at the female driver through her open window to pull the car over to the side of the road. The car then accelerated toward Hart Avenue.

I activated my emergency lights and went after the vehicle. The car ran the stop sign at Snyder and Hart and went north on Hart at a high rate of speed. The car then turned left onto Otter Drive. The car then nearly went into the ditch at the dead end of Otter Drive.

The female driver got out of her car and ran toward my patrol car despite me telling her to get back into her vehicle. I took her by the arm and walked her back and sat her in her car. I then called out my traffic stop on the radio.

I observed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's person. I asked her for her driver's license and she stated it was in her purse. I asked her to get it and she stated "why, I'm going to jail anyway."

I asked the driver why she nearly hit my patrol car and then ran from me and she stated because she was going through a nasty divorce and her husband was a Deputy. She said I saw the Deputy vehicle and. I asked her and what, you tried to hit me because you thought I was your ex-husband? She did not answer at that time. I then asked her why she refused to stop after I ordered her to and activated my emergency lights. She stated "I'm having a bad night."

I identified the driver as Cara Mia Odgers. Cara pulled out a cigarette and I stated please do not smoke while I'm conducting my investigation. Cara stared at me for a moment the produced a book of matches. I again said do not light a cigarette while I'm conducting my investigation. Cara looked at me stated "whatever" and lit the match. I removed the cigarette from her mouth and told her that was the last warning she was going to receive. Cara became angry and stated I did not have to be so mean about it.

I asked Cara if she knew where she was and she stated she was lost. I asked her where she was going and she stated to a friends house. I then asked Cara if she had consumed any alcoholic beverages in the last few hours and she replied "I've been a good girl." I stated I did not ask if you had been good I asked if you had consumed any alcoholic beverages and she again stated "I've been a good girl."

I told Cara I believed she was under the influence of alcohol and requested she perform some field sobriety exercises. Cara said sure. I asked her if she had any medical issues that would prevent her from performing the exercises and she stated no.

During standing Gaze and Nystagmus Cara would turn her head, look at my pen then look back and me and state "I did it." I explained to her several times not to move her head and to follow the tip of my pen with her eyes only, but she would not follow my directions.

I then continued to the one legged stand. I told Cara to stand with her feet together and hands at her side while I explained the exercise. When I finished explaining Cara took 30sec to decide which foot she was going to lift. Char began counting one thousand and one and so forth until she reached five. She then stumbled back against her car and stated I can't do it. I asked her if she was refusing and she stated no, I just can't do it because I haven't eaten in three days. I asked Cara if she would be willing to attempt another exercise and she stated yes, I'm not refusing.

In the area where we were there was a well lit patch of concrete that was level and had a straight seam through the middle. I advised Cara to stand on the seam with her left foot in front of her right and remain their while I explained the walk and turn exercise. Before I could start Cara stumbled off the line and said I can't do it. I asked her why and she stated because I'm hungry and I have high blood pressure. I asked Cara if she was sure she did not want to attempt the exercise and she said I can't do it but I'm not refusing.

I placed Cara under arrest and had her car removed by Edgewater Towing. Ofc. Muniz was at the scene and performed a female pat down of Cara. Once at the station I read implied consent to Cara and requested she provide me with a breath sample, Cara refused. I explained to her that a refusal would be used against her in court and her license could be suspended for up to one year. She stated she understood and again refused the breath test.

I completed the paperwork for Cara's arrest and then transported her to the Volusia County Branch Jail.

### Assisting Officers

Suspect Hate / Bias Motivated: *None (No bias)*

On February 27, 2012 I contacted Melinda Eissler at her residence, 1819 Victory Palm Drive in reference to a burglary. She advised she was going through a divorce and she returned to this residence to photo the house for court purposes and found many items missing. M. Eissler said she had an injunction against her soon to be ex-husband, Steven Eissler. She advised he was ordered to vacate the residence and not to have any contact with her. M. Eissler said she also vacated the residence after the injunction was issued. She rented the house to a friend of hers, Earlae Foy.

Foy later moved out and had a mover assist with her belongings. Foy advised the mover did take some things he believed to be Foy's that M. Eissler was attempting to report stolen. Foy later advised via telephone that she was in contact with M. Eissler and would be returning the items in question.

Amanda Eissler, the sister in law on S. Eissler's side saw me at the residence and stopped. She advised she saw the mover with a trailer on an unknown date and time loading things. She advised she saw several items that belonged to S. Eissler on the trailer. She said the unknown mover advised he did not know what was not Foy's and that A. Eissler could remove any items that weren't. A. Eissler said she did take a bicycle that she knew belonged to S. Eissler and she had it at her residence. She advised S. Eissler was aware and I did confirm this via telephone.

I explained to M. Eissler that the property dispute was a civil issue. I explained that it would be separated in the court system. I also advised her that a mover inadvertently took things thinking they belonged to Foy. I advised her to contact Foy.

I attempted to explain to A. Eissler that this was a civil issue, but she became argumentative. I explained to her that it was an issue that was between the owners of the property and she could provide a statement if she like as to what she knew about seeing the mover taking things she knew belonged to S. Eissler. She refused to do so and grew more agitated. She was raising her voice at me and requested a sergeant. I notified Officer Adams and requested his response.

I later explained to A. Eissler that M. Eissler did not want her to return to the property to retrieve any items. Again, A. Eissler raised her voice and was agitated. She was concerned about a refrigerator that belonged to S. Eissler's father. I again advised her that Edgewater Police would not interfere with division of property and it would be handled in the court system. She hastily requested a case number and was later given such.

I gave M. Eissler a case number and advised her to speak with her attorney and former roommate to retrieve some missing items.
