Attached is a copy of the crash report that was investigated by Sgt. Vaughn.

I spoke with Sgt. Vaughn yesterday and he stated that the physical evidence from the crash did not support the scenario that Deputy Oliver described in the crash.

Both Deputy Oliver and Mr. Rivera were both issued a ticket for careless driving and shown to be inattentive in the crash.

No other charges were filed against Deputy Oliver. The burden for a criminal charge is much higher than the burden in an internal investigation for falsifying a police report.

We routinely interview drivers at crash scenes that are insistent on their view of how the crash happened, but the damage on the vehicles is not.

This alone would not support someone being charged with falsifying a police report.

You will see that the trooper's investigation and the deputy's version of the crash are documented in the narrative of the above report.
