

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11 spot lights and observed Gerard (V1) walking across the front of his property towards Sgt. Mejias. At this point in time Sgt. Mejias was standing
 12 behind or near the open drivers side door of his patrol vehicle. Sgt Mejias alerted VCSO dispatch and advised that Gerard (D1) was standing in
 13 the driveway, armed with a gun. Sgt. Mejias then commanded Gerard (D1) to drop his weapon several times. Gerard (D1) failed to comply with
 14 Sgt. Mejias and refused to drop the weapon, which was later identified as a Remington pump action shotgun, Model 870. Gerard (D1) then
 15 challenged Sgt Mejias by turning towards him and pointing the gun at Sgt Mejias. Sgt Mejias, in fear of his own safety and the safety of the others,
 16 fired his issued duty weapon at Gerard (D1) three times, hitting him once and ending the threat posed by Gerard (D1). Gerard (D1) dropped the
 17 weapon upon being shot, at which time Sgt. Mejias approached Gerard (D1) and immediately rendered aid. Gerard (D1) was immediately treated
 18 at the scene and flown by Air 1 to Halifax Health for further medical treatment. Sgt Mejias was not injured during the incident, and the shotgun
 19 Gerard (D1) had armed himself with and pointed at Sgt Mejias was later found to be unloaded.
 20
 21 Inv. Campanella conducted his investigation on scene and charged Gerard (D1) with Aggravated Assault on an LEO.

1 On above date and time Lt. Brown, who was the VCSO Watch Commander, was notified of a possible shooting involving a VCSO deputy. Lt.

2 Brown responded to 1165 S. Blue Lake Ave, Deland where the incident occurred. While on route Lt. Brown received information Sgt. Vidal Mejias

3 was involved with the shooting.

4

5 Upon arrival to the incident location, Lt. Brown met with Sgt. Mejias to get an overview of what happened. Sgt. Mejias said he responded to the

6 above address for a family disturbance. When Sgt. Mejias arrived on scene he parked his marked patrol car in the roadway in front of the above

7 residence. Sgt. Mejias observed a white male subject, later identified as , Joshua J. Gerard (D1) standing in the drive way brandishing a gun. Sgt.

8 Mejias told the subject several times to put down his weapon but Gerard refused to comply. Gerard then turned toward Sgt. Mejias and lifted the

9 gun up toward Sgt. Mejias. Sgt. Mejias then fired 3 rounds from his department issued handgun, toward Gerard, striking him in the left elbow and

10 the abdomen. Gerard fell to the ground. Sgt. Mejias notified Central Communications of the shots fired and requested EVAC & fire rescue to

11 respond. He then went to secure Gerard and render first aid.



 6 DISTURBANCE OCCURRED AT 1165 S. BLUE LAKE AVE., DELAND. INV. C. BOURKE-STURRUP WAS ALSO INFORMED THAT SGT. V.
 7 MEJIAS FIRED THREE SHOTS FROM HIS ISSUED .40 CALIBER FIREARM WHILE STANDING IN BETWEEN THE PATROL VEHICLE AND
 8 THE OPENED DRIVER SIDE DOOR.

The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant, on the 09 day of May, 2010, at approximately 0942 a.m. p.m. at 1165 S Blue lake Ave DELAND within Volusia County, violated the law and did then and there:

1 Defendant committed the offense of Aggravated Assault on an LEO to wit:
 2 The defendant had committed the offense of Aggravated Battery / Domestic Violence upon his wife Gerard, Sarah which caused Gerard, Sarah to
 3 flee her residence and call 911 for emergency assistance (See VCISO Case number #10-14239). Deputies from the Volusia County Sheriff's Office
 4 were called to respond to the incident location of 1165 S Blue Lake Ave, Deland. While VCISO Deputies were enroute to the incident location Gerard,
 5 Sarah advised VCISO Dispatch that the defendant poured gasoline on her, that there were guns in the house but there was no ammunition, and that
 6 she received a text from the defendant advising "I will not go to jail I will kill them all". Sgt. Vidal Mejias was first to arrive on scene. Sgt Mejias
 7 parked his vehicle in S Blue Lake Ave near the frontage of 1165 S Blue Lake Ave. While utilizing the lights on his vehicle and shining his spotlight in
 8 a northerly direction, Sgt Mejias visually observed the defendant walking towards him. Sgt Mejias immediately observed the defendant was armed
 9 with a shotgun (later identified as a Remington Model 870 pump action 12 gauge shotgun which was not loaded). Sgt. Mejias was positioned near
 10 the driver side door of his clearly marked VCISO patrol vehicle. Sgt. Mejias challenged the defendant and ordered the defendant to drop his weapon
 11 approximately three times. The defendant failed to comply with Sgt. Mejias' orders to drop the weapon. The defendant then challenged Sgt. Mejias,
 12 faced Sgt. Mejias, then willfully with the intent to kill Sgt Mejias, raised the shotgun towards Sgt. Mejias. Sgt. Mejias then fired his issued duty

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

1 On 05-09-10 at 2230, Inv. Dewees was dispatched to this incident to assist with crime scene processing. Inv. Dewees responded and arrived on
 2 the scene at 2349. Upon arrival, contact was made with Sgt. R. Combs. Sgt. Combs advised that Sgt. V. Mejias has responded to a disturbance
 3 call at the scene address. The suspect in the case, Joshua Gerard had doused his wife with gasoline and was standing at the end of his driveway
 4 holding a shotgun. Sgt. Mejias put his spotlight on the suspect and told him to drop his weapon. The suspect brandished the shotgun toward Sgt.
 5 Mejias, at which time Mejias fired three rounds at the suspect from his department issued handgun. The suspect was struck at least one time.
 6
 7 The victim had been transported from the scene prior to the arrival of Inv. Dewees. Inv. Dewees observed crime scene tape up around the area,
 8 and Sgt. Mejias's patrol vehicle on scene. Examination of the scene showed a Remington pump action shotgun on the ground at the end of the
 9 driveway. Sgt. Mejias's patrol vehicle was approximately 80 feet south of the shotgun. Three .40 caliber shell cases were found at the scene.
 10 One shell case was lodged on top of the passenger side rear door frame of the patrol car. Two additional shell cases were found on the ground at
 11 the passenger side of the patrol car.
 12
 13 Inv. Dewees inquired as to where Sgt. Mejias was standing when he fired his service pistol. Sgt. C. Brown advised that per, Sgt. Mejias, he was
 14 standing in the open door way of his patrol car, drivers door. When Sgt. Mejias fired he was positioned over the top of the spot light. This position
 15 would be consistent with the location of the shell cases.
 16
 17 Dep. C. Bourke was assigned to photograph, sketch and collect the evidence at the scene. Inv. Dewees examined the ground, trees, and
 18 buildings located in the line of fire. Inv. Dewees did not locate any projectile strikes. Inv. Campanella followed up behind Inv. Dewees searching
 19 for possible strikes. He did not find any either.
 20
 21 Inv. Dewees took custody of the suspect's shorts and a single projectile that was removed from his abdomen at the hospital. These items were
 22 received from FDLE Special Agent Timothy Krafft. Processing of the scene was completed at 0217.
 23
