Thanks for speaking on the telephone with me today regarding our (VolusiaExposed.Com) Public Record Request (PRR). Our request centers around any type of list your agency maintains to facilitate compliance with Brady v Maryland (US Supreme Court). Realizing that Brady is a very complex decision, we are just focusing our PRR on any list that the 7th SA has compiled or maintains, that focused on police officers that might have credibility / veracity concerns. (commonly referred to as a "Brady List")

As examples of what we are requesting, we present the following media articles which outlines PRRs from other similar website operators, to two different SA offices within Florida.
