Good Morning / Afternoon:

VolusiaExposed.Com is currently evaluating documents for an pending article on a former BCSO deputy and Melbourne Village police officer, Ryan Pill.

We (VolusiaExposed) file this public record request for the following documents. All of these documents should be readily available, as is required by Florida State law.

According to a June 2011 Palm Bay PD criminal investigation, Officer Pill was a suspect in a sexual assault. Further, according to the PBPD report, MVPD Police Chief King and MVPD Sgt. Wheeler were listed as witnesses in this criminal investigation.

As per the requirements of Florida Statute 943.1395, and Florida Administrative Code 11B-27 – allegations of sexual assault by a law enforcement officer mandate the opening of an internal affairs investigation by the employing law enforcement agency.

The above governing mandates also requires the filing of certain documents to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement / Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission.

With that in mind – we (VolusiaExposed) request, under the authority of Florida Statute Chapter 119, the following public records.

1. The complete MVPD internal affairs investigation (to include supportive documentation) into the sexual assault allegations that were criminally investigated by the Palm Bay PD.
2. A copy of the CJSTC 78 form filed on this investigation.
3. A copy of the CJSTC 61 and 61A (if filed) regarding Officer Ryan Pill's departure from the MVPD.

The availability of these records is not only crucial to our (VolusiaExposed) review, but also to the credibility of the MVPD.

We ask you to recall the recent scandal attached to the West Melbourne PD's handling of an internal investigation of one of their ranking supervisors. Eventually, Police Chief Brian Locke was terminated from his position due to some perceived mishandling in that investigation.

Please advise us in advance of any cost that is associated with our public record request, and use our below listed email address as our point of contact.
