There's no question that the Sheriff's Office has the resources, expertise and capability to conduct the investigation. The rationale for bringing in FDLE was to avoid any appearance of a conflict. Since the County now has taken control of the Advertising Authority's finances and has initiated an audit, the decision was made to bring in an outside agency to avoid any appearance of a conflict that could have resulted from another branch of County Government -- the Sheriff's Office — conducting the criminal investigation. For that reason, the County thought it best to have the criminal investigation conducted by a law enforcement agency that's independent of County Government. That was the reason that FDLE was asked to conduct the investigation.
