INVESTIGATIVE LEADS/NARRATIVE:

On Wednesday, August 22, 2001 Sgt. SOCHA met with Captain ROBERT JONES. Captain JONES advised that information was received from various individuals that BRIAN PARE, a Deputy Sheriff with the Volusia County Sheriff's Office had made threats to commit suicide. The first incident occurred on Tuesday, August 21, 2001 at BRIAN PARE's residence in DeBary. Information from Deputy Sheriff MICHELLE BROWN indicated that DEPUTY BROWN had stopped by Deputy PARE'S residence and that Deputy PARE had curled himself inside a blanket while holding a firearm in his hand. The second incident occurred on Wednesday, August 22, 2001 after a minor confrontation outside of Sonny's Restaurant located on Saxon Blvd. in Orange City. At some point in the confrontation DEPUTY PARE began to strike himself in the face with his fists and then stated he was going to kill himself.

Captain JONES requested Sgt. SOCHA to complete a Baker Act form on DEP. PARE, proceed to DEP. PARE'S residence and transport DEP. PARE to a receiving facility. After completing the Baker Act form, Sgt. SOCHA arrived at DEP. PARE'S residence where he was met by Lt. JODY

INVESTIGATIVE LEADS/NARRATIVE:

PALERMO and DEPUTY BRIAN PARE. Sgt. SOCHA spoke with DEP. PARE AND asked about having any emotional problems. DEP. PARE advised that he was going through hard times due to his recent transfer/reassignment. DEP. PARE advised that he never mentioned attempting to commit suicide because he loved his parents, sister and her child. Sgt. SOCHA advised DEP. PARE that he needed to be transported to ACT due to allegations from individuals that he was contemplating suicide. While at the residence, Sgt. SOCHA completed the back page of the Baker Act form to include next of kin information. Dep. PARE while upset about the transport to a receiving facility remained calm. He did advise that he thought he needed to seek counseling due to an incident on I-4 in which he was badly beaten and also he was upset about his pending transfer to another division.

Prior to leaving the residence, Sgt. SOCHA and Lt. PALERMO collected Dep. PARE'S firearms, keys to his vehicle and identification card. The vehicle and weapons were later dropped off at District IV.

Lt. PALERMO and SGT. SOCHA transported DEP. PARE to ACT in Daytona Beach. Upon arrival at ACT, Sgt. SOCHA was advised by the intake counselor that no beds were available. The intake counselor advised that Florida Hospital in DeLand would accept a volunteer Baker Act at their facility but would not accept a Baker Act. Sgt. SOCHA spoke with Dep. PARE who advised he would voluntarily admit himself to Florida Hospital for psychological evaluation.

DEP. PARE Was then transported to West Volusia Hospital. At the hospital DEP. PARE was then medically cleared and then interviewed by Dr. KNIGHT. After approximately 45 minutes Dr. KNIGHT upon finishing his interview advised that DEP. PARE did not meet the criteria for a Baker Act. Sgt. SOCHA furnished Dr. KNIGHT with the original Baker Act form and asked Dr. KNIGHT if he though DEP. PARE needed to seek psychological assistance with his problem. Dr. KNIGHT stated that he would accept DEP. PARE as a volunteer for evaluation but that he thought he would probably be released in the morning after evaluation by the psychologist. Sgt. SOCHA asked Dr. KNIGHT if he would retain the original Baker Act Form in case Dep. PARE decided to change his mind and leave the hospital. Dr. KNIGHT stated that the paperwork was not needed that DEP. PARE would not be allowed to leave and was given a business card if Dep. PARE did change his mind.

After leaving the hospital, Lt. PALERMO contacted CAPTAIN JONES by telephone. CAPTAIN JONES according to LT. PALERMO advised that the voluntary evaluation was not suitable due to DEP. PARE'S statements and concern over his well-being. Additionally, Captain JONES believed that DEP. PARE should be in a secure facility.

Lt. PALERMO and SGT. SOCHA proceeded back to Florida Hospital in DeLand and then transported Deputy PARE to Halifax Hospital which is a receiving facility. The original Baker Act Form was left at the hospital.

BRIAN WAS VERY DISTRAUGHT OVER AN INCIDENT THAT HAD HAPPENED ON 08/18/01 (SUNDAY) MORNING. I SAID I SAW HIM IN HIS BED WITH NATASHA. I TOLD BRIAN THAT I COULD NOT SEE HIM ANYMORE AND DID NOT WANT HIM TO CALL OR ASK ME AGAIN SINCE HE OBVIOUSLY WAS DATING SOMEONE ELSE ANYWAY.
