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


NARRATIVE

1 On 02-19-2015 at approximately 0149 hours, Deputy Winnie responded to the 1400 block of Colin Kelly Ave, Daytona Beach in reference to an
 2 incident involving dating violence. (SEE VSCO 15-4638) At the conclusion of the investigation, Jessica Monroe(R1) was placed under arrest for
 3 simple battery (dating violence). At the time of her arrest Monroe was heavily intoxicated and uncooperative. Due to Monroe's behavior, prior to
 4 transport, Deputy Winnie began recording Monroe using a digital voice recorder in the patrol vehicle.
 5
 6 While Deputy Winnie was transporting Monroe to the Branch Jail, she became violent and began to kick at the door and window of Deputy
 7 Winnie's patrol vehicle. Deputy Winnie requested a second unit and stopped at the intersection of Red John Rd and W International Speedway
 8 Blvd. Deputy Winnie and Deputy Feaster were able to briefly calm Monroe and finish transporting her to the jail. Once inside the sally port area of
 9 the jail, Monroe again began to kick at the doors and windows of the vehicle. Monroe was removed from the vehicle and calmed down long
 10 enough to be taken into the intake area of the jail. Monroe again became uncooperative and refused to be fingerprinted. The intake officer

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION	<p>11 advised the booking officer of Monroe's refusal to cooperate. The intake officer then instructed Deputy Winnie to go ahead and bring Monroe into</p> <p>12 booking. Once inside booking, Monroe made the allegation she was raped at OB's Lounge in Deland (1750 N Woodland Blvd). At that time</p> <p>13 booking instructed Deputy Winnie that per the jail's policy Monroe would need to be transported to Halifax Hospital to be treated/medically cleared.</p> <p>14 Monroe refused to go to the hospital and continued being uncooperative. Monroe had to be removed from the jail and escorted back to Deputy</p> <p>15 Winnie's patrol vehicle. Deputy queried Monroe if Gregory Plewa(O1), the victim she battered, was the suspect who raped her. Monroe advised it</p> <p>16 was not Plewa, but a man named Jimmy who is a regular patron of OB's where she is employed. Monroe would not answer any questions about</p> <p>17 the incident and began screaming at the top of her lungs over and over while kicking the doors and windows of Deputy Winnie's patrol vehicle.</p> <p>18</p> <p>19 Deputy Winnie notified Sgt Hattaway of the allegation and he responded to the jail. Sgt Hattaway notified the watch commander, Lt Gowan of the</p> <p>20 incident and also requested the on-call CID Investigator respond to the jail to interview Monroe. While waiting for Lt Gowan and CID to respond</p> <p>21 Monroe slipped one of her handcuffs and again began to kick at the door and window of the patrol vehicle. Monroe was re-handcuffed and</p> <p>22 hobbled. Monroe was able to slip off her boots and defeat the hobble. Monroe began striking the steel bars of the vehicle with her head yelling</p> <p>23 she wanted to kill herself. Deputy Winnie removed Monroe from the vehicle at which point she tried unsuccessfully to hit her head on the cement</p> <p>24 floor of the sally port. Sgt Hattaway and Deputy Winnie placed Monroe in a sitting position and restrained her from striking her head on the</p> <p>25 concrete. At some point during the act of restraining Monroe, Corrections Officers and their lieutenant began recording Monroe's actions using a</p> <p>26 hand held, digital video recording device. Shortly thereafter Lt Gowan and Investigator Ott arrived on scene.</p> <p>27</p> <p>28 Monroe refused to cooperate with investigator Ott's investigation and continued to yell obscenities and act ill rational and combative. At that time it</p> <p>29 was determined Monroe was a danger to herself and others and she was taken into protective custody under the Baker Act statute. EVAC and fire</p> <p>30 rescue responded to the scene to treat Monroe. Monroe then disclosed to rescue she had taken Adderall in addition to drinking a large amount of</p> <p>31 alcohol. Monroe was unarrested and transported to Halifax Hospital for treatment and further evaluation. ADMINISTRATIVE	<p>1 After Deputy Feaster departed Volusia County Branch Jail, he was informed by Deputy Winnie that Jessica Monroe made a sexual battery allegation while being received by the jail. After meeting with Deputy Winnie at the jail, Deputy Feaster proceeded to the residence of Monroe's boyfriend Gregory Plewa. Deputy Feaster activated an audio recorder and met with Plewa.</p> <p>2</p> <p>3</p> <p>4</p> <p>5 Plewa stated he was rehearsing with his band in Port Orange while Monroe was working and also celebrating her birthday at OB's Restaurant & Lounge in DeLand. He received a text message from Monroe in which she stated she was intoxicated and wished for him to pick her up. Plewa arrived at the bar at approximately midnight and found Monroe to be heavily intoxicated. Monroe and a female friend of her's went into the women's restroom, then exited and engaged in a physical altercation with each other. Plewa did not know the name of the friend.</p> <p>6</p> <p>7</p> <p>8</p> <p>9</p> <p>10 Plewa stated Monroe's employment at OB's Restaurant & Lounge was terminated due to her behavior described above. According to Plewa, none of Monroe's text messages to him indicated she had been sexually battered. Plewa was unable to locate his and Monroe's cellular telephones for Deputy Feaster. Plewa stated Monroe also made no mention of having been sexually battered during the course of the evening.</p> <p>11</p> <p>12</p>



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

1 On 02-19-2015, at approximately 0534 hours, Deputy Galarza responded to OB's Lounge (1750 N Woodland Blvd, DeLand) in reference to a
 2 follow up investigation to a sexual battery. Upon arrival, Deputy Galarza made contact with O'Brien, Ashley (O1) an employee for OB's Lounge.
 3 O'Brien advised the following.
 4
 5 O'Brien advised Monroe, Jessica (V1) was at work on 02-18-2015 at approximately 2000 hours. O'Brien observed Monroe was acting happy, but
 6 had taken several Jameson Whiskey shots by midnight. O'Brien observed Monroe was intoxicated and in a physical altercation with another
 7 employee, "Rebecca". The altercation took place by the girls bathroom. O'Brien confronted Monroe and advised her she would be taken off the
 8 work schedule and needed to leave and not come back. O'Brien observed Monroe leave OB's with her boyfriend, "Greg". O'Brien advised she did
 9 not observe Monroe in distress as she left on her own free will.
 10
 11 Deputy Galarza made contact with OB's employee, Wheat, Rae (O2) who reported the following information.
 12
 13 Wheat advised she had observed her co-worker, Monroe having several shots throughout the night. Wheat observed by midnight, Monroe was
 14 having difficulty walking to the bathroom. Wheat observed Monroe being assisted into the bathroom by another co-worker. Wheat advised Monroe
 15 was in the bathroom for a "long time". After several minutes in the bathroom, Monroe exited the bathroom with "Rebecca". Wheat observed
 16 Monroe was in a physical altercation with "Rebecca". After the altercation was stopped, Wheat heard O'Brien telling Monroe not to come back to
 17 work. Wheat observed Monroe leaving OB's with her boyfriend.
 18
 19 O'Brien and Wheat provided written statements.
 20
 21 No further action taken by Deputy Galarza.

 23 Scene turned over to Inv. S. Ott along with written statements provided.

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

1 On 02/18/2015, Investigator Paul was called out and asked to responded to the Halifax Medical Center at 201 North Clyde Morris Blvd, Daytona Beach in reference to report of a sexual assault.

2

3

4 Upon arrival, Investigator Paul observed Investigator Ott speaking with a white female, later identified as Jessica Monroe. Monroe was lying down on a hospital bed with both hands and feet strapped down. Investigator Paul later learned, Monroe was arrested for battering her boyfriend, Gregory Plewa. Once arrested, Monroe became extremely combative, trying to strike Deputies and kick out a patrol car's window. Monroe was transported to the Volusia County Jail, where she claimed she was sexually assaulted by an unknown male. After biting, punching, and kicking paramedics, Monroe was ultimately transported to the Halifax Medical Center for treatment.

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9

10 Investigator Ott stated she was unable to get a consistent statement from Monroe. Monroe was acting irrational and most of what she was saying did not make any sense. Investigator Paul was asked to speak with Monroe and possibly get more consistent statement.

13 Investigator Paul made contact with Monroe and the following in a brief of her statement;

14

15 Monroe stated on 02/19/2015, she was at OB's bar in DeLand, where she currently works. According to Monroe, around 0100 hours she entered the bathroom at the bar and a female by the name of "Becka" attacked her for no reason. After she was attacked by Becka, her boyfriend took her to his house on Highway 92. Monroe stated her boyfriend was Polish and insisted his name was "Crashel". Monroe claimed she wanted to leave the house in order to see her children and Plewa tried to stop her. Monroe stated it was only her and Plewa at the house when the assault allegedly happened. When asked about the assault, Monroe stated "someone" had touched her vagina. Monroe claimed, someone had put their hand down her pants and touched the outside of her vagina. Monroe would not say who touched her, only claims they were trying to get her "gold". When asked what her gold was, she began to smile and speak words that had no meaning.

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23 On several occasions, Monroe would stray off topic and speak incoherently. Investigator Paul asked Monroe directly, if Plewa sexually assaulted her and said, "he does in his own way". When asked if she wanted to pursue charges against Plewa, Monroe smiled and made reference to making love to him. Monroe would not say if Plewa actually assaulted her, then asked Investigator Paul to cover her face with the sheets so she could think. After several minutes of incoherent speaking, Monroe stated she no longer wanted to talk.

28 The interview was recorded and a copy was later submitted as evidence.

29

30 Investigators Paul and Ott proceeded to the OB's bar located at 1750 North Woodland Blvd, DeLand. Investigator Paul made contact and conducted an interview with Rebecca Sclafani. The following is a brief of her statement;

33 Sclafani stated, she knows Monroe from working at the bar. Sclafani was not working this morning, however she stopped by with her husband to play billiards. According to Sclafani, Monroe approached her and asked to speak with her in private. Monroe walked with Sclafani to the bathroom where Monroe began to complain about her life. Sclafani said, Monroe wanted to know why she could not have her kids and her boyfriend was not good for her. Sclafani told Monroe, if she wanted to get her life straight, hanging out at bars and trying to score cocaine was not the right way. According to Sclafani, Monroe then attacked her, pushing her into the stall. Sclafani was able to break free and leave the bathroom. Monroe followed Sclafani and attacked her again near the front door of the bar. Sclafani stated, several patrons separated them both, then Monroe and Plewa left the bar. Sclafani stated she was not hurt and she does not wish to pursue any charges against Monroe.

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

NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

1 On 02/19/2015 at approximately 0351 hours, Investigator Ott was requested to respond to Volusia County Branch Jail in regards to a female that
 2 had been arrested by VCSO Patrol Deputies for Dating Violence and alleged she had been raped by an unknown suspect at OB's Lounge in
 3 Deland. Investigator Ott was advised Deputies were on scene at OB's Lounge where the incident had allegedly occurred in the rear parking lot.
 4 Prior to Investigator Ott arriving at the jail, Deputy Feaster had obtained a recorded statement from Monroe's boyfriend (Greg Plewa) that Monroe
 5 had made no mention of being "raped" and stated he had driven to Monroe's job to pick her up. Monroe had sent him a text message that she was
 6 drunk and needed him to drive her home. It was during the drive home that Monroe had punched Plewa in the face and subsequently arrested by
 7 VCSO. (A copy of the recording was provided to Investigator Ott and placed into evidence by Investigator Ott).
 8 Upon arrival at the jail, Investigator Ott observed the alleged victim, Jessica Monroe, handcuffed and seated on the concrete inside the sally port
 9 of the jail. Investigator Ott was advised by VCSO Watch Commander Lieutenant Gown that due to Monroe's actions of hitting her head inside
 10 Deputy Winnie's patrol vehicle and striking Deputies, the decision was made to Baker Act Monroe and have her transported to Halifax Hospital by
 11 EVAC.
 12
 13 While waiting for EVAC to arrive, Investigator Ott attempted to interview Monroe but was met with a barrage of profane dialogue from Monroe.
 14 EVAC arrived on scene shortly thereafter and Monroe was combative with Deputies and EVAC personnel while they were attempting to secure
 15 Monroe to the gurney. Monroe attempted to bite an EVAC employee on his left thigh but a rugged plastic case was in pocket that fowled Monroe's
 16 attempt to puncture his skin. Monroe continued with profane language and appeared as if she were under the influence of a narcotic as well as
 17 reeking of alcohol consumption. Monroe was making no sense in the words she was yelling stating she asked for help and kept screaming the
 18 name Daniel Piccola. (It was learned at a later time Piccola was an acquaintance of Monroe's as well as a law enforcement officer in the city of
 19 Ormond Beach). Monroe stated that she did not want "to be fucking touched by anyone" when asked if she would allow a SART examination.
 20 Due to the allegations by Monroe, EVAC requested Investigator Ott accompany EVAC personnel inside the ambulance. Again Investigator Ott
 21 attempted to interview Monroe regarding the allegations but Monroe continued to state she did not want any help, and nothing had happened.
 22 Monroe was transported to Halifax Hospital Daytona Beach once there she had to be secured by Halifax Hospital staff. Monroe was combative
 23 and disruptive to the point that she was administered a sedative by order of the on duty physician. After Monroe calmed from the medication,
 24 Investigator Ott was able to glean some information regarding the allegations. Monroe only shared that "they" put fingers there. When Investigator
 25 Ott attempted to obtain additional information, Monroe started insisting that she wanted to go home and she wanted to forget everything. There
 26 was never any consistent or complete information obtained from Monroe about the alleged assault except the person had only used "fingers to
 27 touch her". Monroe was unable to give a suspect description, name, or gender, in addition to a location where the incident occurred. Monroe was able
 28 able to recall she had consumed numerous alcoholic "shots" of Jameson Whiskey and pickle juice as it was her birthday. Monroe had initially
 29 stated she was thirty-nine years old but after some time had passed she was able to state her proper age of twenty-nine years. Monroe stated she
 30 had gone to work at OB's and closed the bar around 0200 hours. Monroe then started talking about random topics as if her mental status was
 31 altered. (For example, she kept asking to have her face covered with a sheet so she could "imagine" what she was seeing). Investigator Ott
 32 concluded the interview with Monroe and learned from hospital staff Monroe's ETA levels were .260. Other narcotics were unable to be screened
 33 as Monroe was unable to provide a urine sample due to the restrains placed upon her by hospital staff. (The interview attempts completed by
 34 Investigator Ott were recorded on digital audio and placed into evidence at VCSO District Six by Investigator Ott). Monroe also initially stated she
 35 had ran on foot from the attacker and lost her shoes but changed her story stating she had been chased from the bar in a car by the suspect and
 36 that numerous men had straddled her and she fought them off.
 37
 38 Investigator Paul arrived on scene a short while later and attempted to interview Monroe to see if any additional information could be obtained
 39 about the alleged incident. Monroe provided Investigator Paul with a different name of her "boyfriend". Monroe did indicate to Investigator Paul that
 40 someone had used their fingers and touched her and it happened at "his house" but could not provide the identity of the unknown male. Monroe
 41 stated her boyfriend was not the person who assaulted her and that it had happened in the bar.
 42
 43 Investigators traveled to OB's Lounge where Deputy Galarza had maintained control of the location until the investigation could be completed.
 44 Deputy Galarza had obtained written statements from employees who were on scene during the alleged incident at the request of Investigator Ott.
 45 After reading the statements wherein both employees advised Monroe had been terminated for her fighting behavior and intoxicated level while
 46 working, both employees (one the manager and daughter of the owner) were asked how and with whom Monroe had left the establishment. Both
 47 parties stated Monroe's boyfriend had interrupted the fight between Monroe and another employee. For no apparent reason other than her
 48 intoxicated state, Monroe grabbed the other female employee around the throat in the ladies' room and then followed the other female out into the
 49 main area of the bar. Monroe is observed on video surveillance throwing a roundhouse punch in the direction of the other female and the two
 50 ensued in a physical altercation that was stopped almost instantly. Monroe was observed leaving the establishment with her boyfriend (Plewa) at
 51 about 0120 hours.
 52
 53 Investigator Ott recovered the CAD call, the 911 call from YYYYYYYYYY, and law enforcement radio transmissions of the incident and placed
 54 CD's of all into evidence at VCSO District Six. Investigator Ott noted in the CAD call that YYYYYYYY at 0149 hours from YYYYYYYYYYYYYYYY
 55 YYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYYY after Monroe had struck him in the face. According to Google Maps the distance between OB's Lounge
 56 and Plewa's residence is 12.5 miles and the travel time would be eighteen minutes in duration.
 57
 58 Based on the lack of cooperation by the victim, the inconsistencies of the recollection of the alleged events, the statements of eyewitnesses, and





NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

1 On 02-19-2015, at approximately 0840 hours, Inv. Amrhine was contacted by Sgt. MacDowell in reference to the aforementioned sexual battery
 2 complaint. Inv. Amrhine was informed that Inv. Ott was currently investigating the complaint, and that she was on scene at OB's Lounge located
 3 at 1750 N. Woodland Blvd., Deland, regarding the incident. Inv. Amrhine was further advised an alleged female victim who worked at the bar
 4 during the night claimed that she was dragged out of view of surveillance cameras and raped. Inv. Amrhine was advised the female battered her
 5 boyfriend, and while being combative and belligerently intoxicated when being turned over to the VCBJ staff then made the rape allegations to the
 6 present authorities.
 7
 8 Inv. Amrhine along with Inv. Pierce then responded to OB's Lounge to meet with Inv. Ott. Inv. Amrhine was briefed by Inv. Ott of the current
 9 updates, and was advised the original claim by the female, identified as Jessica Monroe, that she was raped outside of the bar was no longer
 10 valid. Inv. Amrhine learned that Monroe changed her account of the incident to reflect that someone touched her vagina with their hand after she
 11 and her boyfriend left the bar and went back to Daytona Beach where they lived. Inv. Amrhine was advised Monroe had consumed vast quantities
 12 of alcohol (Jameson whiskey) comparable to her size, and was also prescribed medications for anxiety and mood disorders. Inv. Amrhine was
 13 advised the initial interview with Monroe was difficult due to her extremely intoxicated state, however, Monroe gave conflicting accounts of the
 14 nights events. Inv. Amrhine was advised Monroe was at the bar from about 2000 hours until around 0115 hours the next morning. Inv. Amrhine
 15 was advised Monroe, in her intoxicated state, was involved in a physical altercation with another female employee of the bar. No one was
 16 physically injured during the scuffle, and Monroe and her boyfriend left the bar soon after. Inv. Amrhine was advised Monroe was celebrating her
 17 birthday. Written statement copies from bar witnesses were provided to Inv. Amrhine for review.
 18
 19 Inv. Amrhine was advised Monroe was transported to Halifax Medical Center to be evaluated under the Baker Act due to her actions and
 20 extremely intoxicated state.
 21
 22 Inv. Ott advised Inv. Amrhine that surveillance footage of the previous night was available, and that bar employees were working on retrieving it.
 23 Inv. Amrhine met with Chris, bar employee, who assisted in accessing the surveillance footage. Inv. Amrhine observed the pertinent footage, and
 24 the following observations were made:
 25
 26 Timestamp 02-19-2015, approximately 0110 hours, (2) females are observed to engage in a physical altercation. One of the female's was
 27 observed to be thin and of smaller stature, while the other was of medium build and larger than the first female. The altercation was quickly
 28 broken up by other patrons, and the scene was calm. It appeared the smaller female was being consoled by other patrons, as a male believed to
 29 be the smaller female's boyfriend, went outside. Inv. Amrhine observed the male went and retrieved his vehicle from the parking lot and started it
 30 up. Inv. Amrhine observed the female wait outside with another female until the male returned. Around 0115 hours, both the female and the male
 31 walked together to their vehicle, got inside, and drove away towards N. Woodland Blvd. in a normal fashion. Inv. Amrhine was advised the smaller
 32 female was Monroe, and the male was her boyfriend Greg Plewa. Inv. Amrhine at no point in the video observed anything suspicious, or indicative
 33 of someone being dragged off out of view of the cameras.
 34
 35 Chris was provided with a flash drive to download and save the footage for Inv. Amrhine.
 36
 37 Inv. Amrhine and Inv. Pierce later attempted to make contact with Monroe at Halifax for a follow-up interview, but met with negative results.
 38 Investigators were advised that due to her current state, Monroe was unable to speak with investigators; however, they would be contacted when
 39 she is alert and able to speak.
 40
 41 Investigators made multiple attempts to contact Plewa at his provided contact number, but met with negative results. Inv. Pierce left a voice
 42 message detailing the reason for the call, and requested a call back. Investigators then responded to Plewa's residence located at 1454 Colin
 43 Kelly Ave., Daytona Beach, to contact him, but met with negative results.
 44
 45 Inv. Amrhine later reviewed all written statements, Plewa's audio interview, and reports generated for the incident. Inv. Amrhine observed the
 46 witness accounts of the evening corresponded with the observed video, and timeline of events. Inv. Amrhine observed on CAD, that XXXXX
 47 contacted VCSO Communications reference the battery complaint around 0149 hours, which was approximately (34) minutes after they left OB's.
 48 Inv. Amrhine observed that Plewa's statement given to Dep. Feaster gave the same account of the night's events at the other witnesses at the bar,
 49 as well as the surveillance footage. As it pertained to the allegations of rape or someone touching Monroe's vagina, Plewa expressed disbelief
 50 and confusion about the allegations, and gave a statement to the negative regarding knowledge of any such assault.
 51 Inv. Amrhine saved the bar surveillance footage to a CD and later submitted the disk into VCSO District II Evidence.
 52
 53 Inv. Amrhine was later contacted by Inv. Pierce who advised the following:
 54
 55 At approximately 1810 hours, Inv. Pierce conducted a follow-up interview with Monroe in J-pod at Halifax Medical Center. Inv. Pierce advised she
 56 contacted Monroe who was in custody under the Baker Act. Inv. Pierce stated she inquired about the previous night's events, and asked Monroe
 57 about her allegations. Monroe declined to cooperate with any further investigation, as well as stated she did not wish to speak about the previous
 58 night's events. Monroe thanked Inv. Pierce for her time, and advised she no longer wanted law enforcement involvement.
