<b>NARRATIVE</b> The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant,			
on the 28 day of June, 2018, at approximately 0650 a.m. p.m.			
at 2400 Blk. Citrus Ave SOUTH DAYTONA within Volusia County, violated the law and did then and there:			
1 BWC Footage Sgt. Craig, Ofc. Mccallister and Ofc. Sanderson			
2			
3 The defendant entered onto several properties in between the 900 Blk of Lemon Rd and 2406 Citrus Ave that he did not have permission to enter			
4 onto. When approached by a uniformed officer in the yard of 929 Lemon Rd, the defendant did not dispel the officers alarm, and ran away. While			
5 running away from the officer, the defendant was trying to make entry into other residences on Citrus Ave. and the vehicles that were in their			
6 driveway, which was also witnessed by the officer. The defendant obtained a plastic pump pesticide bottle that he did not have permission to have,			
7 and later sprayed officers that were trying to affect the arrest of the defendant as he tried to escape them. The defendant still trying to escape arrest			
8 punched and kicked the officers that were on scene. Also the defendant tried to bite an officers finger off in and attempt to escape arrest.			
9			
10 On the above date and time, Ofc. Treat responded to a suspicious persons call at Duncan Rd and Magnolia Ave. As Ofc. Treat arrived on scene and			
11 drove the area, where the suspicious people were spotted originally, Ofc. Treat located a white male and a white female, walking from behind the			
12 southeast corner of 929 Lemon Rd. The male was later identified as Timothy J. Coffman (defendant) and Lisa D. Edelston (W-1). Ofc. Treat			
13 attempted to make contact with the defendant as he walked away from 929 Lemon Rd. Ofc. Treat identified himself and told Defendant to stop so he			
14 could talk with him. The defendant told Ofc. Treat "Fuck You, you are not the real police". The defendant ran from Ofc. Treat from 929 Lemon,			
15 towards 930 Ponderosa. Ofc. Treat chased the defendant on foot through the yard of 930 Duncan Rd southbound towards 929 Duncan Rd. All the




16 while Ofc. Treat was ordering the defendant to stop. Ofc. Treat was able to get into tasing distance of the defendant at 929 Duncan Rd. Ofc. Treat  
 17 deployed his department issued taser in the dart mode at the defendant, with both probes striking him in the back. This stunned the defendant briefly  
 18 and the defendant went to the ground. Before the complete cycle of the Taser completed, the defendant was able to pull one of the probes out and  
 19 was no longer stunned. Ofc. Treat deployed his second Taser cartridge at the defendant, but missed. The defendant then ran west bound across  
 20 Citrus Ave. The defendant ran up the driveway of 2338 Citrus, where the garage door was open and the resident was sitting inside. The defendant  
 21 got to the thresh hold of the garage, where he asked the resident for help because the police were chasing him. The resident told the defendant to  
 22 leave his property. The defendant left south bound from 2338 Citrus and ran to 2342 Citrus. While at 2342 Citrus, the defendant tried the front door to  
 23 enter the residence and was unable to. The defendant continued to run south bound and then went to 2400 Citrus. While at that address, the  
 24 defendant tried opening the front door of the residence to get into it, but was unable again. The defendant also tried the door handles of the vehicles  
 25 in the drive way of the residence, but they were locked. This was witnessed by Ofc. Treat who was now following the defendant in his marked police  
 26 vehicle. The defendant continued south where he reached 2406 Citrus. The defendant tried the front door of that residence, but once again he could  
 27 not get inside. The front door to that residence was recessed and covered by the roof. The defendant armed himself with a pesticide sprayer from  
 28 near the front door of 2406 Citrus. Ofc. Treat was now at this address with the defendant and ordering him to put the sprayer down. The defendant  
 29 pressurized the sprayer, by pumping it up and would not comply with Ofc. Treats commands. Ofc. Treat tried to utilized his department issued cap  
 30 stun on the defendant, which did not have any effect on him. The defendant started to spray Ofc. Treat with the pesticide. Sgt. Craig, Ofc. Mccallister  
 31 and Ofc. Sanderson arrived on scene. Sgt. Craig tried to assist in getting the defendant under control with verbal command, which he did not comply.  
 32 Sgt. Craig approached the defendant, who was at this time physically resisting Ofc. Treat as they were fighting. Ofc. Mccallister and Ofc. Sanderson  
 33 approached and now all officers that were on scene were trying to gain control of the defendant. The defendant was taken to the ground, where he  
 34 still had the sprayer from the pesticide canister in his hand. Sgt. Craig attempted to gain control of the defendants legs, but her was able to get a leg  
 35 free and kick Sgt, Craig in the face area several times. The defendant was hitting Ofc. Treat in the head with the sprayer from the pesticide canister.  
 36 Ofc. Mccallister was able to get control of one of the defendants arms, but during the struggle his left ring finger entered the defendants mouth. The  
 37 defendant bit down on Ofc. Mccallisters left ring finger and would not let go. The defendant was biting so hard that Ofc. Mccallister was in fear that his  
 38 finger would be bit off. Ofc. Sanderson was able to open the defendants mouth long enough to get Ofc. Mccallister's finger free. Ofc. treat was able to  
 39 have the defendant drop the sprayer and get control of the defendants other arm. During this time all officers except for Ofc. Sanderson were either  
 40 punched or kicked by the defendant at some point during the struggle.  
 41  
 42 Once the defendant was restrained by handcuffs and a ripp restraint, his body went limp. Two cans of Narcan were used on the defendant because  
 43 the officers were in fear that the defendant was over dosing. At one point Sgt. Craig began CPR on the defendant until South Daytona Rescue and  
 44 Evac arrived on scene.  
 45  
 46 The defendant, Ofc. Treat and Ofc. Mccallister were all transported to Halifax Hospital Daytona to be treated for their injuries sustained from this  
 47 incident.  
 48  
 49 Evidence Tech Ketelaar was called to the scene to help photograph and collect evidence from this incident. All evidence and pictures were entered  
 50 into evidence.  
 51  
 52 The defendant was placed under arrest and was accompanied to the hospital, were he remained until he was turned over to Volusia County  
 53 Corrections.






3 On the above date and time, I responded as a backup unit to Ofc. Treat. Ofc. Treat was attempting to take a person into custody for resisting

4 arrest and other charges. I arrived on scene and could see Ofc. Treat chasing after a male, later identified as Timothy Jason Coffman. I exited my

5 vehicle and the defendant had a chemical yard sprayer in his possession. The defendant was also clearly under the influence of some sort of

6 narcotic. The defendant's arms were vascular, his face and body were red in color and he was foaming as he was yelling nonsensical statements.

7 I overheard the male making statements similar to "South Daytona Police, come get me" or something of that nature. The yard sprayer was full of

8 chemicals and he was actively spraying officers. I ran towards him and yelled for him to get on the ground. The defendant refused and sprayed me

9 in the face with the chemical. I moved my head a bit, but the chemical entered my mouth. I was able to spit it out and attempted to run back

10 towards the defendant, but the defendant continued to spray officers. I removed my TASER and attempted to utilize it, But Ofc. Treat was now

11 attempting to take positive physical control of the defendant. I holstered my TASER and Ofc. Treat tackled the defendant to the ground. The

12 defendant landed on his back, so I grabbed his right arm and attempted to maneuver into a position to be handcuffed. The defendant felt very

13 warm, as if his body temperature was elevated, similar to narcotic use. At this time, Ofc. McCallister and Sanderson arrived and also attempted to

14 gain positive physical control of the defendant. However, Ofc. McCallister somehow put his hand close to the defendant's mouth and the

15 defendant bit down on Ofc. McCallister's finger. The bite was incredibly strong and it was evident that Ofc. McCallister could not remove his finger.

16 Ofc. McCallister attempted used pain compliance techniques by pressing into pressure points in order for the defendant to release the finger, but

17 the defendant refused. I also attempted to restrain the defendant's legs, but blood and sweat covered his legs and his legs were slippery. At one

18 point, his leg was free and he kicked me directly on the right side of the face. This forced my body camera into an upwards position. I tried again to

19 gain control of the legs, this time, I was able to sit on the legs, preventing them from coming up. We were able to handcuff one arm and then flip

20 him over to his stomach to handcuff the second arm. All of this while he continued to aggressively bite, kick and punch officers. Ofc. McCallister

21 restrained his the head, I restrained the legs and Ofc. McCallister and Sanderson had the arms. We double-cuffed his arms, meaning one set of

22 handcuffs was on the left wrist and a second set of handcuffs were on the right wrist and the two sets were connected together. This allowed the

23 defendant to continued free motion of his arms and he continued to reach and punch officers. At this point, we decided to remove one set of cuffs

24 and got to a single set of cuffs. The defendant's right arm was uncuffed and the set of handcuffs on his left hand were utilized. Meanwhile, the

25 defendant continued to kick me in my back. I also utilized RIPP Restraints in order to prevent his legs from kicking me. At this point, we rolled the

26 defendant over and his body went limp. Also, his pupils were incredibly dilated. Based on the above, I requested Ofc. McCallister to utilize Narcan,

27 thinking the defendant was overdosing. After no affect, a second dose of Narcan was used and no affect. The defendant had labored breathing

28 and his temperature was now cold to the touch. We continued to monitor his actions as we requested Fire Rescue for an emergency response.

29 We moved the defendant into a recovery position (on his right side, knees up) and there was no affect form the Narcan. At this point, we removed

30 the handcuffs from the back and placed them on the front. We continued to monitor his status, but it was obvious that his pulse was weakening.

31 One last check for a pulse revealed that he had no pulse and I immediately began CPR procedures. Within seconds, the paramedics arrived and

32 took over. The defendant was transported and Ofc. Sanderson remained with him at the hospital.

33

34 While on scene, I photographed Ofc. Treat and Ofc. McCallister's injuries. Both officers also went to Halifax Hospital to be treated for their injuries.

36 Evidence Technician Dawn Ketelaar responded to the scene to take pictures of the crime scene. I also walked with her as she photographed the

37 area. We located TASER probe lines at 2338 Citrus Ave., 929 Ponderosa Dr., and 2400 Citrus Ave. The probe lines were gathered by me and

38 submitted into evidence by me. Also, I gathered the defendant's clothing and collected that as evidence as well. The clothing was submitted by



 59 This may have been the reason that he was calling Ofc. treat a fake police officer.







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NARRATIVE / CONTINUATION

1 On June 28, 2018 I was dispatched to the intersection of Magnolia Ave and Duncan Rd. in reference to a suspicious white male and white female  
 2 walking Westbound on Duncan Rd. Upon arrival I drove Westbound on Duncan Rd. toward Citrus Ave. I continued Southbound on Citrus Ave. and  
 3 as I was pulling onto Lemon Rd I witnessed the defendant and the female walking away from the rear of 929 Lemon Rd. I was flagged down by a  
 4 resident who was walking his dog on Lemon Rd. The resident advised me that the defendant looks to be acting crazy and advised me that an  
 5 older male resides at 929 Lemon Rd and stated he does not believe that the defendant and the female should be behind the property. I drove up  
 6 to the defendant and the female and as I was driving toward them the defendant started to walk away. I got out of my patrol vehicle and told both  
 7 of them to come toward me and that I needed to talk to them. The defendant looked at me and then started running Eastbound on Ponderosa Dr. I  
 8 got back into my patrol vehicle and drove onto Ponderosa Dr to catch up to the defendant. I caught up to the defendant in front of 926 Ponderosa  
 9 Dr. I got out of my vehicle and told the defendant to stop running. The defendant then proceeded to run across the street to 929 Ponderosa Dr. I  
 10 yelled at the defendant to stop and then I used my issued stun gun in an attempt to subdue the defendant. The stun gun probes hit the defendant  
 11 and he fell forward into the grass in the front yard of 929 Ponderosa Dr. The defendant stood up and ripped the stun gun probes out of his back. I  
 12 attempted to use my stun gun a second time but missed the defendant. The defendant then proceeded to Citrus Ave and then Southbound on  
 13 Citrus Ave. I chased the defendant still giving commands for the defendant to stop running and get on the ground. The defendant ran into the  
 14 driveway of 2338 Citrus Ave. The resident of 2338 Citrus was sitting inside his garage with the door open during the time of the incident and the  
 15 defendant attempted to run inside the garage. The resident of 2338 Citrus yelled at the defendant to leave his property. The defendant continued  
 16 Southbound on Citrus Ave and then ran to the front door of 2342 Citrus Ave. The defendant attempted using the front door knob to open the front  
 17 door of the residence to make entry. The front door was locked and the defendant continued running Southbound. I chased after the defendant to  
 18 the residence of 2400 Citrus Ave. where the defendant also attempted to make entry into the residence by using the front door knob. I used my  
 19 issued pepper spray to attempt to subdue the defendant. The defendant grabbed a spray pump that was at the front door step of 2400 Citrus Ave.  
 20 The defendant started hitting me with the spray pump. I continued to use my pepper spray on the defendant. The defendant started to spray me  
 21 with an unknown chemical that was inside the spray pump. Due to the pepper spray having no affect on the defendant I used my department  
 22 issued baton to attempt to subdue the defendant. As I struck the defendant with the baton the defendant struck me back with the stick end of the  
 23 pump spray. The defendant then continued to run Southbound to the front yard of 2406 Citrus Ave. While running the defendant attempted to get  
 24 into several parked unoccupied vehicles by using the door handles to open the door. The defendant was unable to get into any vehicles or  
 25 residences that he attempted to while running from me. In the front yard of 2406 Citrus Ave I repeatedly order the defendant to get on the ground.  
 26 The defendant continued to spray me with the unknown chemicals with the pump spray and would not comply to my commands. Knowing that  
 27 none of my less than lethal weapons were having any affect on the defendant I attempted to create approximately ten feet of distance from the  
 28 defendant while not allowing him to leave the scene. I did this to give other responding units time to get to the scene to help subdue the defendant.  
 29 Sgt. Craig arrived on scene first and moved toward the defendant to go hands on. The defendant moved out of Sgt. Craig's way and then turned  
 30 to make an aggressive stance towards both of us. Not knowing the Sgt. Craig pulled out his stun gun to attempt to stun the defendant, I moved in  
 31 to tackle the defendant to the ground. The defendant went to the ground, I let off the defendant for a brief second and then went back hands on  
 32 with the defendant on the ground to get control of his arms. At this point Sgt. Craig, Ofc. Mccalister, Ofc. Sanderson, and I were all hands on with  
 33 the defendant attempting to get handcuffs on him. The defendant struck me in my face with a closed fist and also kicked Sgt. Craig in the face.  
 34 The defendant bit onto one of Ofc. Mccalister's fingers and would not let go. I attempted to get Ofc. Mccalister's hand free from he defendant's  
 35 mouth but the defendant had a strong bite on his finger. I started to notice the defendant drawing blood from Ofc. Mccalister's finger and still would  
 36 not let go. I struck the defendant in the left side of his face with a closed fist in an attempt to get him to let loose his bite on Ofc. Mccalister's finger.  
 37 Ofc. Mccalister was finally able to get his finger free from the defendant's mouth and we were able to handcuff the defendant. Sgt. Craig told me to  
 38 grab his leg restraints from the driver side door of his patrol vehicle. I grabbed the leg restraints and we placed them on the defendant. At this point  
 39 Sgt. Craig told me to walk away so that I could catch my breath and assess myself for any injuries. Due to the defendant spraying me all over my  
 40 person and face with an unknown chemical and also having pepper spray on me I went to Halifax hospital in Daytona Beach. After being  
 41 discharged from Halifax hospital I responded back out to Citrus Ave and gathered a statement from, Albert Mckim, who witnessed the defendant  
 42 fleeing from me on Citrus Ave. A. Mckim stated he heard me yelling to the defendant at least ten times to stop resisting and to get on the ground.  
 43 A. Mckim heard both stun gun deployments and then witnessed the defendant running from me Southbound on Citrus Ave. I placed the used stun  
 44 gun cartridges into an evidence bag and submitted it into evidence at the South Daytona Police Department.





