Gary,

We are requesting documents from an incident that is over a year old, therefore, it is expected and certainly not a surprise that you didn't initially realize additional documents were available. Don't sweat it.

Additionally, we fully support the VCSO position, that all firearms are assumed to be loaded, REGARDLESS of any reports that they are not loaded. I can assure you that VolusiaExposed.Com will NOT become fixated on that topic.

I anticipate that our examination will focus more on whether the suspect attempted to level the firearm at the deputy and whether the deputy issued commands to drop the firearm prior to discharging his weapon.

Gary, is there any dashboard video / audio available regarding this incident. It is noted, in the 911 tape, that shortly before the shooting, the wife stated that she saw "a spot light from the cop car". Therefore, we are left wondering, if the dashboard camera captured any video or audio evidence of the shooting?

Lastly, a copy of the VCSO's USE OF FORCE Directives would be appreciated.
