew that had one beer and one mixed drink and Ryan had two beer "guiness". Ryan and his baby's mother broke up in April or May of 2011 at which point he and began "talking" again since then.

Wheeler; they then drove together to Meg O' Malley's where they met Chief King.

While having vaginal sex, would him not to "go in me" which he interpreted it as not to ejaculate inside her vagina. Ryan then took his penis out of her vagina and ejaculated on the bed. Ryan grabbed a towel so could clean herself up and then they both went to sleep.

The next morning they both got up to alarm at which point Ryan drove her mom's house. Ryan said that they didn't converse in the car however when was getting out of the vehicle, she asked him if he respected her. When he left, Ryan received a text from the saying that he raped her.

Ryan denied ever telling him no or that she wasn't interested in sex, but did say that she was tired. Ryan also said that when he responded to the accusations (in the text) in the manner that he did (ie. Apologizing), Ryan said that it was because he didn't like

When confronted with the text messages and controlled phone call, Ryan had a visible reaction especially to the phone call. Ryan started tearing up and put his head in his hands while looking down. While he was looking down, Ryan was taking deep controlled breaths as if to calm down. Ryan's attorney didn't want Ryan to give a statement to the evidence until they conferred first. Upon return of their conversation, Ryan attained that he only said those things on the phone and the text messages because he wanted to comfort because she was in distress. Ryan also said that he wasn't sure who texted who first when I confronted him on the fact that he had initiated the text message dialogue which began with him apologizing. Ryan didn t have anything further to add and the interview was concluded shortly thereafter.

Based on the initial statement from the text message dialogue and the controlled phone call, there is sufficient probable cause to submit this case as a capias request to the State Attorney's Office with the charge of sexual battery.


