I would first like to say that I apologize for the reason of this letter. We have always had a

good relationship with one another via you the Sheriff and my husband, the now

Lieutenant Michael Odgers. I was the Court Liaison for Stewart Marchman Act (SMA) in

Judge Watson's Court room for the last 4 ½ years. Until I was forced to resign (due to a DV

charge), I worked for SMA for 9 ½ years.

From all my years within the SMA/Court System and married to an employee of the Volusia

County Sheriff's Department, there were three important values we all adhered to:

Character, Moral, and Ethical Standards.

My husband of 11 (together 14) years used a bogus Domestic Violence charge to

accommodate his cheating, but that is not the issue at this time. In a #2011 33560 Police

Report, he clearly listed a Melinda Eissler as his girlfriend (Both still married) at my

property. He then had his girlfriend list my address as her own for an injunction against her

this day. I signed mediation papers on 10/3/11 and at which time; no divorce petition was

filed on behalf of Melinda Eissler.

I am sorry Mr. Johnson, but I think a Lieutenant for the Sheriff's Department should have more moral and ethical standards than to shack up with a married woman (which he is currently doing), while she/he are still married and have the five children between both parties suffer the cost.
