

1 On 02-01-2013 at 1925 hours, Sergeant Whitener responded to XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX in reference to a disturbance. On arrival
 2 Sergeant Whitener made contact with David M. Fuller(D1), who advised the following information.
 3
 4 Fuller(D1) advised he and his wife, Tania M. Fuller(V1) were in a verbal argument over Fuller(V1) not doing her part around the house.
 5 Fuller(D1) advised his wife became angry at him and said she was calling 911. Fuller(D1) advised his wife makes threats like that all the time
 6 because he is a deputy. Fuller(D1) didn't believe her and thought she was "bluffing". Fuller(D1's) wife told him she was taking their son, XXXXXX
 7 XXXX(W1) and leaving for the night. Fuller(D1) said he thought that was a good idea. Fuller(V1) grabbed her purse and van keys. Fuller(V1) then
 8 left the residence. Fuller(D1) stated he never made physical contact with his wife anytime during the argument. Fuller(D1) advised he never made
 9 any attempts to hit his wife or make any gestures to make her believe he would. Fuller(D1) stated he did not throw anything at any time. Fuller(D1)
 10 denied throwing a purse or a plastic container with wheels. Fuller(D1) stated his son, XXXXXXXXXXX (W1) was in his bedroom the entire time and



11 did not see any of the argument. Fuller(V1) was not there when deputies arrived. Fuller(D1) did not know where his wife went, however he
 12 provided Sergeant Whitener with her cell phone number.
 13
 14 Sergeant Whitener made contact with Fuller(V1) via the cell phone number provided and asked Fuller(V1) to return to the scene to talk to
 15 deputies. Fuller(V1) arrived on scene a short time later and advised the following information.
 16
 17 Fuller(V1) said she and her husband(Fuller D1) were in a verbal argument. Fuller(V1) advised her husband(Fuller D1) was yelling at her
 18 because she did not bring Chinese food home for him. While Fuller(V1) was getting their son ready for a bath, Fuller(D1) was yelling at her about
 19 who ate the potato chips. Fuller(V1) advised at that point she quit answering her husband's questions. Fuller(D1) called her a lazy bitch, a cunt,
 20 and told her she never does anything for him. Fuller(V1) decided she was going to leave the residence. When Fuller(D1) realized his wife was
 21 leaving he grabbed Fuller(V1's) purse and keys and ran outside with them. Fuller(V1) said her husband came back inside and tossed her purse
 22 back to her. Fuller(V1) advised her husband started running toward her with a clinched right fist. Fuller(V1) believed her husband was going to hit
 23 her, so she turned away in order to keep Fuller(D1) from hitting her in the face. When Fuller(V1) turned away her husband put her into a "bear
 24 hug". Fuller(V1) advised when her husband let her go, she grabbed the phone and called the police. When Fuller(V1) started to leave her husband
 25 sat down with their son and would not let him go with Fuller(V1). After more arguing Fuller(D1) released their son. Fuller(V1) said her husband
 26 followed her to the door and was yelling in her face, so close that she could smell the alcohol on his breath. Fuller(V1) went to the van to put their
 27 son in the car seat while Fuller(D1) was yelling the whole time. Fuller(V1) advised when she got in the car she immediately locked the doors. After
 28 locking the doors, Fuller(D1) started hitting the side of the van. Fuller(V1) observed her husband(Fuller D1) pick up a plastic container and said he
 29 was going to "pop her tires" with it. Fuller(V1) stated her husband threw it under her rear tire causing her to run over it. After the rear tire hit it,
 30 Fuller(D1) picked it up and stood in front of the van preventing her from diving forward. Fuller(V1) said she continuously pressed the horn for as
 31 long as it took for her husband to move. After Fuller(D1) moved, she left the residence to go to her parents.
 32
 33 Sergeant Whitener spoke with XXXXXXX(W1), who advised the following information.
 34
 35 XXXXX(W1) watched his parents yell and scream at each other. XXX(W1) said his Dad came up behind his mommy. XXXX(W1) told Sergeant
 36 Whitener that he watched his Dad grab his mommy from the back.
 37
 38 Sergeant Whitener observed Fuller(V1) to be visibly distraught. Fuller(V1) was shaking and advised she was in fear for her and her son's
 39 safety. Fuller(V1) had physical signs of injury(see Deputy Campbell's supplement). Sergeant Whitener did not observe Fuller(D1) to be under the
 40 influence of alcohol, however Fuller(D1) did admit to having several alcoholic beverages prior to deputies arriving. Sergeant Whitener the plastic
 41 carrier to be in broken with several pieces in the driveway, which is consistent with Fuller(V1's). Sergeant Whitener saw a tire track on the plastic
 42 container. The plastic container was collected and submitted to District Four evidence for safekeeping(see Deputy Savage's supplement). An
 43 audio disk of the 911 call was collected and uploaded to the digital crime scene data base(see Deputy Savage's supplement). All parties refused
 44 medical rescue at the scene.
 45
 46 Sergeant Whitener contacted the Watch Commander and Sergeant Stickle contacted the District Lieutenant.

1 On the above date and time, Deputy Campbell responded to XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX Deltona, reference to assist Deputies on scene in

2 obtaining photographs of injuries on a female victim. Upon arrival, Deputy Campbell made contact with Tania M Fuller (V1) who stated the

3 following:

4

5 Fuller (V1) stated her husband, David M Fuller III (D1), got angry with her earlier in the evening and they got into a heated verbal argument. Fuller

6 (V1) stated Fuller (D1) she was in fear so she attempted separating herself from the situation by leaving. Fuller (V1) stated Fuller (D1) raised his

7 fist to her and she thought he was going to punch her but wrapped his arms around her upper torso and squeezed her really tightly, not letting her

8 go for several seconds.

9

10 Deputy Campbell examined Fuller (V1) for any signs of visible injuries. Deputy Campbell observed redness on both of Fuller's (V1) arms. Deputy

11 Campbell took photographs of the bruising on Fuller's (V1) injuries and later placed them into the Digital Crime Scene Database. Deputy

12 Campbell collected a sworn written statement detailing the events from Fuller (V1), which is attached to the report. Deputy Campbell completed a

13 Domestic Violence Abuse Assessment of a Child for XXXXXXXX (W1) who witnessed the entire incident. The assessment is attached to the

14 report.

15

16 XXXXX (W1) stated Fuller (D1) was very upset with Fuller (V1) and was screaming and yelling at her. XXXXX (W1) stated Fuller (D1) was hitting

17 Fuller's (V1) van when she was attempting to leave. XXXXX (W1) stated Fuller (D1) also threw something at Fuller's (V1) van. XXXX (W1) stated


18 Fuller (D1) always destroys things inside the residence, even destroying one of his toys. XXXXX (W1) stated Fuller (D1) has advised Fuller (V1)

19 that he wanted to kill her. XXX (W1) stated he was very scared when Fuller (D1) was screaming at Fuller (V1) and throwing things at her vehicle.



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NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

1 On February 1 2013, Sergeant Stickels responded to XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival, Sergeant Stickels
 2 made contact with Deputy Savage and Fuller (D1) inside the residence. During the course of the investigation, Fuller stated that he had a verbal
 3 argument with his wife Fuller (V1) because she was not contributing to the household. Fuller (D1) said the argument was verbal in nature and
 4 there was never any physical contact between him and his wife Fuller (V1). While Fuller (D1) was speaking with Sergeant Stickels, he continually
 5 used vulgar language during his recollection of the incident. Fuller (D1) admitted that part of the argument on today's date was over him
 6 consuming alcohol. Fuller (D1) appeared to be intoxicated at the scene. Fuller (D1) did admit he followed Fuller (V1) outside the residence as she
 7 was attempting to leave with their child because he wanted to know where she was going. While inside the residence Sergeant Stickels did not
 8 notice any damage or evidence consistent with a physical altercation.
 9
 10 Sergeant Whitener spoke with Fuller (V1) via telephone. Fuller (V1) responded back to the residence to speak with deputies on scene after she
 11 called 911 for assistance. Sergeant Whitener was provided with information that Fuller (D1) attempted to puncture Fuller (V1's) tire with a plastic
 12 container to prevent her from leaving her residence prior to deputies arriving on scene. Sergeant Stickels located a dark colored plastic tote sitting
 13 in a chair. Sergeant Stickels noticed the plastic tote was broken in several pieces. Sergeant Stickels then located several more pieces of broken
 14 plastic in the rock driveway, which were consistent with the broken pieces of plastic in the chair. When Sergeant Stickels questioned Fuller (D1)
 15 about the broken plastic tote, he stated there is garbage all over outside and denied placing the container under Fuller (V1's) tire. After further
 16 inspection of the broken plastic and location where it was found, Sergeant Stickels determined that the physical evidence was consistent with the

 20 Stickels placed Fuller (D1) under arrest outside the residence. Fuller was escorted inside at which time Sergeant Stickels took possession of Fuller
 21 (D1's) department issued equipment including firearms, badges, department identification, and department issued keys. Sergeant Stickels also
 22 took possession of Fuller (D1's) department issued vehicle which was relocated and secured at District Four. Fuller (D1) was turned over to

12 a plastic chair near the front entrance of the house. Deputy Savage observed a tire track located on the collapsible cart. Deputy Savage



 21 Fuller(V1) arrived on scene a short time later and advised the following information.




 23 Fuller(V1) said she and her husband(Fuller D1) were in a verbal argument. Fuller(V1) advised her husband(Fuller D1) was yelling at her because
 24 she did not bring Chinese food home for him. While Fuller(V1) was getting their son ready for a bath, Fuller(D1) was yelling at her about who ate the
 25 potato chips. Fuller(V1) advised at that point she quit answering her husband's questions. Fuller(D1) called her a lazy bitch, a cunt, and told her she
 26 never does anything for him. Fuller(V1) decided she was going to leave the residence. When Fuller(D1) realized his wife was leaving he grabbed
 27 Fuller(V1's) purse and keys and ran outside with them. Fuller(V1) said her husband came back inside and tossed her purse back to her. Fuller(V1)
