

WITNESS STATEMENT

TT – Sgt. Tom Tatum GB – Inv. Glen Bennett TD – Dep. Travis Deane
JV – Dep. Josh Vedder (Teamsters Rep) BW – Bob Walker (Teamsters Rep)

TT Ok the recorder is on. This is the administration of oath and perjury warning. It's in reference to case number IA-11-017. The witness name is Dep. Travis Deane. I'm Sgt. Tatum with the Volusia County Sheriff's Office internal affairs unit. Today's date is May 18, 2012 and the current time is 1517 hours. The current, or I'm sorry the location of this interview is the sheriff's office administrative offices in Deland. Also present during this interview is Inv. Bennett and we also have Dep. Josh Vedder and Teamsters rep Robert Walker who are representing Travis. Travis are you aware that this interview is being recorded?

TD Yes sir..

TT Ok, I am conducting an official administrative investigation concerning most recently the directives 26.2.106 Untruthfulness, and directive 26.2.145 Texting use of data devices while driving VCSO vehicle. As a Florida law enforcement officer and Notary Public of the state of Florida I am empowered to take sworn statements. At this time I would ask that you raise your right hand and be sworn. Do you solemnly swear or affirm the statement you're about to give is the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth?

TD Yes sir.

TT Any false statements about material matters given by a witness under oath will constitute perjury which is a third degree felony according to section 837.02 Florida Statutes. Do you understand that if you knowingly make material misstatements of facts to me during this investigation you will have committed the crime of perjury?

TD Yes sir.

TT Alright. That's just the directives so you guys have a copy of it. Alright Dep. Deane did you have time to review the documents provided to you and your representatives?

TD Yes sir.

TT Alright, prior to the recording did you read and understand the garrity warning as provided to you?

48 TD Yes sir.
49
50 TT Alright. You were served with an amended IA in reference to this investigation
51 on May 7, 2012 and you received a copy of your law enforcement officer bill of
52 rights?
53
54 TD Yes sir.
55
56 TT Ok. Alright Travis basically what we're doing here is with your last interview
57 being March 12, 2012.
58
59 TD Uh huh.
60
61 TT Per that interview some additional information that came out during your
62 conversation with us, we went out and spoke to a couple of additional witnesses.
63 So we just want to talk to you about that. You saw the people that we spoke to...
64
65 TD Uh huh.
66
67 TT ...so we're just going to cover some of that, what our conversation was ok? Ok
68 one of the people that we did talk to is Sgt. Whitener who was formally Dep.
69 Whitener and worked in Deland. So Dep. Deane did you have a conversation
70 with Dep. Whitener several days prior to making the arrest on Steven Dehut about
71 [REDACTED] being battered and do you remember asking his opinion what you
72 should do about it?
73
74 TD I remember speaking with him the night of the incident yes.
75
76 TT The night of the incident?
77
78 TD Yes.
79
80 TT Ok where was that?
81
82 TD I believe it was outside the district office.
83
84 TT Ok what did you ask him?
85
86 TD I posed him with the situation that she had initially said she got hit and then
87 became I'm trying, evasive when I started asking her more about it um, and that
88 she had gotten to a safe location and what his thoughts on it were because I didn't
89 know 100% how to handle the situation. My biggest concern was her safety and
90 she was safe and she wasn't particularly helpful for the police investigative
91 aspect.
92

93 TT Ok so with your conversation with at the time Dep. Whitener, we'll just call him
 94 Sgt. Whitener.
 95
 96 TD Ok.
 97
 98 TT With Sgt. Whitener did you tell him specific names, did you tell him you were
 99 talking about [REDACTED] and Steven Dehut.
 100
 101 TD I don't recall having used specific names, I very well may have.
 102
 103 TT Because he knows [REDACTED] and Steven also...
 104
 105 TD Uh huh, he does.
 106
 107 TT ...because he's worked in Pierson for many years.
 108
 109 TD Uh huh.
 110
 111 TT So you think you would have told him the names of the people you were, or were
 112 you posing a hypothetical?
 113
 114 TD I don't recall if I used their names specifically. I very well may have. It wasn't a
 115 stand out conversation. Like it isn't something that is a landmark in my mind to
 116 where I remember all the details of it.
 117
 118 TT And Travis we're not trying to have you do like landmark revelations or anything
 119 like that.
 120
 121 TD Right.
 122
 123 TT But obviously you guys both know these people...
 124
 125 TD Right.
 126
 127 TT ...that are involved so when you're having a conversation with him I mean you
 128 don't recall saying hey you know what? [REDACTED] just called me, she and Steven got
 129 into an argument.
 130
 131 TD I really don't remember if I said specifically [REDACTED]. I probably did but I really
 132 don't remember. I do remember having a conversation with him about the
 133 incident I just don't remember if I specifically said their names or not.
 134
 135 TT Ok so you gave him the rundown of what was going on. Basically what took
 136 place between the two?
 137
 138 TD Yeah I believe so.

139
140 TT In your conversation with [REDACTED]?
141
142 TD Yes sir.
143
144 TT What, did you ask his opinion, what do you think I should do?
145
146 TD I think I asked his opinion about what he thought about it or what he though I
147 should do about the incident stuff like that since there really wasn't a tremendous
148 amount there to go on.
149
150 TT So what did he tell you?
151
152 TD He said you know it's up to me to handle it how I want, that he also felt the same
153 way as far as if it were him in the situation knowing that her well being is good
154 that's the most important thing and if there's not enough to go on then...
155
156 TT Does Sgt. Whitener know your relationship with her?
157
158 TD I believe so.
159
160 TT So he knows that you guys are pretty good friends?
161
162 TD Right, he knows that we associate, we're associated with each other.
163
164 TT So was that of any concern when you were speaking with Sgt. Whitener was hey
165 you know what we're pretty good friends, what do you think I should do?
166
167 TD It wasn't a conversation with Whitener because I was concerned about a
168 friendship conflict, it was I was concerned about a friend. Does that make sense?
169 I didn't ask him because I was worried about oh well it's a friendship what should
170 I do? It's hey she's a friend what should I do? I guess that probably doesn't
171 make any sense. I'm trying to think of how...
172
173 TT Because the way Sgt. Whitener you know said in his statement the way he spoke
174 to us...
175
176 TD Uh huh.
177
178 TT ...it was more like look you know this may be a criminal element to this.
179
180 TD Uh huh.
181
182 TT You know with my relationship with her what do you think I should do? Is that
183 the way the conversation went?
184

185 TD It, I really just don't remember. It may have been. I...
186
187 TT So this was at the district and it was...
188
189 TD It was...
190
191 TT ...probably early morning hours?
192
193 TD It, was it on, I think I looked through the paperwork. That was a Friday,
194 Saturday, Sunday stint?
195
196 TT Uh huh.
197
198 TD And if I was the Yankee unit I would have been getting off at 4:00 in the morning
199 so it probably would have been close to that.
200
201 TT Ok.
202
203 GB May I see your packet right there is that alright?
204
205 TT There's transcripts in that one...
206
207 GB In this one?
208
209 TT ...if that's what you're looking for.
210
211 GB Ok yeah, I think...
212
213 TT It should be the same ones that are in Travis'.
214
215 GB Ok sorry.
216
217 TT Alright Travis what I want to talk to you about now is your conversation with Sgt.
218 McGuire...
219
220 TD Uh huh.
221
222 TT ...the night of the disturbance. Or actually it's gonna be the night of the arrest.
223
224 TD Ok.
225
226 TT On December 14th. So you spoke with Sgt. McGuire and you told him about the
227 domestic incident and your relationship with [REDACTED].
228
229 TD Uh huh.
230

231 TT As far as being friends.
 232
 233 TD Uh huh.
 234
 235 TT Did you tell him that she was at your Halloween party the month before?
 236
 237 TD No sir.
 238
 239 TT Do you think that might have been important to tell him?
 240
 241 TD I didn't think it was a particularly pertinent detail. I had expressed that we were
 242 friends.
 243
 244 TT Ok you say you expressed that you're friends but I mean did you tell him that you
 245 were friends on facebook?
 246
 247 TD No.
 248
 249 TT You know she had been to your house, your party?
 250
 251 TD No.
 252
 253 TT What about the how you call each other hubby and wifey?
 254
 255 TD No I hadn't expressed that either.
 256
 257 TT Ok. Don't you think that would be kind of important information when you're
 258 talking about a potential domestic issue? And your relationship with her though
 259 you're saying not romantic...
 260
 261 TD Uh huh.
 262
 263 TT ...you're still calling each other terms of endearment...
 264
 265 TD Uh huh.
 266
 267 TT ...you know by hubby, wifey and that makes people who look at this say you
 268 know what, they seem a little bit closer than just friends, people that know each
 269 other from the restaurant you know what I'm saying?
 270
 271 TD Uh huh, I understand what you're saying. I didn't feel the details were
 272 particularly pertinent because to me it had only ever been a friendship. It wasn't
 273 anything more nor was I striving for anything more. I mean men and women flirt
 274 with each other to some extent even if they're friends and that's all I ever saw it
 275 as.
 276

277 TT Because according to Sgt. McGuire if he would have known the information with
 278 you calling each other these little nicknames hubby wifey...
 279

280 TD Uh huh.
 281

282 TT ...and that she had been at your house, been at your party, he said he would have
 283 taken a different action. He would have had somebody else take the report.
 284

285 TD Ok.
 286

287 TT So this is all information that probably would have been important for you to be
 288 forthright and up front with him at the time you were having that conversation.
 289

290 TD Ok.
 291

292 TT So, do you agree with that?
 293

294 TD Had I volunteered that much more information and Sgt. McGuire says that it
 295 would have changed the outcome of events then I guess it would have changed
 296 the outcome of events. You know hindsight's 20/20 I didn't think any of the
 297 details were pertinent at the time but obviously now it would have worked out to
 298 my benefit.
 299

300 TT Alright along those lines too when you had your conversation with Sgt. McGuire
 301 did you tell him that [REDACTED] and Steven Dehut lived together at the time of
 302 the battery?
 303

304 TD I don't think I said that. I don't believe that they were living together at the time
 305 of the incident because [REDACTED] had specifically told me she was going to Steven's
 306 house for a party. They had lived together previously. I think in my report I even
 307 documented a time frame from this month to this month or what not in a certain
 308 year.
 309

310 TT Right, we're talking about the conversation that you had with Sgt. McGuire.
 311

312 TD Uh huh.
 313

314 TT Do you specifically remember telling him that they lived together?
 315

316 TD At the time of the incident?
 317

318 TT At the time of the incident.
 319

320 TD I don't think I said that. I don't believe I said that.
 321

322 TT Ok because you had a chance to look through his transcripts and...

323

324 TD Uh huh. I saw that he said he believed I had told him that.

325

326 TT And then he said it was his understanding that they had, they were currently living

327 together and that was what he based his decision on to make the arrest because

328 they still lived together.

329

330 TD I don't think they lived together and I wouldn't have said they lived together if

331 they didn't. I know they had in the past.

332

333 TT Uh huh.

334

335 TD I mean if I review the report I can see if I, if they were currently living together or

336 living together at the time of the incident I'd have notated it in the report. And if

337 it's not in the report then they weren't living together. So...

338

339 TT Yeah and..

340

341 TD ...without actually being able to read it and know for sure.

342

343 TT I don't believe it's in the report. I mean it's in there where you documented that

344 previously they had lived together for a short time.

345

346 TD Uh huh.

347

348 TT Alright and in your previous statement to Sgt. McGuire or actually with your

349 interview with us you said that you told Sgt. McGuire that you and Steven Dehut

350 had not been the best of friends and then you went on to talk a little bit more

351 about the couple times that you had contact with Steven...

352

353 TD Uh huh.

354

355 TT ...and that you know he had illegal tint on his window...

356

357 TD Uh huh.

358

359 TT ...and you never wrote him a citation or anything.

360

361 TD Correct.

362

363 TT But when you were talking to Sgt. McGuire that night did you tell him about all

364 these things like these prior contacts that you've had with him or...

365

366 TD Not in detail, I thought I had made mention to Sgt. McGuire that Steven and I had

367 butted heads or didn't necessarily get along with each other but I don't remember

368 any specific detailed incidences that I'd have outlined to him.

369
370 TT Because I was reading through your transcripts and I was trying to see because the
371 way you answered it was you know basically that you guys weren't the best of
372 friends.
373
374 TD Uh huh.
375
376 TT And then you went on to say about all the prior contacts you had with him.
377
378 TD Uh huh.
379
380 TT So I didn't know if that was something you told him that night or if that was
381 something that you kind of just told us. You know what I'm saying?
382
383 TD I didn't, I don't believe that I told Sgt. McGuire about the specific incidents and
384 run ins. I thought I had made mention to him that Steven and I weren't in any
385 kind of way friendly.
386
387 TT Because Sgt. McGuire doesn't recall you saying anything about you having an
388 issue with him with Steven Dehut.
389
390 TD Ok.
391
392 TT Because he said that would have set an alarm off for him to be more aware of
393 what was going on. Alright, did [REDACTED], and again this goes back to the
394 conversation that we had the first time...
395
396 TD Uh huh.
397
398 TT ...during your interview. You said that [REDACTED] had sent you a picture of the
399 beer cups on your patrol car?
400
401 TD She sent me a picture of a patrol car with cups on it and later found out it was
402 mine or was under the impression it was mine given the information I got after the
403 party that people had done that.
404
405 TT Did she, was that a text or how did she send that to you?
406
407 TD It was, it's a text message or a multimedia message. It comes in like a text
408 message but it's deemed something different because it's a photograph.
409
410 TT Now when she sent the picture to you did she attach any kind of a statement or
411 anything with it?
412
413 TD The picture came by itself but prior to the picture and without actually looking at
414 my phone to see the time stamps, but the same day earlier from that she sent me a

415 long text message about and I'm paraphrasing, I hope you're happy you've ruined
 416 my Christmas, my relationship with my boyfriend, my relationship with my
 417 parents, this is obviously what you wanted blah, blah, blah, blah. And I
 418 responded to her and said I'm sorry things suck right now, that's not what I
 419 wanted to have happen but I had to do my job and if you want to hate me for it
 420 then so be it. And then shortly after that I got the picture of the car.
 421
 422 TT Alright do you remember what day you got that picture? Was it, because the
 423 arrest was on the 14th, do you recall off hand?
 424
 425 TD Huh uh, I, no not off hand I don't recall.
 426
 427 TT Ok.
 428
 429 TD It would be afterwards because I mean she made mention specifically before the
 430 picture about how I ruined everything which is in reference to arresting Steven.
 431
 432 TT Uh huh.
 433
 434 TD So.
 435
 436 TT Alright did you have a chance to meet with Dep. Sierstorpff at some point and
 437 show him the picture of the beer cups on the patrol car?
 438
 439 TD Uh huh.
 440
 441 TT Do you remember where you were when you guys had that conversation that he
 442 saw that picture?
 443
 444 TD I believe we were eating inside the restaurant.
 445
 446 TT And you're referring to?
 447
 448 TD Pierson Family Restaurant.
 449
 450 TT Ok. And we believe that was December 16th which is two days after the arrest...
 451
 452 TD Ok.
 453
 454 TT ...is when you guys had that conversation. Do you remember what the discussion
 455 was?
 456
 457 TD Like between?
 458
 459 TT Between you and Taylor.
 460

461 TD Taylor and I? Um, not any specific details. I remember, I say it's in the
 462 restaurant because I seem to remember like leaning on the table and being across
 463 from him and showing him my phone to show him the picture and I think I had
 464 told him that [REDACTED] sent it to me but again I don't really remember a tremendous
 465 amount about the conversation.
 466

467 TT Do you remember saying anything to Taylor about they're not going to be able to
 468 tell that this is my patrol car, there's no numbers on it, anything like that?
 469

470 TD I probably made statements along the lines of it's good that the picture's not good
 471 it's compromising but the silver lining concept is there's no numbers on the car so
 472 it's not specifically gonna shaft me you know what I mean?
 473

474 TT Right.
 475

476 TD So.
 477

478 TT Alright so that was as far as the conversation was?
 479

480 TD That I can remember.
 481

482 TT Did she send you any other texts?
 483

484 TD That, the pictures...
 485

486 TT I mean as far as pictures.
 487

488 TD That one picture is the last message I ever got from her. And the one prior to it
 489 where I said I'm sorry you feel that way if you want to hate me then so be it is the
 490 last message I ever sent her.
 491

492 TT Ok so it's still and I don't want to put words in your mouth but it's still your
 493 statement that you were unaware of these beer cups that were on the hood of the
 494 patrol car?
 495

496 TD At the time of the party?
 497

498 TT At the time of the party.
 499

500 TD Yeah I didn't know anything about them I found out about it the next day and I
 501 was thoroughly displeased.
 502

503 TT So the kegs, the keg of beer where everybody was you know pouring beer...
 504

505 TD Uh huh.
 506

507 TT ... was in the garage.
508
509 TD Uh huh.
510
511 TT The garage door is open.
512
513 TD Uh huh.
514
515 TT And the patrol car is sitting right there by the front of the garage.
516
517 TD Right.
518
519 TT So with you in there partaking as you said in the alcohol.
520
521 TD Uh huh.
522
523 TT At no time did you see those beer cups sitting on your patrol car?
524
525 TD I didn't see the beer cups sitting on the patrol car and after it occurred and I was
526 told about it I asked you know where was I yada, yada, yada, and they said you
527 were in the bedroom which is what we had discussed.
528
529 TT Who said you were in the bedroom?
530
531 TD The people that played beer pong. My sister, my brother in law, some other
532 people.
533
534 TT Ok so it's your statement that you weren't present when anybody was playing
535 beer pong or that you never saw the...
536
537 TD I wasn't present.
538
539 TT ...cups on the patrol car that night.
540
541 TD Not that night.
542
543 TT Alright Travis on December 11, 2011 which was the night that you got the phone
544 call from [REDACTED]...
545
546 TD Uh huh.
547
548 TT ...in reference to the disturbance you made an arrest on a male I believe it was for
549 not having a driver's license and you were transporting him to the jail do you
550 recall that?
551
552 TD Uh huh.

553
554 TT And I gave you a copy of the CAD printout for that night just to refresh your
555 mind and I think the affidavit is even in there also.
556
557 TD Yes.
558
559 TT You provided us last time we had our conversation, had your interview, with
560 some text messages that were sent between you and [REDACTED].
561
562 TD Correct.
563
564 TT So after reading those text messages it appeared that you were driving your
565 prisoner to the jail and there were some text messages that were being sent back
566 and fourth. So my question to you is were you driving your patrol car when those
567 texts were being sent?
568
569 TD Yes.
570
571 TT Ok and you're aware of the county policy 26.2.145?
572
573 TD The one that says you can't use your data device or your MDC while operating a
574 vehicle?
575
576 TT That you can't, you're not allowed to text.
577
578 TD Or use your MDC.
579
580 TT Or use your MDC uh huh, yeah.
581
582 TD Yep.
583
584 TT So you're aware of that policy? Do you feel like you violated that policy with the
585 texting?
586
587 TD Yes.
588
589 TT Ok, did you bring your phone bill in?
590
591 TD Yes.
592
593 TT Ok. We need to take a look at that because your prior statement you said that you
594 had a conversation with [REDACTED] after the text messages that were kind of hard to
595 understand.
596
597 TD Uh huh.
598

599 TT So you were saying that you had a conversation with her on the phone.
600
601 TD Uh huh.
602
603 TT So what we'd like to do is just verify that you actually had a phone conversation
604 with her instead of just these text messages.
605
606 TD My particular concern on that is the last time I provided information to absolve
607 myself of an accusation I'm in turn being dinked for it again for lack of a better
608 term.
609
610 TT Well here's the problem Travis. You're talking about she's asking about
611 something from you as a law enforcement officer and you're using your telephone
612 to talk to her...
613
614 TD Uh huh.
615
616 TT ...in regards to a possible criminal violation that may be taking place.
617
618 TD Uh huh.
619
620 TT So are you telling me that you're not going to provide those phone statements to
621 us?
622
623 TD I'm not saying I won't provide them I'm just expressing my concern.
624
625 TT I understand.
626
627 TD So.
628
629 TT And like I said we're just looking at that two hour window between 2 and 4.
630
631 TD Ok, I can, I can do that.
632
633 TT Do you have them with you?
634
635 TD I do.
636
637 TT Ok.
638
639 TD I printed out the specific page that has the phone call on it and I marked the phone
640 call. I guess that's number 1, I think it's 175 or 176 on there. It's got a little hash
641 mark next to it.
642
643 JV This is something I'm not good with.
644


645 TT What's that? Phone bills, phone records?
646
647 JV Absolutely.
648
649 TD Actually I think it says 3:29 as the time frame.
650
651 TT Ok was that the, lets see, 3:29.
652
653 TD And it should have her phone number listed next to it.
654
655 TT Right I got it here.
656
657 TD And if you guys want a copy of that I'd be happy to provide a copy of it so long
658 as everything else except for that one phone call is blocked out. Like I'll tape...
659
660 TT Yeah.
661
662 TD ...I'll tape paper on it and we can photocopy it if need be.
663
664 TT Yeah Travis we're not interested in this other stuff.
665
666 TD I, I'm...
667
668 TT You know we're just interested in the phone conversation that you had with her.
669
670 TD I understand and I don't necessarily think that it was your efforts to retrieve the
671 text messages that I willingly provided in attempts to again dink me with
672 anything. But just because it's not your intention doesn't mean that won't, that
673 isn't what will come from it, does that make sense?
674
675 TT Uh huh, yeah, yeah I understand. Ok, so you had the one conversation with her at
676 3:29? And that was when you were leaving the jail I assume because looking at
677 CAD it looks like maybe you cleared the jail about that time. Do we have that
678 print out, let me see that. Yeah you cleared at 0329 so, so you did have a
679 conversation with her shortly after you left the jail.
680
681 TD Uh huh.
682
683 TT What did she tell you in that phone conversation?
684
685 TD I don't remember anymore. I thought I had discussed it during my initial
686 interview.
687
688 TT So you don't recall anymore?
689
690 TD Huh uh.

691
692 TT Alright. Do you mind if Glen asks you any questions?
693
694 TD No I don't mind.
695
696 GB Actually I don't have anything.
697
698 TT Alright do you guys have anything?
699
700 BW Just to reiterate something, make it plain. When you talked with Sgt. McGuire
701 that night you did say I'm friends with this girl?
702
703 TD Correct.
704
705 BW And I see her all the time.
706
707 TD I had expressed a friendship. I don't know if I expressed the quantity of
708 association.
709
710 BW Yeah well that was my next thing. Did you feel the need to pile on all these
711 details like?
712
713 TD The way I had viewed my relationship with [REDACTED] was as a friend and I had called
714 Sgt. McGuire because I thought it may be a conflict of interest since we were
715 friends and I wanted clarification from him.
716
717 BW And you told him there was no romantic involvement or desire or anything.
718
719 TD Correct, I think his specific questions were "are you sleeping with her?" "have
720 you slept with her?" "are you trying to sleep with her?" or "are you dating her or
721 anything of the sorts?" and when I answered no to all of those he said then...
722
723 BW Ok. That's it guys.
724
725 TT Alright Travis is there anything else in this investigation that you would like to
726 talk about before we conclude the interview?
727
728 TD Out of curiosity how come nobody else on the witness list I provided you was
729 contacted in reference to anything? And the only reason I ask is because
730 obviously there's a criminal investigation or a criminal proceeding going on and
731 my attorney solicited witness statements from over a dozen people that all conflict
732 with what the vindictive person or the person who has an ax to grind with me has
733 said.
734
735 TT We're here talking about what you know and what your knowledge is of the
736 incident.


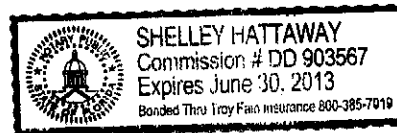

738 TD Ok, fair enough.
739
740 GB Well how, were they going to dispute the fact that the cups were on the car?
741
742 TD No.
743
744 GB Were they going to dispute the fact the car was not in your driveway in front of
745 your house?
746
747 TD No.
748
749 GB Were they going to dispute the text messages while you drove a 10-15 down State
750 Road 11?
751
752 TD No.
753
754 GB So what, I'm trying to think of the pertinent information that they would provide
755 that we don't already have.
756
757 TD Reference, reference my first interview and the allegations that were initially
758 brought against me. That's what I was referencing. Obviously they would have
759 no input what occurred with the particular arrest or anything of the investigation
760 or that sorts.
761
762 GB They'd have other testimony to offer that beer was not served to [REDACTED] or [REDACTED]?
763
764 TD Not by me. Aside from that that's all I have was just the curiosity as to why it
765 wasn't, why other people weren't contacted.
766
767 TT Ok.
768
769 GB Very good.
770
771 TT The time is now 1545 hours, this concludes the interview with Dep. Travis Deane.
772
