Central Dispatch of the call for service. The person making the alleged threats to do harm to himself was at University High School.

On 12/15/11, Investigator Ott was assigned this case for follow up. After reviewing the initial report, Investigator Ott proceeded to University High School and made contact with Assistant Principal DeVito (O3) regarding this case. DeVito stated on 11/28/11, he was approached by teacher, Blair, Adam (W2) regarding an observation he made involving a teacher Cobb, Stephanie (S1) and student [REDACTED] ((V1), hereinafter referred to as [REDACTED]) on 11/23/11. Blair told DeVito he came to the school on 11/23/2011 around 1:30 pm to meet with Cobb to give her the weight room key. Blair text messaged and phoned Cobb with negative results when he arrived on campus. The meeting had been prearranged between the two earlier in the day.

When Blair received no response from Cobb he decided to walk to her classroom. Blair was going to leave the key with a note on her desk. Blair was able to enter the locked hallway (Building 1C, second floor) where Cobb's classroom is located because a janitor (Reyes, Juan (W1)) was working there in the absence of students. (This particular day was a "no school" day where no one was required to be on campus with the exception of some Administrators). Reyes said to Blair "your wife is down there" and motioned towards Cobb's classroom. Blair thought this odd, but knows Cobb's husband and thought perhaps the custodian mistook him for Mr. Cobb. (The two have very similar physical characteristics according to DeVito and Blair).

Blair continued on his way not giving much thought to Reyes' statement and proceeded to Cobb's classroom #1C-203. Blair indicated the door was locked and no lights were on in the classroom. Blair knocked on the door and waited a few seconds with no response. Blair looked through the door's glass window pane but could not see anyone in the room. Blair left Cobb's door and walked back towards the exit on the courtyard side of the building. As Blair walked towards the end of the hallway, he noticed lights on in the classroom that adjoins Cobb's (#1C-200 which is currently assigned to Mrs. Lapnow). Blair could see through the door's glass pane and he observed [REDACTED] emerging from a middle office door. (The door is one of two that connect the classrooms). Blair waited at the door until [REDACTED] walked over to him and

opened the door. Blair asked if [redacted] knew where Cobb was and [redacted] replied, "She was here a little while ago but not now". Blair told [redacted] he had made arrangements to meet Cobb to pass off the weight room key and [redacted] grabbed the key from Blair's hand and said, "I'll give it to her". Blair took the key back and said he would give it to Cobb himself. [redacted] suggested to Blair the two go and check the weight room and other parts of the campus for Cobb. The two left together and Blair eventually ended up in DeVito's office after looking around campus for Cobb with negative results.

Blair contacted DeVito in the main office and had Cobb paged over the intercom to return to her room to meet Blair. Cobb was eventually located in the stairwell at the end of her hallway by Blair where he jokingly asked "where she was hiding" to which she replied defensively she "must have been in the restroom". Blair gave the key to Cobb as the two walked towards her classroom. After two or three minutes passed and the two conversed, [redacted] arrived back at Cobb's classroom. Blair left shortly thereafter around 1:45 pm.

According to DeVito, Blair approached him on 11/28/2011 and told him he did not know how to approach Cobb about the incident. Blair stated to DeVito he thought about the events on 11/23/11 and thought the appearance was inappropriate that Cobb had left a male student unattended in another teacher's classroom. DeVito and Blair both spoke of the incident and felt because Cobb was a new young teacher, she may not be aware of the perception of a female teacher being alone with a male student. DeVito suggested to Blair that he speak with Cobb and approach the incident on a teacher to teacher basis in a mentor fashion, as Blair did not observe anything more than a male student emerging from an adjoining classroom. Blair clarified he did not see Cobb in the classroom with [redacted] on 11/23/11.

According to DeVito, Blair approached Cobb on 11/29/2011 and felt her response inappropriate and defensive. When Blair was unable to locate DeVito, Blair approached Assistant Principal Pender, Craig (O2), on 11/30/2011, and explained the situation to him. Blair asked if there was anyway to find out if Cobb was in the classroom on 11/23/2011. Blair conveyed to Pender he felt there was no way Cobb had been in the restroom as she stated. Pender suggested they check the security cameras.

Pender and Blair proceeded to the security cameras and observed the same chain of events as previously documented with the exception of Cobb emerging from her classroom moments after Blair and ██████ walk away from the adjoining classroom together. This confirmed Cobb was in the classroom or the middle office area where ██████ emerged from. After viewing the footage of Cobb emerging from her classroom, Pender and Blair notified DeVito. Pender and DeVito researched several hours of video surveillance on 11/30/2011. The footage revealed Cobb leaving her classroom and letting ██████ into the locked school building on 11/23/2011.

The incident was ultimately brought to the attention of University High School Principal Neal Dennis (O7). During an Administrative meeting on 12/02/2011, Neal asked Assistant Principal Chenoweth, Karen (W/3) to look into the matter further and meet with Cobb to inquire about the incident. Chenoweth is the administrator responsible for teacher evaluations.

On 12/02/2011, Chenoweth met with Cobb and requested specific information about the interactions between her and ██████ on 11/23/2011. Cobb stated ██████ arrived at school and came through the front door of the school. Cobb stated she was helping ██████ with his English essay for his college class and that he had stayed about an hour and a half (Cobb is an English major and was ██████'s teacher for the 2010-2011 school year so this was a plausible explanation). Cobb stated she had come to school to grade papers and then she and ██████ went to the weight room together and worked on his essay. According to Cobb, ██████ left around 3pm towards the student parking lot and was only there for about an hour and a half.

The meeting ended and Chenoweth met with Neal and advised him of the discrepancies. Neal and Chenoweth previously viewed the surveillance footage and knew there were several inconsistencies in Cobb's statement. Chenoweth and Neal decided a Volusia County School Board "Written Record of Counseling" would need to be completed and provided to Cobb.

The nature of this apparent union is unknown.)</p> <p>Cobb and [redacted] were alone from 11:18-11:32, then 11:35-1:32, and then again 2:37-3:33. The two were alone for two hours and seven minutes over the course of the day</p> <p>Chenoweth received an email from Cobb at 0746am on 12/05/2011 that she "tried to stop by to follow up with you (Chenoweth)...let me (Cobb) know a better time as I'd like to get this cleared up". According to Volusia County School Board policy, teachers must be given twenty-four hour notice if they are going to be met with again by their administration for disciplinary purposes. Chenoweth emailed Cobb on 12/05/2011 at 0816 am regarding the required twenty-four hour notice. Cobb corresponded again with Chenoweth and asked if she could come down earlier as Cobb was eager to put the matter behind her.</p> <p>Cobb came down during 2nd lunch on 12/05/2011 (1209-1250 hours) and told Chenoweth she provided misinformation regarding the events of 11/23/2011. A Volusia County School Board Record of Counseling was issued to Cobb by Chenoweth as there was no evidence that anything inappropriate had taken place. Chenoweth advised Cobb that [redacted] was not to be in her classroom without other students present as the perception makes it appear inappropriate. Chenoweth played the video footage on 11/23/2011 for Cobb, specifically Building 1C, first floor, (camera time) 3:38pm. The video depicts Cobb and [redacted] walking together with all of their belongings towards the parking lot and the two are clearly walking separately down the hallway. At the end of the hallway, it is clearly visible the two shadows become one, appearing the two may have shared a kiss or hug for a few seconds, and the shadows emerge separately. Chenoweth asked Cobb if she shared a kiss or a hug with [redacted]. According to Chenoweth, after a very long pause of silence, Cobb answered "I don't recall". Shortly thereafter the meeting ended and Cobb left Chenoweth's office. About five minutes later, Cobb requested Chenoweth to get a substitute teacher as she was ill and needed to go home.</p>

Pender and DeVito met with [REDACTED] on 12/05/2011 during the same time frame that Chenoweth met with Cobb, and advised him he is to leave at the end of third period (1022 hours) for his college classes and not return until the end of the school day for his team sports commitments. [REDACTED] left after the meeting with Pender and DeVito and Cobb notified Chenoweth she needed to leave at or near the same time.

On 12/06/2011 at 8:15 am, Cobb sent DeVito an email indicating she "has a lot going on both at work and in her personal life and needs to take a personal leave day on Friday 12/09/2011". DeVito advised the leave day would not be a problem.

Later that day, [REDACTED] was observed on camera entering Cobb's classroom at 12:05 pm during second lunch period. At 12:40 pm, other children entered the classroom but left after one minute, leaving Cobb and [REDACTED] alone until he left at 12:47 pm. At 2:42 pm, [REDACTED] entered Cobb's classroom again, and the two left together at 3:00 pm.

According to DeVito, Cobb attended work on 12/07 and 12/08, but was out sick on 12/09. Email correspondence from Cobb to DeVito continued over the weekend where Cobb indicated she fell ill over the weekend and would not be to work until Wednesday 12/14/11. On Monday December 12th 2011, Cobb emailed DeVito stating she had provided work for the substitute and would keep him informed as to when she may was able to return to work.

On Tuesday December 13th 2011, Cobb emailed DeVito at 7:14 am, indicating she was still unable to return to work due to her illness.

At 3:00 pm, Volusia County Sheriff's Office Central Dispatch received a "911" call originating from cell phone number 407-314-6702. The female called indicated her "friend was having suicidal thoughts" and further stated the friend's name was "[REDACTED]". The caller indicated [REDACTED] had a gun and that he was texting her stating "he wants to end everything and he has no purpose in living". The female caller did not want to give her name and did provide Central with telephone number [REDACTED] for [REDACTED] along with the address [REDACTED] in Deltona. Central dispatch

disconnected with the female caller and was able to establish contact with [REDACTED] by telephone. [REDACTED] indicated everything was "ok" and he was at University High School. [REDACTED] further indicated he "was having a moment but everything is okay". "going through tough times and got caught in the moment" and he "does not feel safe anymore and that something with his life might go wrong".

Within a few moments, [REDACTED] was located and brought into the main office of University High School where he met with Pender and DeVito and awaited the arrival of his parents. [REDACTED] did not have any weapons on his person and stated he did not make any statements to harm himself.

While waiting for his parents, Pender made small talk with [REDACTED] and began asking about his Iphone. [REDACTED] offered his phone to Pender to look at as school administration needed to establish the credibility, or lack thereof, the alleged written threats to do harm to himself. (Per the caller's statement, [REDACTED] "texted" the threat to her). As Pender looked through the phone, he thought it odd there were no messages whatsoever in [REDACTED]'s phone and asked him if his girlfriends' number was in the phone to which [REDACTED] replied "yes". Pender could not find a "Jessica" in [REDACTED]'s contacts and asked what name Jessica's contact information is stored under? [REDACTED] replied she is listed as "my precious angel"

Pender located the contact "my precious angel" and noted the number 407-314-6702. Pender thought he recognized the number as Cobb's and showed DeVito the contact information. DeVito had been communicating with Cobb and had her contact information in his personal cell phone. DeVito verified the telephone number belonged to English teacher Stephanie Cobb. Neither Pender nor DeVito commented on their discovery, however, they requested Coach Anthony Taranto (W4) sit with [REDACTED]. Pender and DeVito then went to meet with Principal Neal to inform him of the discovery. Simultaneously, [REDACTED]'s mother [REDACTED] (O4) arrived at school and was escorted into Neal's office.

As Neal spoke with [REDACTED] and informed her of the evolving information, [REDACTED] openly stated "her son was in a relationship with an adult on this campus and was in way over his head" and cited she felt this was the reason for his recent behavior and statements. After determining [REDACTED] was not a harm to himself or others, the meeting ended and

[REDACTED] left with his mother. VCISO School Resource Deputy Worledge was present during the incident and completed an incident report. (See Worledge's initial report for further information). It should be noted that neither Neal nor [REDACTED] revealed to the other Cobb's identity. It should also be noted the CAD call was closed at 1715 hours.

At 6:22pm, DeVito emailed Cobb inquiring on Cobb's health status and she responded at 6:38 pm inquiring about a leave of absence. DeVito replied suggesting to Cobb she exhaust her sick time before requesting a leave. DeVito did not hear back from Cobb until 9:04 pm at which time Cobb sent her resignation notice effective December 16th 2011, to both DeVito and Chenoweth. Neal was informed of the resignation, and requested to have Cobb change the resignation date effective December 14th and she agreed.

On December 14th 2011, around 7:00 pm, Cobb met with DeVito and Chenoweth at University High School to sign the required resignation paperwork, turn in her school assigned keys, and remove her personal teaching supplies from the classroom. DeVito noticed Cobb did have a bandage on her right jaw where the illness Cobb spoke of had originated. Both Chenoweth and DeVito indicated there was no communication with Cobb regarding the previous day's discovery nor did she offer any further explanation as to why she was resigning. The only statement Cobb made while emptying her classroom was, "I shouldn't have to do this". Both DeVito and Chenoweth thought it strange she made the comment as there had been no actions on the schools part to initiate the resignation from Cobb. In fact, DeVito, Chenoweth, Pender and Neal were shocked when Cobb sent the email containing her intentions.

On December 15th 2011, Investigators Ott and Seymour were provided this case for further investigation. Investigator Ott traveled to University High School to speak with DeVito who relayed the same information as previously written. Investigator Seymour prepared a subpoena for Cobb's cell phone records related to phone number 386-314-6702 and later joined Investigator Ott at University High School along with Sergeant Ford.

[REDACTED] had arrived at the school to pick [REDACTED] up for his regular dismissal time and Investigators interviewed her prior to speaking with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] indicated she had felt her son was in over his head because she heard him speaking on

his cell phone very late on a school night. [redacted] went into his bedroom and took his cell phone from him and as she looked at it, she saw "Mrs. Cobb" on the cell phone's display. [redacted] stated to [redacted] "You're in over your head". [redacted] decided to speak to her husband the next day and discuss their plans with the information [redacted] stated she had been noticing a change in [redacted]'s behavior recently and felt it was because of the interaction between he and Cobb. [redacted] agreed to allow Investigators to interview [redacted] without her present. Both interviews were captured on digital recordings and placed into evidence at VCSO District Six.

Through the interview process, information was gained from [redacted] that he and Cobb did in fact have a relationship and it was of a sexual nature on one occasion [redacted] disclosed the two engaged in "minor" intercourse in Cobb's vehicle at Dewey Boster Park in Deltona. [redacted] stated the incident took place about a month ago but could not give a definitive date and time. [redacted] was asked if he understood what intercourse meant and he replied "yes" confirming his sexual organ contacted, and united with, Cobb's sexual organ. When asked what "minor" intercourse meant, [redacted] stated that it only lasted for a brief period of time. [redacted] stated that he did wear a condom during intercourse and he was a willing participant. [redacted] was hesitant on answering the Investigators questions fearing that Cobb would "go to jail" because of the relationship between them.

[redacted] stated the relationship began after this school year started and he and Cobb began to communicate initially about his college English class. [redacted] stated it developed into more than a friendship and admitted that he and Cobb both understood that their relationship was inappropriate. [redacted] stated that the two were in love and shared a considerable amount of time together. [redacted] did not share any further details regarding the actual intercourse that had taken place.

When asked where his cell phone was located, [redacted] stated his father had taken it away from him two days prior and it was in his father's possession. [redacted]'s cell phone number was recorded as [redacted]. [redacted] confirmed this information and was advised there would be additional information needed to be gathered and Investigators would contact with her once further information was obtained.

While Investigators Ott and Seymour were interviewing [REDACTED] Sergeant Ford attempted to interview Matthew Goble (O11), a close friend of [REDACTED]'s who possibly had information regarding the relationship between [REDACTED] and Cobb. Goble's parents were contacted and requested Sergeant Ford wait to speak to Matthew until they arrived at the school. Once the parents arrived, they advised Matthew could not be interviewed until they spoke with an attorney. There was no further contact with Matthew or his parents at that particular time.

Investigators Ott and Seymour responded to 217 Alexandra Woods Drive, DeBary, Florida, to speak with Cobb. Cobb invited Investigators into the home, and Investigators noted several plastic storage bins and boxes in the living room right inside the front door. Cobb made small talk indicating she had just moved and was asked if she knew why investigators were there. Cobb stated she did and said "it's fabricated, total lies". Cobb then stated she did not wish to speak any further unless her representative was present.

Investigator Seymour asked Cobb what she meant by representative and Cobb stated, "from my teachers' union" and when asked if representative meant a legal representative like an attorney, Cobb stated "yes". Investigators provided Cobb with a business card and left the home. Investigators noted a black Nissan Xterra in the driveway and it appeared no one else was in the home during the time the investigators were speaking to Cobb.

Investigators left the house and discovered the only vehicle registered to Cobb and her spouse was the black Nissan. Due to the possibility of evidence being contained within the vehicle, investigators returned to 217 Alexandra Woods and seized the vehicle as evidence. The vehicle was taped with red evidence tape and towed to the VCSO Evidence Facility and placed into a sealed garage. (The vehicle is a 2010 Nissan Xterra, black in color, bearing Florida license plate C304ZA, vehicle identification number 5N1NANONIUN5AC522491 registered to Cobb and her spouse Brian Cobb (O8)).

Sergeant Ford contacted [REDACTED] (O6), father of [REDACTED], and met with him to retrieve the victim's cell phone for forensic examination around 1900 hours. [REDACTED] signed a VCSO Consent to Search form and turned [REDACTED]'s cell phone over to Sergeant Ford voluntarily.

Investigator Ott requested and received a legal search warrant for the 2010 Nissan on 12/16/2011. Crime Scene Investigator Sergeant R. Fortin and Investigator Ott served the search warrant on the vehicle later in the day. (See supplement by Sergeant Fortin for further information). Seven pieces of evidence were removed from the vehicle and sent to FDLE for processing by Sergeant Fortin.

██████████'s cell phone was taken to VCSO Investigator C Gallagher and a forensic examination was completed on the phone. The CD containing the contents of the cell phone extraction report was provided to Sergeant Ford and placed into evidence at VCSO District Six along with the cell phone.

Investigator Seymour contacted ██████████ by telephone to provide the family with VCSO Victim Advocate Pat Taylor's information. ██████████ stated she and ██████████ spoke and were concentrating on ██████████ and what would be in his best interest.

On December 19th 2011, Investigator Seymour received and reviewed the subpoena results for Cobb's cell phone. The results concluded eleven thousand eight hundred forty-seven (11,847) text messages existed between Cobb and ██████████'s cell phones between September 25th 2011 and December 13th 2011.

On December 20th 2011, Investigators viewed the information from the extraction report of ██████████'s cell phone and discovered some texts were deleted but partially retained on the phone. The following are texts are those that were able to be retrieved:

Investigator Ott called Cobb's cell phone and left a message advising Cobb's vehicle was ready to be picked up from the VCSO Evidence Facility.

On December 22nd 2011, Sergeant Ford requested and received a lawful search warrant for 217 Alexandra Woods to locate Cobb's cell phone. The search warrant was served on Cobb on December 23rd after she arrived at 217 Alexandra Woods at 1230 hours. Investigator Ott dialed telephone number 386-314-6702 from her VCSO issued Nextel, and the cell phone in Cobb's hand rang confirming the phone was the one listed in the search warrant. Cobb's cell phone was placed into evidence by Investigators. The search warrant returns for Cobb's vehicle and cell phone were returned to the Clerk's Office the afternoon of December 23rd 2011 by Investigator Ott.

On December 27th 2011, Investigator Seymour requested and received a lawful search warrant for Cobb's cell phone. Investigator Seymour retrieved the cell phone from VCSO evidence and delivered the phone to Investigator Gallagher to conduct a forensic examination. Later in the day, Investigator Gallagher advised the phone was password protected and trying more than three times at the password could potentially erase the hard drive and any potential evidence. The cell phone was returned to VCSO evidence and the search warrant return completed as inconclusive.

Sergeant Ford received written notice by US Mail from Attorney Warren Lindsey (O10) that he represented Matthew Goble and would meet with Investigators to provide a statement from his client. Investigator Seymour left a telephone message for Lindsey to return the call to set up an appointment.

On January 5th 2012, Investigators Ott and Seymour returned to University High School to conduct additional interviews with potential witnesses in this case. Teacher Adam Blair provided Investigators with both verbal and written statements (attached to report) and recalled the events from November 23rd 2011 as they were previously depicted by

DeVito, Blair offered that Cobb and [REDACTED] may have been communicating by email as well as text messages. Blair stated Cobb used her school email account to communicate with him and thought it possible the email account may contain relevant information.

Investigator Ott recalled DeVito acknowledging Cobb had turned in her school assigned laptop to him on the day of her resignation (December 14th 2011). DeVito had the laptop sitting in his office since that date and no one had used the laptop. Investigator Ott seized the Dell Latitude E5500 (serial number JZZJ3M1-VCSB ID#268249) and provided DeVito a receipt. The laptop was placed into evidence at VCSO District Six.

Investigator Ott contacted Pegg by telephone and left a message for him to return the call. Investigator Seymour left another message for Attorney Lindsey to make an appointment to interview Matthew Goble.

[REDACTED] called Investigator Ott at 1241 hours and he inquired as to the reason for contacting his friends and the status of the case and inquired if Cobb would go to jail because he was a willing participant. Investigator Ott advised [REDACTED] she could not discuss the details of the case with him. (The content of the conversation was digitally recorded). After concluding the call with [REDACTED], Pegg called Investigator Ott and stated he "wanted to stay out of it and was not making a statement". (The content of the conversation was also digitally recorded).

[REDACTED] was contacted by Investigator Ott by telephone and advised of the inquiry by [REDACTED] regarding the case. [REDACTED] stated she did not want investigators speaking to [REDACTED]'s friends as she felt it would cause [REDACTED] more emotional stress. (The content of the conversation was digitally recorded). A CD containing the recordings was placed into evidence at VCSO District Six.

On January 6th 2012, Cobb's attorney, Catherine Drees, contacted Investigator Ott and advised [REDACTED] had driven by Cobb's marital residence in Orange City on January 4th 2012 and contacted Cobb's brother via Facebook. Drees also stated according to Cobb, [REDACTED] called Cobb's mother's cell phone in an attempt to contact Cobb. Drees was asked to

provide a timeline of the events that Cobb was alleging took place and provide them to Investigator Ott. Drees stated she would fax the information to Investigator Ott on Monday, January 9th 2012.

On January 10th 2012, Investigator Ott requested and received a lawful subpoena for Cobb's Volusia County School Board email account (slcobb@volusia.k12.fl.us). The subpoena was served to Ann Conley of VCSB.

On January 11th 2012, Investigators Ott and Seymour traveled to University High School and interviewed Assistant Principals Chenoweth and Pender, and School Custodian Juan Reyes. All interviews were digitally recorded and placed into evidence at VCSO District Six. (The content of the interviews with the exception of Reyes' have been depicted previously in this report). Reyes commented that he had observed a white male in Cobb's classroom on November 23, 2011. Reyes thought the male may have been Cobb's family member but he did not observe anything inappropriate on that day.

At 1345 hours, VCSO Crime Scene Investigator Dewees arrived at University High School and processed Cobb's classroom and the offices in between hers and the adjoining classroom for anything of evidentiary value. The search met with negative results. Investigator Dewees photographed the classrooms and offices for reporting purposes.

Investigator Ott retrieved a CD containing Cobb's email account from Volusia County School Board. (A total of 2261 emails were on the CD). After review of the emails it was discovered there were two additional email addresses that belonged to Cobb (Stephanie_grad08@yahoo.com and stephanielcobb@gmail.com) along with a "Facebook friend request" on October 29th 2011 at 8:08 pm, indicating Cobb had a "Facebook" account within the time range of this incident.

Attorney Drees faxed a statement allegedly typed by Cobb, even though it was unsigned, wherein Cobb alleges [REDACTED] is "irrational, immature, and unpredictable" and that he is "striving for her (Cobb's) attention". (A copy of the statement is attached to this report). Cobb also provided license plate (Florida tag 690TER) of a black Mustang that drove by Cobb's

marital residence. Cobb stated she felt the vehicle was [REDACTED]'s and that he was following her. (The license plate was registered to a close neighbor that resides one block from Cobb's marital residence and had no affiliation with this case). Drees suggested Cobb was being stalked by [REDACTED] and requested contact be made with him to deter any further attempt by him to contact Cobb. Investigator Ott contacted [REDACTED] and relayed the information. [REDACTED] assured Investigator Ott that [REDACTED] had not been in contact with Cobb.

On January 12th 2012, Investigator Ott and State Attorney Investigator Eckersen met with Cobb's estranged husband Brian (O8) for the purpose of conducting an interview. The interview took place at the State Attorney's Office located at the Volusia County Courthouse in Deland.

Brian advised that he and Cobb had been going through some marital difficulties over the last few months. When asked when the difficulties began, Brian stated it was after the school year started, possibly around the beginning of September 2011. (Within the time frame where Cobb and [REDACTED] began communicating by telephone and text messaging. According to subpoenaed records, the first text message from Cobb's cell phone to [REDACTED]'s cell phone was September 25th 2011 at 21:21 hours and the first telephone call between the two was on October 14th 2011 at 13:45 hours).

Brian stated the problems were typical relationship issues but became growing concerns of his when Cobb moved into a spare bedroom of their marital residence. Brian stated it was around his birthday, which is November 21st, but could not cite an exact date (Around the time frame that [REDACTED] stated he and Cobb had engaged in sexual intercourse). Brian stated Cobb kept saying she needed to move out because it was something she just needed to do. When Brian inquired as to the reason Cobb wanted to move out, she told him that "she just needed to" and could never provide a reasonable and logical explanation. The text messages between Cobb and [REDACTED] greatly increased during this time frame as exhibited in the records returned by both cell phone providers.

Brian stated he overheard Cobb talking on her cell phone very late into the night one evening after she moved into the

spare bedroom. Brian suspected Cobb may be involved in an extramarital relationship due to the late night phone conversations but did not have any evidence to support his suspicions. Brian felt it may have been a co-worker from University High School as Cobb was spending an unusual amount of extra time at school before and after hours.

Brian stated the weekend after Thanksgiving (December 2nd and 3rd 2011), Cobb stated she was going to spend the weekend with her girlfriend in Saint Augustine because she needed some time. Brian stated Cobb told him she did not want to move any longer but needed time to clear her head. Brian stated Cobb did not go to her friends and after pressuring her for an answer where she had gone Cobb told him she was "at a hotel north of the county line on 95". Brian stated Cobb had withdrawn a couple hundred dollars prior to taking the trip so there were no financial transactions that could be retrieved.

According to Brian, Cobb told him she had been written up at work for being in a classroom with a student on a non-school day but the issue was over. Brian never questioned Cobb about who the student was or what happened. Brian stated Cobb did not share any of the issues with him regarding the incident that occurred at school until she resigned on December 13th 2011. Brian also stated Cobb resigned without discussing it with him stating the reason to Brian was because of too much stress at work. Brian stated Cobb called him before she called 911 on December 13th 2011 and asked him if he could get [redacted]'s home phone number because he was threatening to do harm to himself. Brian stated he did not think anything of it because she had mentioned to him about having to go to school counselors in the past because of statements made by her students.

Shortly after Cobb's statement to Brian, he was informed of the incident report involving Cobb by his supervisor. Brian decided it best for Cobb to move out of the house until the investigation was completed as he did not want to jeopardize his employment. Brian stated he drew his own conclusion about that Cobb was involved with a co-worker but "definitely did not think it was a student". Brian stated Cobb went out with both Coach Taranto and Blair on occasions socially.

Brian stated he knew [redacted] as he had been introduced to him at a football game and Cobb was his teacher last year.

Brian stated Cobb worked with a fellow teacher who photographed sporting events for the school yearbook. Brian would occasionally see many of Cobb's students at football games when he would accompany her.

Brian stated Cobb told him during their recent separation that "she (Cobb) screwed up because she met him at parks." Brian asked what she meant and she replied, "I met [redacted] at a couple of parks and I'm sorry". Brian stated Cobb did not elaborate on the statement and all she ever would say to him was she "was sorry".

On January 20th 2012, Investigator Ott requested and received two lawful search warrants for both email accounts listed previously. The search warrants were served via fax to Google and Yahoo! for the listed email accounts.

On January 24th 2012, Investigator Ott requested subpoenas for [redacted] and [redacted]'s cell phone records from AT & T wireless (telephone numbers [redacted] and [redacted] respectively).

Investigator Ott began to examine Cobb's cell phone records in an effort to determine when Cobb initially contacted [redacted]'s cell phone either by text or call. The first contact between Cobb and [redacted]'s phones was on September 25th 2011 at 21:30 hours. With a date range of August 15th 2011 through December 13th 2011, Cobb's phone records revealed 1493 calls both incoming and outgoing from her phone. A total of 324 calls to or from [redacted]'s cell phone were documented in Cobb's call log. A total of 28,800 text messages during the same time frame showed 11,868 were between Cobb and [redacted].

Investigator Ott received the results of the search warrant for the "Google" email account on January 26th 2012. Through a search of the documents, an email dated December 19th 2011 at 9:30 pm from jessi.suminski@gmail.com to stephanieicobb@gmail.com reads: "I went to say happy holidays on Facebook and couldn't find u! Have u deleted your page or am I retarded?" On December 20th 2011 at 8:01 pm Cobb replied "Aaa happy holidays to you as well. I deleted my Facebook a few months ago because of school drama. but thank you for contacting me! I've been thinking of you much lately and hope all is going well for you :) I've actually been struggling lately. I ended up in the hospital for a total of

about a week due to an infection but I'm almost healed completely now. Ugh! It wasn't fun. How are your holiday plans going? I hope you and your bf are still going strong:) I look forward to hearing from ya lady!"

On February 1st 2012, Investigator Ott received the search warrant results for the Cobb's Yahoo! email account. A review of the documents revealed Cobb had her "Facebook" account linked to this email during the time frame of this investigation as well. Investigator Ott completed an Electronic Request for Law Enforcement Officials to Preserve Facebook Account Records on February 7th 2012 using email account Stephanie_grad08@yahoo.com and Reference #322452971125682 was provided by Facebook records. Both the Google and School Board email accounts were no longer active or related to a Facebook account per their records.

Investigator Ott received the subpoena return from AT & T on [redacted] and [redacted]'s cell phone records. A review of the 852 pages revealed 12,007 text messages between [redacted] and Cobb and 521 telephone calls. In fact, Cobb sent 6,151 of the messages to [redacted] and made 195 calls to his phone. [redacted] sent 5,856 text messages to Cobb and called Cobb 326 times during the time frame September 15th 2011 through January 17th 2012. During the month of November 2011, the volume of text messages increased greatly between the two and text messages are sent throughout the day and night by both parties. Note this was the time frame where the "minor intercourse" allegedly took place according to [redacted]'s recorded statement.

On February 8th 2012, Investigator Ott requested and received a lawful search warrant for Cobb's Facebook account. The search warrant was delivered to Facebook by scanned email and a read receipt was requested and received on February 10th 2012.

On February 13th 2012, Investigator Ott was provided a CD containing snapshots of the text messages from [redacted]'s cell phone extraction report and a voicemail from Cobb to [redacted] on December 1st 2011 at 11:41 pm. Cobb's voice mail states, "I know you're mad at me but I'd really like to talk for a minute...audible sigh" Call me back or text me. I'll leave you alone if you want me to but I just want to talk to you for a minute. Bye".

On February 21, 2012, Investigators Ott and State Attorney Investigator Eckersen interviewed Herbert Pegg IV and Matthew Goble. During the interview with Pegg, he revealed he learned of the relationship with [REDACTED] and Cobb during one of his many text conversations with [REDACTED]. Pegg stated [REDACTED] told him he was dating an "older women" and learned later it was a teacher. Pegg stated [REDACTED] confided in him the two began the relationship by texting and then it evolved into a physical relationship. Pegg stated he learned from [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] and Cobb did have sexual intercourse on one occasion at a park in Deltona and provided the name "Dewey O. Boster Park, the one with the football fields". Pegg stated [REDACTED] told him that he and Cobb had sex "in a car" but did not know who the car belonged to. Pegg also stated [REDACTED] advised he was going to join the military and he and Cobb were going to move away together. Pegg confirmed that [REDACTED] knew Cobb could get in trouble for her relationship with [REDACTED].

Pegg confirmed his cell phone number was, and still is 386-228-5510 and confirmed he was responding to [REDACTED]'s texts on 12/13/2011 regarding the break up with Cobb. Pegg acknowledged [REDACTED] was depressed over the break up initially but had gone back to himself after some time had passed. Pegg never observed [REDACTED] with Cobb but did share a picture of Cobb standing outside Florida State University. Pegg stated [REDACTED] and Cobb mutually ended the relationship because of a "janitor catching them at school over Thanksgiving break".

Pegg stated he has known [REDACTED] for quite a few years through a youth baseball league both belonged to and [REDACTED]'s older brother. Pegg stated [REDACTED] has never given him reason to believe [REDACTED] was being untruthful about the relationship and was told by [REDACTED] that he and Cobb loved one another.

Matthew Goble was interviewed his representative Attorney Warren Lindsay present. Matthew stated he considers himself [REDACTED]'s best friend and learned of the relationship between [REDACTED] and Cobb about a month before anyone else knew. Matthew stated [REDACTED] confided in him that "Cobb and he had sex once". Investigator Eckersen inquired of Matthew if he understood the meaning of sexual intercourse and he responded appropriately. Matthew was not able to provide any detailed information as to when and where the two had engaged in intercourse.

Matthew stated [redacted] stayed at his home while [redacted]'s parents were gone to FSU to visit the college for [redacted]'s older brother. Matthew stated [redacted] was never away from Matthew or his parents during the absence of [redacted]'s parents over the two days. Matthew confirmed he knew [redacted] and Cobb spoke both by text messages and telephone conversations. Matthew stated [redacted] would leave the room to speak on his cell phone and figured [redacted] was speaking to Cobb during those times.

Matthew was asked about the text sent to him by [redacted] stating "Tell your Dad things are clearing up" on December 10th 2011. Matthew explained that his father knew [redacted] was involved in a relationship with "an older woman" but was not aware it was a teacher until after the rumors circulated at the school on December 13th 2011.

Copies of the interviews with Brain, Pegg, and Goble were placed into evidence at VCSO District Six by Investigator Ott after receiving them from Eckersen.

VCSO Investigator Gallagher advised there was nothing of evidentiary value on the victim's laptop computer.

On February 24th 2012, the search warrant return was completed for the Facebook account even though nothing had been returned by the provider.

As of February 27th 2012, the information gleaned from the search warrants for the Defendant's cell phone and school assigned laptop computer had not yet been received.
