My wife and I have a joint savings account. I made two electronic transfers of \$25 000, on separate days, to my campaign account. Both were identified as loans to my campaign; one from my wife and one from me.

When I realized only the candidate can make loans to himself, I amended the report to show the loan which was originally identified as being from wife, was from me. My wife never signed a check as both loans were electronic transfers.

I amended my report and caught my clerical mistake before the complaint was received from the Florida Elections Commission. There was never any intent on my part to circumvent the rules or hide that I was loaning myself money for the campaign. By the way the entire loan has been repaid.

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to respond. My attorney has a much longer, detailed response, which he will be providing to the FEC.
