JoAnne:

Thanks for your (via Klare Ly's January 13, 2012 letter - see attached) response to our below January 9, 2012 public record request.

However, we wish to clarify our public records request in order to insure that your organization properly understands our public record request.

We are operating under the assumption that your organization honors it's requirements under Brady (Brady v. Maryland, 373 U.S. 83 (1963)).

With the above understood, we request any document(s), record(s), list(s), computer file(s), policies etc., that your organization maintains or relies on, to identify, track, or memorialize, current or past, law enforcement officers' backgrounds, that should the situation dictate, would mandate a Brady acknowledgement from your organization (7th Circuit - State Attorney Office, State of Florida).

If you have any further difficulties understanding the document(s) / record(s), in which we seek, we suggest you read the below media links attached to our original January 9th request, in which two other State Attorney's offices, within the State of Florida, have provided their records, attached to their Brady responsibilities.

Please be advised - not only do we wish to identify individuals that your organization has identified as possible reportable Brady admissions- but we also wish to better understand your organization's particular procedure / manner / process of complying with the mandates of Brady.

Lastly, we make a public record request for Klare Ly's email address within the 7th Circuit's State Attorney's office.
