1 On 08-07-2012 Deputy Igo was dispatched to 3875 Tiger Bay Road Bldg. 3, Daytona Beach (Stewart Marchman Act) in reference to a sex offense
2 of a child. Upon arrival Deputy Igo made contact with DCF Investigator Theodora Williams (O1) and Stewart Marchman Act employee Ahmad
3 Bryant (O2).
4
5 Williams advised XXXXXXX (V1) had told another child who resides with her at the Stewart Marchman facility she had been sexually assaulted
6 by a staff member. The child then reported XXXXXXX's allegations to Bryant, who contacted DCF to begin an investigation. Williams advised she
7 interviewed XXXXX and she told Williams she was touched inappropriately several times by Stewart Marchman employee Corey Hodges (S1). On
8 07-27-2012 Hodges entered XXXXXXX's room and proceeded to touch her buttocks, breasts and between her legs outside of her clothing and then
9 kissed her. On 07-28-2012 Hodges returned to XXXXXXX's room and kissed her again. XXXXXXX advised Hodges was transporting her to Halifax
10 hospital via company vehicle (See vehicle page) on 08-04-2012 and while enroute Hodges touched her thigh. Hodges asked XXXXXXX if she would

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11 allow him to touch her but XXXXX said she was uncomfortable and Hodges stopped touching her. Williams advised once XXXXX told her she was
 12 touched inappropriately, Williams contacted the Volusia County Sheriff's Office to request a report. Williams also advised XXXXX's parents had
 13 been notified about the investigation.

 15 Bryant advised the facility has video cameras which captured images of Hodges going to XXXXX's room and inappropriately touching her. Deputy
 16 Igo requested a copy of the video footage from staff members. Bryant advised he would have to contact their IT personnel and would contact the
 17 Sheriff's Office when the footage became available. Bryant advised Hodges had been placed on administrative leave while the investigation was
 18 being completed.
 19
 20 Deputy Igo provided Williams with a business card and case number. A copy of this report was faxed to DCF.

3 On 08/08/12, Inv. Burke was contacted by Theodora Williams in reference to this case. Theodora explained that she wanted to have an interview

4 conducted with XXXXXXXX (V1) on this day. Theodora advised that XXXXXXXX disclosed that a worker at Stewart Marchman RAP (Residential

5 Adolescent Program), Hodges, Corey (S1), has touched her inappropriately. XXXXXX disclosed that Corey entered her room and touched her

6 buttocks, breast, and between her legs. XXXXXX disclosed several incidents to Theodora. Theodora advised that Corey had been moved to the

7 RAP program after he was moved from another facility (Vince Carter Sanctuary) due to being inappropriate with clients.

8

9 On 08/08/12, an interview was conducted with XXXXXX at The Children's Advocacy Center with Mike Tagg. During the interview XXX advised that

10 she was touched inappropriately by Mr. Hodges. XXXXXX advised that the first time was on 07/27/12, she was in bed and her two roommates were

11 not in the room. She explained that one roommate was at home on a hall pass and her other roommate was under observation due to being

12 suicidal. XXXX advised that Mr. Hodges was doing regular checks and came to her doorway and told her to get out of bed. She told him that she

13 was not decent and was only wearing a t-shirt and underwear, he told her to get out of bed anyway. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges put his hand

14 in her shirt and touched her breast. She advised that he told her to turn around and then he touched her butt and her vagina over her clothes.

15 XXXXXX advised that he also kissed her on the lips. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges told her not to tell anyone about this happening.

16

17 XXXX advised that the next morning (07/28/12), she woke up and was reading a book. She advised that Mr. Hodges came into her room and told

18 her to get out of bed again. XXXXXX advised that she was wearing the same clothes. She advised that Mr. Hodges put his hand up her shirt and

19 touched her breast, then turned her around and touched her butt and vagina over her clothes. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges also kissed her

20 then. She stated that he again told her not to tell anyone about what happened. XXXXXX advised that there was a new girl at the program named

21 "XXXXXX" (who left yesterday) who was sleeping in the hallway near her doorway on the night and morning that this occurred.

22

23 XXXXXX advised that there are cameras at the RAP Program. XXXXXX advised that she was staying in room three and the camera was on the wall

24 near her room. XXXX advised that when she wrote down what happened with Mr. Hodges (in the Program Director's office) she saw a flat screen

25 with the security camera images on it. She advised that the entrance to her room could be seen on the TV.

26

27 XXXXXX advised that on Friday 08/03/12, she broke her finger playing football and Mr. Hodges took her to the hospital. XXXXXX advised that while at

28 the hospital Mr. Hodges told her that he did not trust her and he thought that she was going to tell people about what had happened. XXXXXX

29 advised that she told him that she would not tell anyone about what happened. XXXXXX advised that on the way back from the hospital Mr. Hodges

30 was rubbing her thigh and asking her if it made her feel uncomfortable, she told him that it did. She advised that he asked her when he could touch

31 "it" (her vagina); she told him that he could not do this. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges told her to pull her shorts up and she told him no. She

32 advised that he did not touch her vagina while driving back.

33

34 XXXXXX advised that nothing else occurred between her and Mr. Hodges. She advised that she did not think that he touched any of the other girls

35 at the program. XXXXXX advised that he would look at other girls. XXXXXX advised that he would drop things and make her room mate, XXXXXX,

36 pick them up, and watch her. XXXX advised that when she got to the RAP Program the other girls told her that Mr. Hodges was a pervert and that

37 they had caught him staring at another girl's butt (XXXXXX). XXXXXX advised that she did not go and tell on Mr. Hodges she said that they (the staff)

38 asked her if any contact occurred and she stated yes. This interview was recorded; refer to DVD with recorded interview for details.

39

40 Several other girls from RAP were also transported to CAC at the request of DCF. XXXXXXXX, XXXXXXXX, and XXXXXXXX.

41

42 Inv. Burke and Theodora Williams conducted an interview with XXXXXXXXXXXX. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges had been saying some

43 stuff. XXXXXX advised that he would ask her for hugs and made comments about beating up a guy that she was dating because he was

44 jealous. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges said they were going to hang out on the "outs" and he would take care of her when she was out there.

45 She advised that he asked her if all she wanted was a "high five" when she turned eighteen and told her she would be legal for him when

46 eighteen. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges told her if she gets engaged on her home pass there will never be a chance for them. XXXXXX

47 advised that he would say this stuff to her in the middle room. XXXXXX advised that she has been alone with him but usually others are in the

48 room too. XXXXXX advised that she has been at RAP since April and Mr. Hodges started saying things approximately a month and a half after

49 she was there. XXXXXX advised on another occasion, Mr. Hodges stood outside her room and dropped a basketball in her room and told her to

50 pick it up, she said she didn't have a bra or pants on, just a shirt. XXXXXX advised that this incident occurred approximately two weeks prior

51 (unknown date or time). XXXXXX advised that she got the ball and gave it to him. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges is in the hallway all the

52 time checking on them. XXXXXX advised that when a male staff is in the girls hall they are supposed to announce it but he does not. XXXXXX

53 advised that she did not say anything to Mr. Hodges when he made these comments to her. XXXXXX advised that he also hugged her in the

54 middle room while no one else was in there one time; she denied that he touched her inappropriately. XXXXXX advised that she told her shift

55 manager Ms. Corn what happened after she heard about what happened to XXXXXX. XXXXXX advised that XXXXXX told her about what

56 happened with XXXXXX. XXXXXX advised that other girls told her that he made inappropriate comments to them while they stayed there.

57 XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges said XXXXXX was too hot to have done drugs as much as they said they did, he said "their asses were too

58 nice". XXXXXX advised that none of the other staff ever heard him say this stuff.

60 Inv. Burke and Theodora Williams also conducted an interview with XXXXXXXXXXXX. XXXXXX advised that she has been in the RAP program

61 since March 17th. XXXXXX advised that when she was going thru withdrawal from heroin she was in a room and Mr. Hodges told her to get up.

62 She told him that she was naked and he said it didn't matter, she said she got up and went to the closet and changed, she said he stood half way

63 in the doorway. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges made comments that she and another girl (XXXXXXXX) were look too good looking and "too

64 thick" to have been using meth. XXXXXX advised that she told Mr. Hodges that she was gay one day and she said told him she likes older guys

65 and he asked if she liked guys her age. XXXXXX advised that he told her that she and XXXXXX had too nice of bodies to have done drugs. XXXX

66 advised that someone told her about what happened with XXXXX then XXXX told her what happened. XXXXX advised that XXXX told her that he

67 came into her room and was messing around and kissed her, she said she did not give her details.

68

69 XXXXXX advised that she was naked the day she was going thru withdrawal (first two weeks she got to RAP) because she was hot. XXXXXX

70 advised Mr. Hodges was getting her up because it was time to eat. XXXXXX advised that she told him she was naked and tried to put blanket on

71 and he said drop the blanket. XXXXXX said she didn't think much of it until the stuff that happened to XXXXXX and the stuff he said to the girls.

72

73 Inv. Burke and Theodora Williams also conducted an interview with XXXXXXXXXXXX. XXXXXX advised that she started the RAP program on June

74 15th. XXXXXX advised that Mr. Hodges told her that she should be a stripper because she has a nice body. XXXXXX advised he told she should

75 be his "sugar mama" and said he could be her "sugar daddy." XXXXXX advised that at the gym he told her to do squats so her butt would be firm

76 and he wants to see her "drop it like it's hot." XXXXXX advised that she would get candy from him and ask for more and he would ask her what
