		provided Inv. Campanella with the VCCF Record of Segregation / Special Inmate Watch forms related to Veira. The aforementioned forms are									
	26	commonly known as VCDC 52's. Veira was on special inmate watch and therefore VCDC 52's were to be completed each day and updated every									
	27	15 minutes. Inv. Campanella was provided with a roster of all VCCF employees' and some medical information. Inv. Campanella observed that									
		Veira was placed on a liquid diet on 09-12-2009 by Prison Health Services for 3 days. The exact cause for Veira being placed on a liquid diet was
